

## II CORINTHIANS 11

### II CORINTHIANS 11:1

1 ¶ Would to God ye could bear with me a little in *my* folly: and indeed bear with me.

### II CORINTHIANS 11:2

2 For I am jealous over you with godly jealousy: for I have espoused you to one husband, that I may present *you* as a chaste virgin to Christ.

### II CORINTHIANS 11:3

3 But I fear, lest by any means, as the serpent beguiled Eve through his subtilty, so your minds should be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ.

### II CORINTHIANS 11:4

4 For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or *if* ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with *him*.

### II CORINTHIANS 11:5

5 ¶ For I suppose I was not a whit behind the very chiefest apostles.

### II CORINTHIANS 11:6

6 But though *I be* rude in speech, yet not in knowledge; but we have been throughly made manifest among you in all things.

### II CORINTHIANS 11:7

7 Have I committed an offence in abasing myself that ye might be exalted, because I have preached to you the gospel of God freely?

### II CORINTHIANS 11:8

8 I robbed other churches, taking wages *of them*, to do you service.

### II CORINTHIANS 11:9

9 And when I was present with you, and wanted, I was chargeable to no man: for that which was lacking to me the brethren which came from Macedonia supplied: and in all *things* I have kept myself from being burdensome unto you, and so will I keep *myself*.

### II CORINTHIANS 11:10

10 As the truth of Christ is in me, no man shall stop me of this boasting in the regions of Achaia.

## II CORINTHIANS 11:11

11 Wherefore? because I love you not? God knoweth.

## II CORINTHIANS 11:12

12 But what I do, that I will do, that I may cut off occasion from them which desire occasion; that wherein they glory, they may be found even as we.

## II CORINTHIANS 11:13

13 For such *are* false apostles, deceitful workers, transforming themselves into the apostles of Christ.

## II CORINTHIANS 11:14

14 And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light.

## II CORINTHIANS 11:15

15 Therefore *it is* no great thing if his ministers also be transformed as the ministers of righteousness; whose end shall be according to their works.

## II CORINTHIANS 11:16

16 ¶ I say again, Let no man think me a fool; if otherwise, yet as a fool receive me, that I may boast myself a little.

## II CORINTHIANS 11:17

17 That which I speak, I speak *it* not after the Lord, but as it were foolishly, in this confidence of boasting.

## II CORINTHIANS 11:18

18 Seeing that many glory after the flesh, I will glory also.

## II CORINTHIANS 11:19

19 For ye suffer fools gladly, seeing ye *yourselves* are wise.

## II CORINTHIANS 11:20

20 For ye suffer, if a man bring you into bondage, if a man devour *you*, if a man take *of you*, if a man exalt himself, if a man smite you on the face.

## II CORINTHIANS 11:21

21 I speak as concerning reproach, as though we had been weak. Howbeit whereinsoever any is bold, (I speak foolishly,) I am bold also.

## II CORINTHIANS 11:22

22 ¶ Are they Hebrews? so *am* I. Are they Israelites? so *am* I. Are they the seed of

Abraham? so *am* I.

II CORINTHIANS 11:23

23 Are they ministers of Christ? (I speak as a fool ) I *am* more; in labours more abundant, in stripes above measure, in prisons more frequent, in deaths oft.

II CORINTHIANS 11:24

24 Of the Jews five times received I forty *stripes* save one.

II CORINTHIANS 11:25

25 Thrice was I beaten with rods, once was I stoned, thrice I suffered shipwreck, a night and a day I have been in the deep;

II CORINTHIANS 11:26

26 *In* journeyings often, *in* perils of waters, *in* perils of robbers, *in* perils by *mine own* countrymen, *in* perils by the heathen, *in* perils in the city, *in* perils in the wilderness, *in* perils in the sea, *in* perils among false brethren;

II CORINTHIANS 11:27

27 In weariness and painfulness, in watchings often, in hunger and thirst, in fastings often, in cold and nakedness.

II CORINTHIANS 11:28

28 Beside those things that are without, that which cometh upon me daily, the care of all the churches.

II CORINTHIANS 11:29

29 Who is weak, and I am not weak? who is offended, and I burn not?

II CORINTHIANS 11:30

30 If I must needs glory, I will glory of the things which concern mine infirmities.

II CORINTHIANS 11:31

31 The God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which is blessed for evermore, knoweth that I lie not.

II CORINTHIANS 11:32

32 In Damascus the governor under Aretas the king kept the city of the Damascenes with a garrison, desirous to apprehend me:

II CORINTHIANS 11:33

33 And through a window in a basket was I let down by the wall, and escaped his hands.
