- For the Leader; upon the Gittith. [A Psalm] of Asaph. Sing aloud unto God our strength; Shout unto the God of Jacob.
- ²Take up the melody, and sound the timbrel, The sweet harp with the psaltery.
- ³Blow the horn at the new moon, At the full moon for our feast-day.
- ⁴For it is a statute for Israel, An ordinance of the God of Jacob.
- ⁵He appointed it in Joseph for a testimony, When He went forth against the land of Egypt. The speech of one that I knew not did I hear:
- ⁶I removed his shoulder from the burden; His hands were freed from the basket.
- 7Thou didst call in trouble, and I rescued thee; I answered thee in the secret place of thunder; I proved thee at the waters of Meribah. Selah
- 8Hear, O My people, and I will admonish thee: O Israel, if thou wouldest hearken unto Me!
- ⁹There shall no strange god be in thee; neither shalt thou worship any foreign god.
- ¹⁰I am the LORD thy God, who brought thee up out of the land of Egypt; open thy mouth wide, and I will fill it.
- 11But My people hearkened not to My voice; And Israel would none of Me.

- ¹²So I let them go after the stubbornness of their heart, That they might walk in their own counsels.
- 13Oh that My people would hearken unto Me, That Israel would walk in My ways!
- 14I would soon subdue their enemies, And turn My hand against their adversaries.
- **15**The haters of the LORD should dwindle away before Him; And their punishment should endure for ever.
- 16They should also be fed with the fat of wheat; And with honey out of the rock would I satisfy thee.'
