Zophar Rebukes Job

- ¹Then answered Zophar the Naamathite, and said:
- ²Should not the multitude of words be answered? And should a man full of talk be accounted right?
- ³Thy boastings have made men hold their peace, And thou hast mocked, with none to make thee ashamed;
- 4And thou hast said: 'My doctrine is pure, And I am clean in Thine eyes.'
- 5But oh that God would speak, And open His lips against thee;

- ¹⁵Surely then shalt thou lift up thy face without spot; Yea, thou shalt be stedfast, and shalt not fear;
- 16 For thou shalt forget thy misery; Thou shalt remember it as waters that are passed away;
- ¹⁷And thy life shall be clearer than the noonday; Though there be darkness, it shall be as the morning.
