## LUKE 12:1

1 ¶ In the mean time, when there were gathered together an innumerable multitude of people, insomuch that they trode one upon another, he began to say unto his disciples first of all, **Beware ye of the leaven of the Pharisees, which is hypocrisy.**

## LUKE 12:2

2 For there is **nothing covered, that shall not be revealed; neither hid, that shall not be known.**

## LUKE 12:3

3 **Therefore whatsoever ye have spoken in darkness shall be heard in the light; and that which ye have spoken in the ear in closets shall be proclaimed upon the housetops.**

## LUKE 12:4

4 And I **say unto you my friends, Be not afraid of them that kill the body, and after that have no more that they can do.**

## LUKE 12:5

5 But I will **forewarn you whom ye shall fear: Fear him, which after he hath killed hath power to cast into hell; yea, I say unto you, Fear him.**

## LUKE 12:6

6 Are not **five sparrows sold for two farthings, and not one of them is forgotten before God?**

## LUKE 12:7

7 But **even the very hairs of your head are all numbered. Fear not therefore: ye are of more value than many sparrows.**

## LUKE 12:8

8 **Also I say unto you, Whosoever shall confess me before men, him shall the Son of man also confess before the angels of God:**

## LUKE 12:9

9 But he that **denieth me before men shall be denied before the angels of God.**

## LUKE 12:10

10 And **whosoever shall speak a word against the Son of man, it shall be forgiven him: but unto him that blasphemeth against the Holy Ghost it shall not be**

\_forgiven.

LUKE 12:11

11 And \_when they \_bring you unto the \_synagogues, and *unto* \_magistrates, and \_powers, take ye \_no \_thought \_how \_or \_what thing ye shall \_answer, \_or \_what ye shall \_say:

LUKE 12:12

12 For the \_Holy \_Ghost shall \_teach you in the \_same \_hour \_what ye \_ought to \_say.

LUKE 12:13

13 ¶ And one of the company said unto him, Master, speak to my brother, that he divide the inheritance with me.

LUKE 12:14

14 And he said unto him, \_Man, \_who \_made me a \_judge \_or a \_divider \_over you?

LUKE 12:15

15 And he said unto them, Take \_heed, and \_beware of \_covetousness: for a \_man's \_life \_consisteth not in the \_abundance of the things which he \_possesseth.

LUKE 12:16

16 And he spake a parable unto them, saying, The \_ground of a \_certain \_rich \_man \_brought \_forth \_plentifully:

LUKE 12:17

17 And he \_thought \_within \_himself, \_saying, \_What shall I \_do, \_because I \_have \_no room \_where to \_bestow my \_fruits?

LUKE 12:18

18 And he \_said, \_This will I \_do: I will \_pull \_down my \_barns, and \_build \_greater; and \_there will I \_bestow \_all my \_fruits and my \_goods.

LUKE 12:19

19 And I will \_say to my \_soul, \_Soul, thou \_hast \_much \_goods \_laid up for \_many \_years; take thine \_ease, \_eat, \_drink, *and* be \_merry.

LUKE 12:20

20 But \_God \_said unto him, *Thou* \_fool, \_this \_night thy \_soul shall be \_required of thee: \_then \_whose shall those things be, \_which thou hast \_provided?

LUKE 12:21

21 *So is he that layeth up treasure for himself, and is not rich toward God.*

LUKE 12:22

22 ¶ And he said unto his disciples, *Therefore I say unto you, Take no thought for your life, what ye shall eat; neither for the body, what ye shall put on.*

LUKE 12:23

23 *The life is more than meat, and the body is more than raiment.*

LUKE 12:24

24 *Consider the ravens: for they neither sow nor reap; which neither have storehouse nor barn; and God feedeth them: how much more are ye better than the fowls?*

LUKE 12:25

25 *And which of you with taking thought can add to his stature one cubit?*

LUKE 12:26

26 *If ye then be not able to do that thing which is least, why take ye thought for the rest?*

LUKE 12:27

27 *Consider the lilies how they grow: they toil not, they spin not; and yet I say unto you, that Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these.*

LUKE 12:28

28 *If then God so clothe the grass, which is to day in the field, and to morrow is cast into the oven; how much more will he clothe you, O ye of little faith?*

LUKE 12:29

29 *And seek not ye what ye shall eat, or what ye shall drink, neither be ye of doubtful mind.*

LUKE 12:30

30 *For all these things do the nations of the world seek after: and your Father knoweth that ye have need of these things.*

LUKE 12:31

31 *But rather seek ye the kingdom of God; and all these things shall be added unto you.*

## LUKE 12:32

32 \_Fear not, \_little \_flock; for it is \_your \_Father's good \_pleasure to \_give you the \_kingdom.

## LUKE 12:33

33 \_Sell that ye \_have, and \_give \_alms; \_provide \_yourselves \_bags which \_wax not \_old, a \_treasure in the \_heavens that \_faileth not, \_where \_no \_thief \_approacheth, \_neither \_moth \_corrupteth.

## LUKE 12:34

34 For \_where \_your \_treasure is, \_there will \_your \_heart be \_also.

## LUKE 12:35

35 Let \_your \_loins be \_girded \_about, and *your* \_lights \_burning;

## LUKE 12:36

36 And ye yourselves \_like unto \_men that \_wait for their \_lord, \_when he will \_return from the \_wedding; that when he \_cometh and \_knocketh, they may \_open unto him \_immediately.

## LUKE 12:37

37 \_Blessed *are* \_those \_servants, \_whom the \_lord when he \_cometh shall \_find \_watching: \_verily I \_say unto you, that he shall \_gird himself, and \_make them to \_sit \_down to meat, and will \_come \_forth and \_serve them.

## LUKE 12:38

38 And \_if he shall \_come in the \_second \_watch, \_or \_come in the \_third \_watch, and \_find *them* \_so, \_blessed are \_those \_servants.

## LUKE 12:39

39 And \_this \_know, that \_if the \_goodman of the \_house had \_known \_what \_hour the \_thief would \_come, he would have \_watched, and not have \_suffered his \_house to be \_broken \_through.

## LUKE 12:40

40 Be ye \_therefore \_ready \_also: for the \_Son of \_man \_cometh at an \_hour when ye \_think not.

## LUKE 12:41

41 ¶ Then Peter said unto him, Lord, speakest thou this parable unto us, or even to all?

## LUKE 12:42

42 And the Lord said, *Who then is that faithful and wise steward, whom his lord shall make ruler over his household, to give them their portion of meat in due season?*

## LUKE 12:43

43 *Blessed is that servant, whom his lord when he cometh shall find so doing.*

## LUKE 12:44

44 Of a truth I say unto you, that he will make him ruler over all that he hath.

## LUKE 12:45

45 But and if that servant say in his heart, My lord delayeth his coming; and shall begin to beat the menservants and maidens, and to eat and drink, and to be drunken;

## LUKE 12:46

46 The lord of that servant will come in a day when he looketh not for him, and at an hour when he is not aware, and will cut him in sunder, and will appoint him his portion with the unbelievers.

## LUKE 12:47

47 And that servant, which knew his lord's will, and prepared not himself, neither did according to his will, shall be beaten with many stripes.

## LUKE 12:48

48 But he that knew not, and did commit things worthy of stripes, shall be beaten with few stripes. For unto whomsoever much is given, of him shall be much required: and to whom men have committed much, of him they will ask the more.

## LUKE 12:49

49 I am come to send fire on the earth; and what will I, if it be already kindled?

## LUKE 12:50

50 But I have a baptism to be baptized with; and how am I straitened till it be accomplished!

## LUKE 12:51

51 *Suppose ye that I am come to give peace on earth? I tell you, Nay; but rather division:*

## LUKE 12:52

52 For from henceforth there shall be five in one house divided, three against two, and two against three.

## LUKE 12:53

53 The father shall be divided against the son, and the son against the father; the mother against the daughter, and the daughter against the mother; the mother in law against her daughter in law, and the daughter in law against her mother in law.

## LUKE 12:54

54 ¶ And he said also to the people, When ye see a cloud rise out of the west, straightway ye say, There cometh a shower; and so it is.

## LUKE 12:55

55 And when ye see the south wind blow, ye say, There will be heat; and it cometh to pass.

## LUKE 12:56

56 Ye hypocrites, ye can discern the face of the sky and of the earth; but how is it that ye do not discern this time?

## LUKE 12:57

57 Yea, and why even of yourselves judge ye not what is right?

## LUKE 12:58

58 When thou goest with thine adversary to the magistrate, as thou art in the way, give diligence that thou mayest be delivered from him; lest he hale thee to the judge, and the judge deliver thee to the officer, and the officer cast thee into prison.

## LUKE 12:59

59 I tell thee, thou shalt not depart thence, till thou hast paid the very last mite.
