## A Father's Discipline

- <sup>1</sup>A wise son is instructed of his father; But a scorner heareth not rebuke.
- <sup>2</sup>A man shall eat good from the fruit of his mouth; But the desire of the faithless is violence.
- <sup>3</sup>He that guardeth his mouth keepeth his life; But for him that openeth wide his lips there shall be ruin.

- <sup>4</sup>The soul of the sluggard desireth, and hath nothing; But the soul of the diligent shall be abundantly gratified.
- <sup>5</sup>A righteous man hateth lying; But a wicked man behaveth vilely and shamefully.
- <sup>6</sup>Righteousness guardeth him that is upright in the way; But wickedness overthroweth the sinner.
- There is that pretendeth himself rich, yet hath nothing; There is that pretendeth himself poor, yet hath great wealth.
