LUKE 14

LUKE 14:1

1 And it came to pass, as he went into the house of one of the chief Pharisees to eat bread on the sabbath day, that they watched him.

LUKE 14:2

2 And, behold, there was a certain man before him which had the dropsy.

LUKE 14:3

3 And Jesus answering spake unto the lawyers and Pharisees, saying, Is it _lawful to _heal on the _sabbath day?

LUKE 14:4

4 And they held their peace. And he took him, and healed him, and let him go;

LUKE 14:5

5 And answered them, saying, _Which of you shall have an _ass _or an _ox _fallen _into a _pit, and will not _straightway _pull him out _on the _sabbath _day?

LUKE 14:6

6 And they could not answer him again to these things.

LUKE 14:7

7 ¶ And he put forth a parable to those which were bidden, when he marked how they chose out the chief rooms; saying unto them,

LUKE 14:8

8 _When thou art _bidden of _any *man* to a _wedding, _sit not _down in the _highest _room; _lest a more _honourable man than thou be _bidden of him;

LUKE 14:9

9 And he that _bade thee and him _come and _say to thee, _Give _this man _place; and thou _begin with _shame to _take the _lowest _room.

LUKE 14:10

10 But _when thou art _bidden, _go and _sit _down in the _lowest _room; that _when he that _bade thee _cometh, he may _say unto thee, _Friend, _go up _higher: _then shalt thou _have _worship in the _presence of them that _sit _at meat with thee.

LUKE 14:11

11 For _whosoever _exalteth _himself shall be _abased; and he that _humbleth

_himself shall be _exalted.

LUKE 14:12

12 Then said he also to him that bade him, _When thou _makest a _dinner _or a _supper, _call not thy _friends, _nor thy _brethren, _neither thy _kinsmen, _nor thy _rich _neighbours; _lest they _also _bid thee _again, and a _recompence be _made thee.

LUKE 14:13

13 But _when thou _makest a _feast, _call the _poor, the _maimed, the _lame, the blind:

LUKE 14:14

14 And thou shalt be _blessed; for they _cannot _recompense thee: for thou shalt be _recompensed _at the _resurrection of the _just.

LUKE 14:15

15 ¶ And when one of them that sat at meat with him heard these things, he said unto him, Blessed is he that shall eat bread in the kingdom of God.

LUKE 14:16

16 Then said he unto him, A _certain _man _made a _great _supper, and _bade _many:

LUKE 14:17

17 And _sent his _servant at _supper _time to _say to them that were _bidden, _Come; for _all things are _now _ready.

LUKE 14:18

18 And they _all with _one *consent* _began to _make _excuse. The _first _said unto him, I have _bought a piece of _ground, and I _must _needs _go and _see it: I _pray thee _have me _excused.

LUKE 14:19

19 And _another _said, I have _bought _five _yoke of _oxen, and I _go to _prove them: I _pray thee _have me excused.

LUKE 14:20

20 And _another _said, I have _married a _wife, and _therefore I _cannot _come.

LUKE 14:21

21 _So that _servant _came, and _shewed his _lord _these things. _Then the _master of the _house being _angry _said to his _servant, _Go out _quickly _into the

_streets and _lanes of the _city, and _bring in _hither the _poor, and the _maimed, and the _halt, and the _blind.

LUKE 14:22

22 And the _servant _said, _Lord, it is _done as thou hast _commanded, and _yet there is _room.

LUKE 14:23

23 And the _lord _said unto the _servant, _Go out _into the _highways and _hedges, and _compel *them* to _come in, that my _house may be _filled.

LUKE 14:24

24 For I _say unto you, That _none of _those _men _which were _bidden shall _taste of my _supper.

LUKE 14:25

25 And there went great multitudes with him: and he turned, and said unto them,

LUKE 14:26

26 _If _any *man* _come to me, and _hate not his _father, and _mother, and _wife, and _children, and _brethren, and _sisters, _yea, and his _own _life _also, he _cannot be my _disciple.

LUKE 14:27

27 And _whosoever doth not _bear his _cross, and _come _after me, _cannot be my _disciple.

LUKE 14:28

28 For _which of you, _intending to _build a _tower, _sitteth not _down _first, and _counteth the _cost, _whether he _have *sufficient* to _finish *it*?

LUKE 14:29

29 _Lest _haply, after he hath _laid the _foundation, and is not _able to _finish *it*, _all that _behold *it* _begin to _mock him,

LUKE 14:30

30 _Saying, _This _man _began to _build, and was not _able to _finish.

LUKE 14:31

31 _Or _what _king, _going to _make _war against _another _king, _sitteth not _down _first, and _consulteth _whether he be _able with _ten _thousand to _meet him that _cometh _against him with _twenty _thousand?

LUKE 14:32

32 _Or _else, while the _other is _yet a great _way off, he _sendeth an _ambassage, and _desireth _conditions of _peace.

LUKE 14:33

33 _So _likewise, _whosoever he be of you that _forsaketh not _all that he _hath, he _cannot be my _disciple.

LUKE 14:34

34 _Salt *is* _good: but _if the _salt have _lost his _savour, _wherewith shall it be _seasoned?

LUKE 14:35

35 It is _neither _fit for the _land, _nor yet for the _dunghill; *but* men _cast it out. He that _hath _ears to _hear, let him _hear.
