JOHN 7

JOHN 7:1

1 ¶ After these things Jesus walked in Galilee: for he would not walk in Jewry, because the Jews sought to kill him.

JOHN 7:2

2 Now the Jews' feast of tabernacles was at hand.

JOHN 7:3

3 His brethren therefore said unto him, Depart hence, and go into Judaea, that thy disciples also may see the works that thou doest.

JOHN 7:4

4 For *there is* no man *that* doeth any thing in secret, and he himself seeketh to be known openly. If thou do these things, shew thyself to the world.

JOHN 7:5

5 For neither did his brethren believe in him.

JOHN 7:6

6 Then Jesus said unto them, My _time is not _yet _come: but _your _time is _alway _ready.

JOHN 7:7

7 The _world _cannot _hate you; but me it _hateth, _because I _testify of it, that the _works _thereof are _evil.

JOHN 7:8

8 _Go ye up unto _this _feast: I _go not up _yet unto _this _feast; for my _time is not _yet _full _come.

JOHN 7:9

9 When he had said these words unto them, he abode *still* in Galilee.

JOHN 7:10

10 But when his brethren were gone up, then went he also up unto the feast, not openly, but as it were in secret.

JOHN 7:11

11 Then the Jews sought him at the feast, and said, Where is he?

JOHN 7:12

12 And there was much murmuring among the people concerning him: for some said, He is a good man: others said, Nay; but he deceiveth the people.

JOHN 7:13

13 Howbeit no man spake openly of him for fear of the Jews.

JOHN 7:14

14 Now about the midst of the feast Jesus went up into the temple, and taught.

JOHN 7:15

15 And the Jews marvelled, saying, How knoweth this man letters, having never learned?

JOHN 7:16

16 Jesus answered them, and said, My _doctrine is not _mine, but his that _sent me.

JOHN 7:17

17 _If _any man _will _do his _will, he shall _know of the _doctrine, _whether it be of _God, _or *whether* I _speak of _myself.

JOHN 7:18

18 He that _speaketh of _himself _seeketh his _own _glory: but he that _seeketh his _glory that _sent him, the _same is _true, and _no _unrighteousness is in him.

JOHN 7:19

19 Did not _Moses _give you the _law, and yet _none of you _keepeth the _law? _Why _go ye _about to _kill me?

JOHN 7:20

20 The people answered and said, Thou hast a devil: who goeth about to kill thee?

JOHN 7:21

21 Jesus answered and said unto them, I have _done _one _work, and ye _all _marvel.

JOHN 7:22

22 _Moses _therefore _gave unto you _circumcision; (not _because it is of _Moses, but of the _fathers;) and ye _on the _sabbath day _circumcise a _man.

JOHN 7:23

23 _If a _man _on the _sabbath day _receive _circumcision, that the _law of __Moses should not be _broken; are ye _angry at me, _because I have _made a _man

_every _whit _whole _on the _sabbath day?

JOHN 7:24

24 _Judge not _according to the _appearance, but _judge _righteous _judgment.

JOHN 7:25

25 Then said some of them of Jerusalem, Is not this he, whom they seek to kill?

JOHN 7:26

26 But, lo, he speaketh boldly, and they say nothing unto him. Do the rulers know indeed that this is the very Christ?

JOHN 7:27

27 Howbeit we know this man whence he is: but when Christ cometh, no man knoweth whence he is.

JOHN 7:28

28 Then cried Jesus in the temple as he taught, saying, Ye _both _know me, and ye _know _whence I _am: and I am not _come of _myself, but he that _sent me is _true, _whom ye _know not.

JOHN 7:29

29 But I _know him: for I _am from him, and he hath _sent me.

JOHN 7:30

30 Then they sought to take him: but no man laid hands on him, because his hour was not yet come.

JOHN 7:31

31 And many of the people believed on him, and said, When Christ cometh, will he do more miracles than these which this *man* hath done?

JOHN 7:32

32 The Pharisees heard that the people murmured such things concerning him; and the Pharisees and the chief priests sent officers to take him.

JOHN 7:33

33 Then said Jesus unto them, _Yet a _little _while _am I with you, and *then* I _go unto him that _sent me.

JOHN 7:34

34 Ye shall _seek me, and shall not _find *me*: and _where I _am, *thither* ye _cannot _come.

JOHN 7:35

35 Then said the Jews among themselves, Whither will he go, that we shall not find him? will he go unto the dispersed among the Gentiles, and teach the Gentiles?

JOHN 7:36

36 What *manner of* saying is this that he said, Ye shall seek me, and shall not find *me*: and where I am, *thither* ye cannot come?

JOHN 7:37

37 ¶ In the last day, that great *day* of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, _If _any man _thirst, let him _come unto me, and _drink.

JOHN 7:38

38 He that _believeth _on me, as the _scripture hath _said, out of his _belly shall _flow _rivers of _living _water.

JOHN 7:39

39 (But this spake he of the Spirit, which they that believe on him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet *given*; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.)

JOHN 7:40

40 Many of the people therefore, when they heard this saying, said, Of a truth this is the Prophet.

JOHN 7:41

41 Others said, This is the Christ. But some said, Shall Christ come out of Galilee?

JOHN 7:42

42 Hath not the scripture said, That Christ cometh of the seed of David, and out of the town of Bethlehem, where David was?

JOHN 7:43

43 So there was a division among the people because of him.

JOHN 7:44

44 And some of them would have taken him; but no man laid hands on him.

JOHN 7:45

45 Then came the officers to the chief priests and Pharisees; and they said unto them, Why have ye not brought him?

JOHN 7:46

46 The officers answered, Never man spake like this man.

JOHN 7:47

47 Then answered them the Pharisees, Are ye also deceived?

JOHN 7:48

48 Have any of the rulers or of the Pharisees believed on him?

JOHN 7:49

49 But this people who knoweth not the law are cursed.

JOHN 7:50

50 Nicodemus saith unto them, (he that came to Jesus by night, being one of them,)

JOHN 7:51

51 Doth our law judge any man, before it hear him, and know what he doeth?

JOHN 7:52

52 They answered and said unto him, Art thou also of Galilee? Search, and look: for out of Galilee ariseth no prophet.

JOHN 7:53

53 And every man went unto his own house.
