## Give Thanks to the LORD, for He Is Good

- <sup>1</sup>Hallelujah. O give thanks unto the LORD; for He is good; For His mercy endureth for ever.
- <sup>2</sup>Who can express the mighty acts of the LORD, Or make all His praise to be heard?
- <sup>3</sup>Happy are they that keep justice, That do righteousness at all times.
- 4Remember me, O LORD, when Thou favourest Thy people; O think of me at Thy salvation;
- <sup>5</sup>That I may behold the prosperity of Thy chosen, That I may rejoice in the gladness of Thy nation, That I may glory with Thine inheritance.
- <sup>6</sup>We have sinned with our fathers, We have done iniquitously, we have dealt wickedly.
- Our fathers in Egypt gave no heed unto Thy wonders; They remembered not the multitude of Thy mercies; But were rebellious at the sea, even at the Red Sea.
- <sup>8</sup>Nevertheless He saved them for His name's sake, That He might make His mighty power to be known.

- <sup>9</sup>And He rebuked the Red Sea, and it was dried up; And He led them through the depths, as through a wilderness.
- <sup>10</sup>And He saved them from the hand of him that hated them, And redeemed them from the hand of the enemy.
- <sup>11</sup>And the waters covered their adversaries; There was not one of them left.
- 12Then believed they His words; They sang His praise.
- 13They soon forgot His works; They waited not for His counsel;
- 14But lusted exceedingly in the wilderness, And tried God in the desert.
- <sup>15</sup>And He gave them their request; But sent leanness into their soul.
- <sup>16</sup>They were jealous also of Moses in the camp, And of Aaron the holy one of the LORD.
- 17The earth opened and swallowed up Dathan, And covered the company of Abiram.
- 18 And a fire was kindled in their company; The flame burned up the wicked.
- <sup>19</sup>They made a calf in Horeb, And worshipped a molten image.
- <sup>20</sup>Thus they exchanged their glory For the likeness of an ox that eateth grass.
- <sup>21</sup>They forgot God their saviour, Who had done great things in Egypt;
- <sup>22</sup>Wondrous works in the land of Ham, Terrible things by the Red Sea.
- <sup>23</sup>Therefore He said that He would destroy them, Had not Moses His chosen stood before Him in the breach, To turn back His wrath, lest He should destroy them.
- <sup>24</sup>Moreover, they scorned the desirable land, They believed not His word;
- <sup>25</sup>And they murmured in their tents, They hearkened not unto the voice of the LORD.
- <sup>26</sup>Therefore He swore concerning them, That He would overthrow them in the wilderness;
- <sup>27</sup>And that He would cast out their seed among the nations, And scatter them in the lands.
- <sup>28</sup>They joined themselves also unto Baal of Peor, And ate the sacrifices of the dead.
- <sup>29</sup>Thus they provoked Him with their doings, And the plague broke in upon them.
- <sup>30</sup>Then stood up Phinehas, and wrought judgment, And so the plague was stayed.
- 31And that was counted unto him for righteousness, Unto all generations for ever.
- 32They angered Him also at the waters of Meribah, And it went ill with Moses because of them;

- <sup>33</sup>For they embittered his spirit, And he spoke rashly with his lips.
- 34They did not destroy the peoples, As the LORD commanded them;
- 35But mingled themselves with the nations, And learned their works;
- <sup>36</sup>And they served their idols, Which became a snare unto them;
- 37Yea, they sacrificed their sons and their daughters unto demons,
- <sup>38</sup>And shed innocent blood, even the blood of their sons and of their daughters, Whom they sacrificed unto the idols of Canaan; And the land was polluted with blood.
- <sup>39</sup>Thus were they defiled with their works, And went astray in their doings.
- <sup>40</sup>Therefore was the wrath of the LORD kindled against His people, And He abhorred His inheritance.
- 41 And He gave them into the hand of the nations; And they that hated them ruled over them.
- 42Their enemies also oppressed them, And they were subdued under their hand.
- 43 Many times did He deliver them; But they were rebellious in their counsel, And sank low through their iniquity.
- 44 Nevertheless He looked upon their distress, When He heard their cry;
- <sup>45</sup>And He remembered for them His covenant, And repented according to the multitude of His mercies.
- 46He made them also to be pitied Of all those that carried them captive.
- <sup>47</sup>Save us, O LORD our God, And gather us from among the nations, That we may give thanks unto Thy holy name, That we may triumph in Thy praise.
- **48**Blessed be the LORD, the God of Israel, From everlasting even to everlasting, And let all the people say: 'Amen.' Hallelujah.
