## A Reproof of Ephraim, Judah, and Jacob

- <sup>1</sup>Ephraim striveth after wind, and followeth after the east wind; All the day he multiplieth lies and desolation; And they make a covenant with Assyria, And oil is carried into Egypt.
- <sup>2</sup>The LORD hath also a controversy with Judah, And will punish Jacob according to his ways, According to his doings will He recompense him.
- <sup>3</sup>In the womb he took his brother by the heel, And by his strength he strove with a godlike being;
- <sup>4</sup>So he strove with an angel, and prevailed; He wept, and made supplication unto him; At Beth-el he would find him, And there he would speak with us;
- <sup>5</sup>But the LORD, the God of hosts, The LORD is His name.
- <sup>6</sup>Therefore turn thou to thy God; Keep mercy and justice, And wait for thy God continually.
- <sup>7</sup>As for the trafficker, the balances of deceit are in his hand. He loveth to oppress.
- 8And Ephraim said: 'Surely I am become rich, I have found me wealth; In all my labours they shall find in me No iniquity that were sin.'
- <sup>9</sup>But I am the LORD thy God From the land of Egypt; I will yet again make thee to dwell in tents, As in the days of the appointed season.

- <sup>10</sup>I have also spoken unto the prophets, And I have multiplied visions; And by the ministry of the prophets have I used similitudes.
- <sup>11</sup>If Gilead be given to iniquity Becoming altogether vanity, In Gilgal they sacrifice unto bullocks; Yea, their altars shall be as heaps In the furrows of the field.
- 12 And Jacob fled into the field of Aram, And Israel served for a wife, And for a wife he kept sheep.
- <sup>13</sup>And by a prophet the LORD brought Israel up out of Egypt, And by a prophet was he kept.
- 14Ephraim hath provoked most bitterly; Therefore shall his blood be cast upon him, And his reproach shall his Lord return unto him.
