## **Do Not Rebuke Me in Your Anger**

([Psalm 38:1–22](#))

<sup>1</sup>For the Leader; with string-music; on the Sheminith. A Psalm of David. O LORD, rebuke me not in Thine anger, Neither chasten me in Thy wrath.

- <sup>2</sup>Be gracious unto me, O LORD, for I languish away; Heal me, O LORD, for my bones are affrighted.
- <sup>3</sup>My soul also is sore affrighted; And Thou, O LORD, how long?
- <sup>4</sup>Return, O LORD, deliver my soul; Save me for Thy mercy's sake.
- <sup>5</sup>For in death there is no remembrance of Thee; In the nether-world who will give Thee thanks?
- <sup>6</sup>I am weary with my groaning; Every night make I my bed to swim; I melt away my couch with my tears.
- <sup>7</sup>Mine eye is dimmed because of vexation; It waxeth old because of all mine adversaries.
- <sup>8</sup>Depart from me, all ye workers of iniquity; For the LORD hath heard the voice of my weeping.
- <sup>9</sup>The LORD hath heard my supplication; The LORD receiveth my prayer.
- <sup>10</sup>All mine enemies shall be ashamed and sore affrighted; They shall turn back, they shall be ashamed suddenly.
