JOB 40:1

1 ¶ Moreover the LORD answered Job, and said,

JOB 40:2

2 Shall he that contendeth with the Almighty instruct *him*? he that reproveth God, let him answer it.

JOB 40:3

3 Then Job answered the LORD, and said,

JOB 40:4

4 Behold, I am vile; what shall I answer thee? I will lay mine hand upon my mouth.

JOB 40:5

5 Once have I spoken; but I will not answer: yea, twice; but I will proceed no further.

JOB 40:6

6 ¶ Then answered the LORD unto Job out of the whirlwind, and said,

JOB 40:7

7 Gird up thy loins now like a man: I will demand of thee, and declare thou unto me.

JOB 40:8

8 Wilt thou also disannul my judgment? wilt thou condemn me, that thou mayest be righteous?

JOB 40:9

9 Hast thou an arm like God? or canst thou thunder with a voice like him?

JOB 40:10

10 Deck thyself now *with* majesty and excellency; and array thyself with glory and beauty.

JOB 40:11

11 Cast abroad the rage of thy wrath: and behold every one *that is* proud, and abase him.

JOB 40:12

12 Look on every one *that is* proud, *and* bring him low; and tread down the wicked in their place.

JOB 40:13

13 Hide them in the dust together; *and* bind their faces in secret.

JOB 40:14

14 Then will I also confess unto thee that thine own right hand can save thee.

JOB 40:15

15 ¶ Behold now behemoth, which I made with thee; he eateth grass as an ox.

JOB 40:16

16 Lo now, his strength *is* in his loins, and his force *is* in the navel of his belly.

JOB 40:17

17 He moveth his tail like a cedar: the sinews of his stones are wrapped together.

JOB 40:18

18 His bones *are* as strong pieces of brass; his bones *are* like bars of iron.

JOB 40:19

19 He *is* the chief of the ways of God: he that made him can make his sword to approach *unto him*.

JOB 40:20

20 Surely the mountains bring him forth food, where all the beasts of the field play.

JOB 40:21

21 He lieth under the shady trees, in the covert of the reed, and fens.

JOB 40:22

22 The shady trees cover him *with* their shadow; the willows of the brook compass him about.

JOB 40:23

23 Behold, he drinketh up a river, *and* hasteth not: he trusteth that he can draw up Jordan into his mouth.

JOB 40:24

24 He taketh it with his eyes: *his* nose pierceth through snares.
