JOHN 13

JOHN 13:1

1 Now before the feast of the passover, when Jesus knew that his hour was come that he should depart out of this world unto the Father, having loved his own which were in the world, he loved them unto the end.

JOHN 13:2

2 And supper being ended, the devil having now put into the heart of Judas Iscariot, Simon's *son*, to betray him;

JOHN 13:3

3 Jesus knowing that the Father had given all things into his hands, and that he was come from God, and went to God;

JOHN 13:4

4 He riseth from supper, and laid aside his garments; and took a towel, and girded himself.

JOHN 13:5

5 After that he poureth water into a bason, and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe *them* with the towel wherewith he was girded.

JOHN 13:6

6 Then cometh he to Simon Peter: and Peter saith unto him, Lord, dost thou wash my feet?

JOHN 13:7

7 Jesus answered and said unto him, _What I _do _thou _knowest not _now; but thou shalt _know _hereafter.

JOHN 13:8

8 Peter saith unto him, Thou shalt never wash my feet. Jesus answered him, _If I _wash thee _not, thou _hast _no _part with me.

JOHN 13:9

9 Simon Peter saith unto him, Lord, not my feet only, but also *my* hands and *my* head.

JOHN 13:10

10 Jesus saith to him, He that is _washed _needeth not _save to _wash *his* _feet, but is _clean _every _whit: and ye are _clean, but not _all.

JOHN 13:11

11 For he knew who should betray him; therefore said he, Ye are not _all _clean.

JOHN 13:12

12 So after he had washed their feet, and had taken his garments, and was set down again, he said unto them, _Know ye _what I have _done to you?

JOHN 13:13

13 Ye _call me _Master and _Lord: and ye _say _well; for so I _am.

JOHN 13:14

14 _If I _then, *your* _Lord and _Master, have _washed _your _feet; ye _also _ought to _wash _one _another's _feet.

JOHN 13:15

15 For I have _given you an _example, that ye should _do as I have _done to you.

JOHN 13:16

16 _Verily, _verily, I _say unto you, The _servant is not _greater than his _lord; _neither he that is _sent _greater than he that _sent him.

JOHN 13:17

17 _If ye _know _these things, _happy are ye _if ye _do them.

JOHN 13:18

18 I _speak not of you _all: I _know _whom I have _chosen: but that the _scripture may be _fulfilled, He that _eateth _bread with me hath _lifted up his _heel _against me.

JOHN 13:19

19 _Now I _tell you _before it _come, that, _when it is _come to pass, ye may _believe that I _am *he*.

JOHN 13:20

20 _Verily, _verily, I _say unto you, He that _receiveth _whomsoever I _send _receiveth me; and he that _receiveth me _receiveth him that _sent me.

JOHN 13:21

21 When Jesus had thus said, he was troubled in spirit, and testified, and said, _Verily, _verily, I _say unto you, that _one of you shall _betray me.

JOHN 13:22

Then the disciples looked one on another, doubting of whom he spake.

JOHN 13:23

Now there was leaning on Jesus' bosom one of his disciples, whom Jesus loved.

JOHN 13:24

24 Simon Peter therefore beckoned to him, that he should ask who it should be of whom he spake.

JOHN 13:25

25 He then lying on Jesus' breast saith unto him, Lord, who is it?

JOHN 13:26

26 Jesus answered, He it is, to _whom I shall _give a _sop, when I have _dipped *it*. And when he had dipped the sop, he gave *it* to Judas Iscariot, *the son* of Simon.

JOHN 13:27

27 And after the sop Satan entered into him. Then said Jesus unto him, That thou _doest, _do _quickly.

JOHN 13:28

Now no man at the table knew for what intent he spake this unto him.

JOHN 13:29

29 For some *of them* thought, because Judas had the bag, that Jesus had said unto him, Buy *those things* that we have need of against the feast; or, that he should give something to the poor.

JOHN 13:30

30 He then having received the sop went immediately out: and it was night.

JOHN 13:31

31 Therefore, when he was gone out, Jesus said, _Now is the _Son of _man glorified, and God is glorified in him.

JOHN 13:32

32 _If _God be _glorified in him, _God shall _also _glorify him in _himself, and shall _straightway _glorify him.

JOHN 13:33

33 _Little _children, _yet a _little _while I _am with you. Ye shall _seek me: and as I _said unto the _Jews, _Whither I _go, ye _cannot _come; _so _now I _say to you.

JOHN 13:34

34 A _new _commandment I _give unto you, That ye _love _one _another; as I have _loved you, that ye _also _love _one _another.

JOHN 13:35

35 By _this shall _all *men* _know that ye are my _disciples, _if ye _have _love _one to another.

JOHN 13:36

36 ¶ Simon Peter said unto him, Lord, whither goest thou? Jesus answered him, _Whither I _go, thou _canst not _follow me _now; but thou shalt _follow me afterwards.

JOHN 13:37

37 Peter said unto him, Lord, why cannot I follow thee now? I will lay down my life for thy sake.

JOHN 13:38

38 Jesus answered him, Wilt thou _lay down thy _life for my sake? _Verily, _verily, I _say unto thee, The _cock shall not _crow, _till thou hast _denied me _thrice.
