(Psalm 135:1–21)

¹Not unto us, O LORD, not unto us, But unto Thy name give glory, For Thy mercy, and for Thy truth's sake.

⁴Their idols are silver and gold, The work of men's hands.

18But we will bless the LORD From this time forth and for ever. Hallelujah.
