### LUKE 10:1

1 After these things the Lord appointed other seventy also, and sent them two and two before his face into every city and place, whither he himself would come.

## LUKE 10:2

2 Therefore said he unto them, The \_harvest \_truly *is* \_great, but the \_labourers *are* \_few: \_pray ye therefore the \_Lord of the \_harvest, that he would \_send \_forth \_labourers \_into his \_harvest.

## LUKE 10:3

**3** \_Go your ways: \_behold, I \_send you \_forth as \_lambs \_among \_wolves.

## LUKE 10:4

4 \_Carry \_neither \_purse, \_nor \_scrip, \_nor \_shoes: and \_salute \_no \_man by the \_way.

### LUKE 10:5

5 And \_into \_whatsoever \_house ye \_enter, \_first \_say, \_Peace be to \_this \_house.

### LUKE 10:6

6 And \_if the \_son of \_peace be \_there, \_your \_peace shall \_rest upon it: \_if not, it shall \_turn to you \_again.

# LUKE 10:7

7 And in the \_same \_house \_remain, \_eating and \_drinking such things as they \_give: for the \_labourer is \_worthy of his \_hire. \_Go not from \_house to \_house.

### LUKE 10:8

8 And \_into \_whatsoever \_city ye \_enter, and they \_receive you, \_eat such things as are \_set \_before you:

### LUKE 10:9

9 And \_heal the \_sick that are \_therein, and \_say unto them, The \_kingdom of \_God is \_come \_nigh unto you.

### LUKE 10:10

**10** But \_into \_whatsoever \_city ye \_enter, and they \_receive you not, \_go your ways out \_into the \_streets of the \_same, and \_say,

11 \_Even the very \_dust of \_your \_city, \_which \_cleaveth on us, we do \_wipe \_off

against you: \_notwithstanding be ye \_sure of \_this, that the \_kingdom of \_God is \_come \_nigh unto you.

## LUKE 10:12

**12** But I \_say unto you, that it shall be \_more \_tolerable in that \_day for \_Sodom, \_than for that \_city.

## LUKE 10:13

13 \_Woe unto thee, \_Chorazin! \_woe unto thee, \_Bethsaida! for \_if the \_mighty works had been \_done in \_Tyre and \_Sidon, \_which have been \_done in you, they had a \_great while \_ago \_repented, \_sitting in \_sackcloth and \_ashes.

## LUKE 10:14

14 \_But it shall be \_more \_tolerable for \_Tyre and \_Sidon \_at the \_judgment, \_than for you.

## LUKE 10:15

15 And thou, \_Capernaum, \_which art \_exalted to \_heaven, shalt be \_thrust \_down to \_hell.

### LUKE 10:16

**16** He that \_heareth you \_heareth me; and he that \_despiseth you \_despiseth me; and he that \_despiseth me \_despiseth him that \_sent me.

### LUKE 10:17

17 And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils are subject unto us through thy name.

### LUKE 10:18

18 And he said unto them, I \_beheld \_Satan as \_lightning \_fall from \_heaven.

### LUKE 10:19

**19** \_Behold, I \_give unto you \_power to \_tread \_on \_serpents and \_scorpions, and \_over \_all the \_power of the \_enemy: and \_nothing shall by \_any \_means \_hurt you.

### LUKE 10:20

**20** \_Notwithstanding in \_this \_rejoice not, that the \_spirits are \_subject unto you; but \_rather \_rejoice, \_because \_your \_names are \_written in \_heaven.

# LUKE 10:21

21 In that hour Jesus rejoiced in spirit, and said, I \_thank thee, O \_Father, \_Lord of \_heaven and \_earth, that thou hast \_hid \_these things from the \_wise and \_prudent, and hast \_revealed them unto \_babes: \_even \_so, \_Father; for \_so it \_seemed good in

thy \_sight.

## LUKE 10:22

22 \_All things are \_delivered to me of my \_Father: and \_no \_man \_knoweth \_who the \_Son is, but the \_Father; and \_who the \_Father is, but the \_Son, and *he* to \_whom the \_Son \_will \_reveal *him*.

# LUKE 10:23

23 And he turned him unto *his* disciples, and said privately, \_Blessed *are* the \_eyes \_which \_see the things that ye \_see:

## LUKE 10:24

**24** For I \_tell you, that \_many \_prophets and \_kings have \_desired to \_see those things \_which ye \_see, and have not \_seen *them*; and to \_hear those things \_which ye \_hear, and have not \_heard *them*.

## LUKE 10:25

25 And, behold, a certain lawyer stood up, and tempted him, saying, Master, what shall I do to inherit eternal life?

### LUKE 10:26

26 He said unto him, \_What is \_written in the \_law? \_how \_readest thou?

### LUKE 10:27

27 And he answering said, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy strength, and with all thy mind; and thy neighbour as thyself.

# LUKE 10:28

28 And he said unto him, Thou hast \_answered \_right: \_this \_do, and thou shalt \_live.

# LUKE 10:29

29 But he, willing to justify himself, said unto Jesus, And who is my neighbour?

# LUKE 10:30

**30** And Jesus answering said, A \_certain *man* \_went \_down from \_Jerusalem to \_Jericho, and \_fell \_among \_thieves, \_which \_stripped him of his raiment, and \_wounded *him*, and \_departed, \_leaving *him* \_half \_dead.

# LUKE 10:31

31 And by \_chance there \_came down a \_certain \_priest that \_way: and when he \_saw him, he \_passed by on the \_other \_side.

#### LUKE 10:32

32 And \_likewise a \_Levite, when he was \_at the \_place, \_came and \_looked *on him*, and \_passed by on the \_other \_side.

#### LUKE 10:33

**33** But a \_certain \_Samaritan, as he \_journeyed, \_came \_where he was: and when he \_saw him, he had \_compassion *on him*,

#### LUKE 10:34

34 And \_went to *him*, and \_bound up his \_wounds, \_pouring in \_oil and \_wine, and \_set him \_on his \_own \_beast, and \_brought him to an \_inn, and \_took \_care of him.

#### LUKE 10:35

**35** And \_on the \_morrow when he \_departed, he \_took out \_two \_pence, and \_gave *them* to the \_host, and \_said unto him, Take \_care of him; and \_whatsoever thou \_spendest \_more, \_when I \_come \_again, I will \_repay thee.

#### LUKE 10:36

**36** \_Which \_now of \_these \_three, \_thinkest thou, was \_neighbour unto him that \_fell \_among the \_thieves?

#### LUKE 10:37

37 And he said, He that shewed mercy on him. Then said Jesus unto him, <u>Go</u>, and <u>do</u> thou likewise.

# LUKE 10:38

38 Now it came to pass, as they went, that he entered into a certain village: and a certain woman named Martha received him into her house.

#### LUKE 10:39

39 And she had a sister called Mary, which also sat at Jesus' feet, and heard his word.

#### LUKE 10:40

40 But Martha was cumbered about much serving, and came to him, and said, Lord, dost thou not care that my sister hath left me to serve alone? bid her therefore that she help me.

### LUKE 10:41

41 And Jesus answered and said unto her, \_Martha, \_Martha, thou art \_careful and \_troubled \_about \_many things:

42 But \_one thing is \_needful: and \_Mary hath \_chosen that \_good \_part, \_which shall not be \_taken \_away from her.
