## O God, Be Not Silent

- <sup>1</sup>A Song, a Psalm of Asaph. O God, keep not Thou silence; Hold not Thy peace, and be not still, O God.
- <sup>2</sup>For, lo, Thine enemies are in an uproar; And they that hate Thee have lifted up the head.
- <sup>3</sup>They hold crafty converse against Thy people, And take counsel against Thy treasured ones.

- <sup>4</sup>They have said: `Come, and let us cut them off from being a nation; That the name of Israel may be no more in remembrance.'
- For they have consulted together with one consent; Against Thee do they make a covenant;
- <sup>6</sup>The tents of Edom and the Ishmaelites; Moab, and the Hagrites;
- Gebal, and Ammon, and Amalek; Philistia with the inhabitants of Tyre;
- 8Assyria also is joined with them; They have been an arm to the children of Lot. Selah
- <sup>9</sup>Do Thou unto them as unto Midian; As to Sisera, as to Jabin, at the brook Kishon;
- **10**Who were destroyed at En-dor; They became as dung for the earth.
- 11 Make their nobles like Oreb and Zeeb, And like Zebah and Zalmunna all their princes;
- 12Who said: 'Let us take to ourselves in possession The habitations of God.'
- 13O my God, make them like the whirling dust; As stubble before the wind.
- 14As the fire that burneth the forest, And as the flame that setteth the mountains ablaze;
- <sup>15</sup>So pursue them with Thy tempest, And affright them with Thy storm.
- 16Fill their faces with shame; That they may seek Thy name, O LORD.
- 17Let them be ashamed and affrighted for ever; Yea, let them be abashed and perish;
- <sup>18</sup>That they may know that it is Thou alone whose name is the LORD, The Most High over all the earth.
