# JOHN 6

### **JOHN 6:1**

1 ¶ After these things Jesus went over the sea of Galilee, which is *the sea* of Tiberias.

### **JOHN 6:2**

2 And a great multitude followed him, because they saw his miracles which he did on them that were diseased.

### **JOHN 6:3**

3 And Jesus went up into a mountain, and there he sat with his disciples.

### **JOHN 6:4**

4 And the passover, a feast of the Jews, was nigh.

### **JOHN 6:5**

5 When Jesus then lifted up *his* eyes, and saw a great company come unto him, he saith unto Philip, \_Whence shall we \_buy \_bread, that \_these may \_eat?

### **JOHN 6:6**

6 And this he said to prove him: for he himself knew what he would do.

## **JOHN 6:7**

7 Philip answered him, Two hundred pennyworth of bread is not sufficient for them, that every one of them may take a little.

### **JOHN 6:8**

8 One of his disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, saith unto him,

## **JOHN 6:9**

9 There is a lad here, which hath five barley loaves, and two small fishes: but what are they among so many?

### JOHN 6:10

10 And Jesus said, <u>Make the men sit down</u>. Now there was much grass in the place. So the men sat down, in number about five thousand.

## JOHN 6:11

11 And Jesus took the loaves; and when he had given thanks, he distributed to the disciples, and the disciples to them that were set down; and likewise of the fishes as much as they would.

12 When they were filled, he said unto his disciples, \_Gather up the \_fragments that \_remain, that \_nothing be \_lost.

## JOHN 6:13

13 Therefore they gathered *them* together, and filled twelve baskets with the fragments of the five barley loaves, which remained over and above unto them that had eaten.

## **JOHN 6:14**

14 Then those men, when they had seen the miracle that Jesus did, said, This is of a truth that prophet that should come into the world.

## JOHN 6:15

15 ¶ When Jesus therefore perceived that they would come and take him by force, to make him a king, he departed again into a mountain himself alone.

## JOHN 6:16

16 And when even was now come, his disciples went down unto the sea,

## JOHN 6:17

17 And entered into a ship, and went over the sea toward Capernaum. And it was now dark, and Jesus was not come to them.

## **JOHN 6:18**

18 And the sea arose by reason of a great wind that blew.

## JOHN 6:19

19 So when they had rowed about five and twenty or thirty furlongs, they see Jesus walking on the sea, and drawing nigh unto the ship: and they were afraid.

## **JOHN 6:20**

20 But he saith unto them, It is I; be not \_afraid.

## JOHN 6:21

21 Then they willingly received him into the ship: and immediately the ship was at the land whither they went.

## **JOHN 6:22**

22 The day following, when the people which stood on the other side of the sea saw that there was none other boat there, save that one whereinto his disciples were entered, and that Jesus went not with his disciples into the boat, but *that* his disciples were gone away alone;

23 (Howbeit there came other boats from Tiberias nigh unto the place where they did eat bread, after that the Lord had given thanks:)

### **JOHN 6:24**

24 When the people therefore saw that Jesus was not there, neither his disciples, they also took shipping, and came to Capernaum, seeking for Jesus.

### **JOHN 6:25**

25 And when they had found him on the other side of the sea, they said unto him, Rabbi, when camest thou hither?

### **JOHN 6:26**

26 Jesus answered them and said, \_Verily, \_verily, I \_say unto you, Ye \_seek me, not \_because ye \_saw the \_miracles, but \_because ye did \_eat of the \_loaves, and were \_filled.

### **JOHN 6:27**

27 \_Labour not for the \_meat \_which \_perisheth, but for that \_meat \_which \_endureth unto \_everlasting \_life, \_which the \_Son of \_man shall \_give unto you: for him hath \_God the \_Father \_sealed.

## **JOHN 6:28**

28 Then said they unto him, What shall we do, that we might work the works of God?

### **JOHN 6:29**

29 Jesus answered and said unto them, \_This is the \_work of \_God, that ye \_believe \_on him \_whom he hath \_sent.

### **JOHN 6:30**

30 They said therefore unto him, What sign shewest thou then, that we may see, and believe thee? what dost thou work?

### **JOHN 6:31**

31 Our fathers did eat manna in the desert; as it is written, He gave them bread from heaven to eat.

### **JOHN 6:32**

32 Then Jesus said unto them, \_Verily, \_verily, I \_say unto you, \_Moses \_gave you not that \_bread from \_heaven; but my \_Father \_giveth you the \_true \_bread from \_heaven.

**33** For the \_bread of \_God is he \_which \_cometh \_down from \_heaven, and \_giveth \_life unto the \_world.

#### **JOHN 6:34**

34 Then said they unto him, Lord, evermore give us this bread.

#### **JOHN 6:35**

35 And Jesus said unto them, I \_am the \_bread of \_life: he that \_cometh to me shall \_never \_hunger; and he that \_believeth \_on me shall \_never \_thirst.

#### **JOHN 6:36**

36 But I \_said unto you, That ye \_also have \_seen me, and \_believe not.

#### **JOHN 6:37**

37 \_All that the \_Father \_giveth me shall \_come to me; and him that \_cometh to me I will in \_no wise \_cast out.

#### **JOHN 6:38**

**38** For I \_came \_down from \_heaven, not to \_do \_mine own \_will, but the \_will of him that \_sent me.

#### **JOHN 6:39**

39 And \_this is the \_Father's \_will \_which hath \_sent me, that of \_all which he hath \_given me I should \_lose \_nothing, but should \_raise it up \_again \_at the \_last \_day.

#### **JOHN 6:40**

40 And \_this is the \_will of him that \_sent me, that \_every one \_which \_seeth the \_Son, and \_believeth \_on him, may \_have \_everlasting \_life: and I will \_raise him up at the \_last \_day.

### **JOHN 6:41**

41 The Jews then murmured at him, because he said, I am the bread which came down from heaven.

#### **JOHN 6:42**

42 And they said, Is not this Jesus, the son of Joseph, whose father and mother we know? how is it then that he saith, I came down from heaven?

### **JOHN 6:43**

43 Jesus therefore answered and said unto them, \_Murmur not \_among \_yourselves.

44 \_No \_man \_can \_come to me, \_except the \_Father \_which hath \_sent me \_draw him: and I will \_raise him up at the \_last \_day.

### **JOHN 6:45**

45 It is \_written in the \_prophets, And they shall be \_all \_taught of \_God. \_Every man \_therefore that hath \_heard, and hath \_learned of the \_Father, \_cometh unto me.

### **JOHN 6:46**

**46** Not that \_any man hath \_seen the \_Father, \_save he \_which is of \_God, he hath \_seen the \_Father.

### JOHN 6:47

**47** \_Verily, \_verily, I \_say unto you, He that \_believeth \_on me \_hath \_everlasting \_life.

### **JOHN 6:48**

**48** I \_am that \_bread of \_life.

### **JOHN 6:49**

49 \_Your \_fathers did \_eat \_manna in the \_wilderness, and are \_dead.

### **JOHN 6:50**

50 \_This is the \_bread \_which \_cometh \_down from \_heaven, that a \_man may \_eat \_thereof, and not \_die.

### **JOHN 6:51**

**51** I \_am the \_living \_bread \_which \_came \_down from \_heaven: \_if \_any man \_eat of \_this \_bread, he shall \_live for \_ever: and the \_bread that I will \_give is my \_flesh, \_which I will \_give for the \_life of the \_world.

### JOHN 6:52

52 The Jews therefore strove among themselves, saying, How can this man give us *his* flesh to eat?

### **JOHN 6:53**

53 Then Jesus said unto them, \_Verily, \_verily, I \_say unto you, \_Except ye \_eat the \_flesh of the \_Son of \_man, and \_drink his \_blood, ye \_have \_no \_life in you.

### JOHN 6:54

54 \_Whoso \_eateth my \_flesh, and \_drinketh my \_blood, \_hath \_eternal \_life; and I will \_raise him up at the \_last \_day.

### **JOHN 6:55**

55 For my \_flesh is \_meat \_indeed, and my \_blood is \_drink \_indeed.

### **JOHN 6:56**

56 He that \_eateth my \_flesh, and \_drinketh my \_blood, \_dwelleth in me, and I in him.

#### **JOHN 6:57**

57 As the \_living \_Father hath \_sent me, and I \_live by the \_Father: \_so he that \_eateth me, \_even he shall \_live by me.

#### **JOHN 6:58**

**58** \_This is that \_bread \_which \_came \_down from \_heaven: not as \_your \_fathers did \_eat \_manna, and are \_dead: he that \_eateth of \_this \_bread shall \_live for \_ever.

#### **JOHN 6:59**

59 These things said he in the synagogue, as he taught in Capernaum.

#### JOHN 6:60

60 ¶ Many therefore of his disciples, when they had heard *this*, said, This is an hard saying; who can hear it?

### JOHN 6:61

61 When Jesus knew in himself that his disciples murmured at it, he said unto them, Doth \_this \_offend you?

### **JOHN 6:62**

62 What and \_if ye shall \_see the \_Son of \_man \_ascend up \_where he was \_before?

### **JOHN 6:63**

**63** It is the \_spirit that \_quickeneth; the \_flesh \_profiteth \_nothing: the \_words that I \_speak unto you, *they* are \_spirit, and *they* are \_life.

#### JOHN 6:64

64 But there are \_some of you that \_believe not. For Jesus knew from the beginning who they were that believed not, and who should betray him.

#### **JOHN 6:65**

65 And he said, \_Therefore \_said I unto you, that \_no \_man \_can \_come unto me, \_except it were \_given unto him of my \_Father.

#### **JOHN 6:66**

66 From that *time* many of his disciples went back, and walked no more with him.

67 Then said Jesus unto the twelve, \_Will ye \_also \_go \_away?

### **JOHN 6:68**

68 Then Simon Peter answered him, Lord, to whom shall we go? thou hast the words of eternal life.

### JOHN 6:69

69 And we believe and are sure that thou art that Christ, the Son of the living God.

## **JOHN 6:70**

70 Jesus answered them, Have not I \_chosen you \_twelve, and \_one of you is a \_devil?

### JOHN 6:71

71 He spake of Judas Iscariot *the son* of Simon: for he it was that should betray him, being one of the twelve.
