#### **JOHN 10:1**

1 Verily, \_verily, I \_say unto you, He that \_entereth not by the \_door \_into the \_sheepfold, but \_climbeth up some \_other way, the \_same is a \_thief and a \_robber.

#### **JOHN 10:2**

2 But he that entereth in by the door is the shepherd of the sheep.

#### **JOHN 10:3**

3 To him the \_porter \_openeth; and the \_sheep \_hear his \_voice: and he \_calleth his \_own \_sheep by \_name, and \_leadeth them out.

## **JOHN 10:4**

4 And \_when he \_putteth \_forth his \_own \_sheep, he \_goeth \_before them, and the \_sheep \_follow him: for they \_know his \_voice.

## **JOHN 10:5**

5 And a \_stranger will they not \_follow, but will \_flee from him: for they \_know not the \_voice of \_strangers.

#### **JOHN 10:6**

6 This parable spake Jesus unto them: but they understood not what things they were which he spake unto them.

## **JOHN 10:7**

7 Then said Jesus unto them again, \_Verily, \_verily, I \_say unto you, I \_am the \_door of the \_sheep.

## **JOHN 10:8**

8 \_All that \_ever \_came \_before me are \_thieves and \_robbers: but the \_sheep did not \_hear them.

#### **JOHN 10:9**

9 I \_am the \_door: by me \_if \_any man \_enter in, he shall be \_saved, and shall \_go in and out, and \_find \_pasture.

#### **JOHN 10:10**

10 The \_thief cometh not, but for to \_steal, and to \_kill, and to \_destroy: I am \_come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.

## **JOHN 10:11**

11 I \_am the \_good \_shepherd: the \_good \_shepherd \_giveth his \_life for the

\_sheep.

## **JOHN 10:12**

12 But he that is an \_hireling, and not the \_shepherd, \_whose \_own the \_sheep are not, \_seeth the \_wolf \_coming, and \_leaveth the \_sheep, and \_fleeth: and the \_wolf \_catcheth them, and \_scattereth the \_sheep.

## **JOHN 10:13**

13 The \_hireling \_fleeth, \_because he is an \_hireling, and \_careth not for the \_sheep.

## **JOHN 10:14**

14 I \_am the \_good \_shepherd, and \_know my sheep, and am \_known of \_mine.

## **JOHN 10:15**

15 As the \_Father \_knoweth me, \_even so \_know I the \_Father: and I \_lay down my \_life for the \_sheep.

#### **JOHN 10:16**

16 And \_other \_sheep I \_have, \_which are not of \_this \_fold: them \_also I \_must \_bring, and they shall \_hear my \_voice; and there shall be \_one \_fold, and \_one \_shepherd.

## **JOHN 10:17**

17 \_Therefore doth my \_Father \_love me, \_because I \_lay down my \_life, that I might \_take it \_again.

## **JOHN 10:18**

18 \_No \_man \_taketh it from me, but I \_lay it down of \_myself. I \_have \_power to \_lay it down, and I \_have \_power to \_take it \_again. \_This \_commandment have I \_received of my \_Father.

## **JOHN 10:19**

19 There was a division therefore again among the Jews for these sayings.

#### JOHN 10:20

20 And many of them said, He hath a devil, and is mad; why hear ye him?

#### **JOHN 10:21**

21 Others said, These are not the words of him that hath a devil. Can a devil open the eyes of the blind?

## **JOHN 10:22**

22 ¶ And it was at Jerusalem the feast of the dedication, and it was winter.

## JOHN 10:23

23 And Jesus walked in the temple in Solomon's porch.

#### JOHN 10:24

24 Then came the Jews round about him, and said unto him, How long dost thou make us to doubt? If thou be the Christ, tell us plainly.

## **JOHN 10:25**

25 Jesus answered them, I \_told you, and ye \_believed not: the \_works that I \_do in my Father's name, they bear witness of me.

#### **JOHN 10:26**

26 But ye \_believe not, \_because ye are not of my \_sheep, as I \_said unto you.

#### JOHN 10:27

27 My \_sheep \_hear my \_voice, and I \_know them, and they \_follow me:

#### **JOHN 10:28**

28 And I \_give unto them \_eternal \_life; and they shall \_never \_perish, \_neither shall \_any *man* \_pluck them out of my \_hand.

## **JOHN 10:29**

29 My \_Father, \_which \_gave *them* me, is \_greater than \_all; and \_no *man* is \_able to \_pluck *them* out of my \_Father's \_hand.

## **JOHN 10:30**

30 I and my \_Father are \_one.

## **JOHN 10:31**

31 Then the Jews took up stones again to stone him.

## **JOHN 10:32**

32 Jesus answered them, \_Many \_good \_works have I \_shewed you from my \_Father; for \_which of \_those \_works do ye \_stone me?

## **JOHN 10:33**

33 The Jews answered him, saying, For a good work we stone thee not; but for blasphemy; and because that thou, being a man, makest thyself God.

## **JOHN 10:34**

34 Jesus answered them, Is it not \_written in \_your \_law, I \_said, Ye are \_gods?

## **JOHN 10:35**

35 \_If he \_called them \_gods, unto \_whom the \_word of \_God \_came, and the \_scripture \_cannot be \_broken;

## **JOHN 10:36**

36 \_Say ye of him, \_whom the \_Father hath \_sanctified, and \_sent \_into the \_world, Thou \_blasphemest; \_because I \_said, I am the \_Son of \_God?

## **JOHN 10:37**

37 \_If I \_do not the \_works of my \_Father, \_believe me not.

#### **JOHN 10:38**

38 But \_if I \_do, \_though ye \_believe not me, \_believe the \_works: that ye may \_know, and \_believe, that the \_Father *is* in me, and I in him.

## **JOHN 10:39**

39 Therefore they sought again to take him: but he escaped out of their hand,

#### **JOHN 10:40**

40 And went away again beyond Jordan into the place where John at first baptized; and there he abode.

## **JOHN 10:41**

41 And many resorted unto him, and said, John did no miracle: but all things that John spake of this man were true.

## **JOHN 10:42**

42 And many believed on him there.
