JOHN 2:1

1 ¶ And the third day there was a marriage in Cana of Galilee; and the mother of Jesus was there:

JOHN 2:2

2 And both Jesus was called, and his disciples, to the marriage.

JOHN 2:3

3 And when they wanted wine, the mother of Jesus saith unto him, They have no wine.

JOHN 2:4

4 Jesus saith unto her, _Woman, _what have I to do with thee? _mine _hour is not _yet _come.

JOHN 2:5

5 His mother saith unto the servants, Whatsoever he saith unto you, do it.

JOHN 2:6

6 And there were set there six waterpots of stone, after the manner of the purifying of the Jews, containing two or three firkins apiece.

JOHN 2:7

7 Jesus saith unto them, _Fill the _waterpots with _water. And they filled them up to the brim.

JOHN 2:8

8 And he saith unto them, _Draw out _now, and _bear unto the _governor of the _feast. And they bare *it*.

JOHN 2:9

9 When the ruler of the feast had tasted the water that was made wine, and knew not whence it was: (but the servants which drew the water knew;) the governor of the feast called the bridegroom,

JOHN 2:10

10 And saith unto him, Every man at the beginning doth set forth good wine; and when men have well drunk, then that which is worse: *but* thou hast kept the good wine until now

JOHN 2:11

11 This beginning of miracles did Jesus in Cana of Galilee, and manifested forth his glory; and his disciples believed on him.

JOHN 2:12

12 ¶ After this he went down to Capernaum, he, and his mother, and his brethren, and his disciples: and they continued there not many days.

JOHN 2:13

13 And the Jews' passover was at hand, and Jesus went up to Jerusalem,

JOHN 2:14

14 And found in the temple those that sold oxen and sheep and doves, and the changers of money sitting:

JOHN 2:15

15 And when he had made a scourge of small cords, he drove them all out of the temple, and the sheep, and the oxen; and poured out the changers' money, and overthrew the tables:

JOHN 2:16

16 And said unto them that sold doves, _Take _these things _hence; _make not my _Father's _house an _house of _merchandise.

JOHN 2:17

17 And his disciples remembered that it was written, The zeal of thine house hath eaten me up.

JOHN 2:18

18 Then answered the Jews and said unto him, What sign shewest thou unto us, seeing that thou doest these things?

JOHN 2:19

19 Jesus answered and said unto them, _Destroy _this _temple, and in _three _days I will _raise it up.

JOHN 2:20

20 Then said the Jews, Forty and six years was this temple in building, and wilt thou rear it up in three days?

JOHN 2:21

21 But he spake of the temple of his body.

JOHN 2:22

22 When therefore he was risen from the dead, his disciples remembered that he had said this unto them; and they believed the scripture, and the word which Jesus had said.

JOHN 2:23

Now when he was in Jerusalem at the passover, in the feast *day*, many believed in his name, when they saw the miracles which he did.

JOHN 2:24

24 But Jesus did not commit himself unto them, because he knew all men,

JOHN 2:25

25 And needed not that any should testify of man: for he knew what was in man.
