I Will Sing of His Love Forever

- ¹Maschil of Ethan the Ezrahite. I will sing of the mercies of the LORD for ever; To all generations will I make known Thy faithfulness with my mouth.
- ²For I have said: 'For ever is mercy built; In the very heavens Thou dost establish Thy faithfulness.
- ³I have made a covenant with My chosen, I have sworn unto David My servant:
- ⁴For ever will I establish thy seed, And build up thy throne to all generations.' Selah
- ⁵So shall the heavens praise Thy wonders, O LORD, Thy faithfulness also in the assembly of the holy ones.
- ⁶For who in the skies can be compared unto the LORD, Who among the sons of might can be likened unto the LORD,
- ⁷A God dreaded in the great council of the holy ones, And feared of all them that are about Him?
- 80 LORD God of hosts, Who is a mighty one, like unto Thee, O LORD? And Thy faithfulness is round about Thee.
- ⁹Thou rulest the proud swelling of the sea; When the waves thereof arise, Thou stillest them.

- ¹⁰Thou didst crush Rahab, as one that is slain; Thou didst scattered Thine enemies with the arm of Thy strength.
- 11 Thine are the heavens, Thine also the earth; The world and the fulness thereof, Thou hast founded them.
- 12The north and the south, Thou hast created them; Tabor and Hermon rejoice in Thy name.
- 13Thine is an arm with might; Strong is Thy hand, and exalted is Thy right hand.
- ¹⁴Righteousness and justice are the foundation of Thy throne; Mercy and truth go before Thee.
- ¹⁵Happy is the people that know the joyful shout; They walk, O LORD, in the light of Thy countenance.
- ¹⁶In Thy name do they rejoice all the day; And through Thy righteousness are they exalted.
- 17 For Thou art the glory of their strength; And in Thy favour our horn is exalted.
- 18 For of the LORD is our shield; And the Holy One of Israel is our king.
- 19Then Thou spokest in vision to Thy godly ones, And saidst: 'I have laid help upon one that is mighty; I have exalted one chosen out of the people.
- ²⁰I have found David My servant; With My holy oil have I anointed him;
- ²¹With whom My hand shall be established; Mine arm also shall strengthen him.
- ²²The enemy shall not exact from him; Nor the son of wickedness afflict him.
- ²³And I will beat to pieces his adversaries before him, And smite them that hate him.
- ²⁴But My faithfulness and My mercy shall be with him; And through My name shall his horn be exalted.
- ²⁵I will set his hand also on the sea, And his right hand on the rivers.
- ²⁶He shall call unto Me: Thou art my Father, My God, and the rock of my salvation.
- ²⁷I also will appoint him first-born, The highest of the kings of the earth.
- 28For ever will I keep for him My mercy, And My covenant shall stand fast with him.
- ²⁹His seed also will I make to endure for ever, And his throne as the days of heaven.
- ³⁰If his children forsake My law, And walk not in Mine ordinances;
- 31If they profane My statutes, And keep not My commandments;
- 32Then will I visit their transgression with the rod, And their iniquity with strokes.
- 33But My mercy will I not break off from him, Nor will I be false to My faithfulness.

- 34My covenant will I not profane, Nor alter that which is gone out of My lips.
- 35Once have I sworn by My holiness: Surely I will not be false unto David;
- ³⁶His seed shall endure for ever, And his throne as the sun before Me.
- 37It shall be established for ever as the moon; And be stedfast as the witness in sky.' Selah
- 38But Thou hast cast off and rejected, Thou hast been wroth with Thine anointed.
- ³⁹Thou hast abhorred the covenant of Thy servant; Thou hast profaned his crown even to the ground.
- 40Thou hast broken down all his fences; Thou hast brought his strongholds to ruin.
- ⁴¹All that pass by the way spoil him; He is become a taunt to his neighbours.
- 42Thou hast exalted the right hand of his adversaries; Thou hast made all his enemies to rejoice.
- 43Yea, Thou turnest back the edge of his sword, And hast not made him to stand in the battle.
- 44Thou hast made his brightness to cease, And cast his throne down to the ground.
- 45 The days of his youth hast Thou shortened; Thou hast covered him with shame. Selah
- 46How long, O LORD, wilt Thou hide Thyself for ever? How long shall Thy wrath burn like fire?
- 47O remember how short my time is; For what vanity hast Thou created all the children of men!
- 48What man is he that liveth and shall not see death, That shall deliver his soul from the power of the grave? Selah
- ⁴⁹Where are Thy former mercies, O Lord, Which Thou didst swear unto David in Thy faithfulness?
- ⁵⁰Remember, Lord, the taunt of Thy servants; How I do bear in my bosom [the taunt of] so many peoples;
- 51Wherewith Thine enemies have taunted, O LORD, Wherewith they have taunted the footsteps of Thine anointed.
- 52Blessed be the LORD for evermore. Amen, and Amen.
