#### A Good Name

- <sup>1</sup>A good name is rather to be chosen than great riches, And loving favour rather than silver and gold.
- <sup>2</sup>The rich and the poor meet together—The LORD is the maker of them all.
- <sup>3</sup>A prudent man seeth the evil, and hideth himself; But the thoughtless pass on, and are punished.
- <sup>4</sup>The reward of humility is the fear of the LORD, Even riches, and honour, and life.
- <sup>5</sup>Thorns and snares are in the way of the froward; He that keepeth his soul holdeth himself far from them.
- <sup>6</sup>Train up a child in the way he should go, And even when he is old, he will not depart from it.
- 7The rich ruleth over the poor, And the borrower is servant to the lender.
- 8He that soweth iniquity shall reap vanity; And the rod of his wrath shall fail.
- <sup>9</sup>He that hath a bountiful eye shall be blessed; For he giveth of his bread to the poor.
- <sup>10</sup>Cast out the scorner, and contention will go out; Yea, strife and shame will cease.
- 11He that loveth pureness of heart, That hath grace in his lips, the king shall be his friend.

- <sup>12</sup>The eyes of the LORD preserve him that hath knowledge, But He overthroweth the words of the faithless man.
- 13The sluggard saith: 'There is a lion without; I shall be slain in the streets.'
- 14The mouth of strange women is a deep pit: He that is abhorred of the LORD shall fall therein.
- <sup>15</sup>Foolishness is bound up in the heart of a child; But the rod of correction shall drive it far from him.
- <sup>16</sup>One may oppress the poor, yet will their gain increase; One may give to the rich, yet will want come.
