## **A Prayer for Deliverance**

(Psalm 74:1–23; Jeremiah 52:1–11)

- <sup>1</sup>A Psalm of Asaph. O God, the heathen are come into Thine inheritance; They have defiled Thy holy temple; They have made Jerusalem into heaps.
- <sup>2</sup>They have given the dead bodies of Thy servants to be food unto the fowls of the heaven, The flesh of Thy saints unto the beasts of the earth.
- <sup>3</sup>They have shed their blood like water Round about Jerusalem, with none to bury them.
- <sup>4</sup>We are become a taunt to our neighbours, A scorn and derision to them that are round about us.
- 5How long, O LORD, wilt Thou be angry for ever? How long will Thy jealousy burn like fire?
- <sup>6</sup>Pour out Thy wrath upon the nations that know Thee not, And upon the kingdoms that call not upon Thy name.
- <sup>7</sup>For they have devoured Jacob, And laid waste his habitation.

- <sup>8</sup>Remember not against us the iniquities of our forefathers; Let Thy compassions speedily come to meet us; For we are brought very low.
- <sup>9</sup>Help us, O God of our salvation, for the sake of the glory of Thy name; And deliver us, and forgive our sins, for Thy name's sake.
- **10**Wherefore should the nations say: 'Where is their God?' Let the avenging of Thy servants' blood that is shed Be made known among the nations in our sight.
- 11Let the groaning of the prisoner come before Thee; According to the greatness of Thy power set free those that are appointed to death;
- <sup>12</sup>And render unto our neighbours sevenfold into their bosom Their reproach, wherewith they have reproached Thee, O Lord.
- 13So we that are Thy people and the flock of Thy pasture Will give Thee thanks for ever; We will tell of Thy praise to all generations.
