LUKE 15:1

1 Then drew near unto him all the publicans and sinners for to hear him.

LUKE 15:2

2 And the Pharisees and scribes murmured, saying, This man receiveth sinners, and eateth with them.

LUKE 15:3

3 And he spake this parable unto them, saying,

LUKF 15:4

4 _What _man of you, _having an _hundred _sheep, if he _lose _one of them, doth not _leave the _ninety and _nine in the _wilderness, and _go _after that which is _lost, _until he _find it?

LUKE 15:5

5 And when he hath _found *it*, he _layeth *it* _on his _shoulders, _rejoicing.

LUKE 15:6

6 And when he _cometh _home, he _calleth _together *his* _friends and _neighbours, saying unto them, Rejoice with me; for I have found my sheep which was lost.

LUKE 15:7

7 I _say unto you, that _likewise _joy shall be in _heaven _over _one _sinner that _repenteth, more _than _over _ninety and _nine _just persons, _which _need _no _repentance.

LUKE 15:8

8 _Either _what _woman _having _ten _pieces of _silver, _if she _lose _one _piece, doth not _light a _candle, and _sweep the _house, and _seek _diligently _till she _find it?

LUKE 15:9

9 And when she hath _found *it*, she _calleth *her* _friends and *her* _neighbours together, saving, Rejoice with me; for I have found the piece which I had lost.

LUKE 15:10

10 _Likewise, I _say unto you, there is _joy in the _presence of the _angels of _God _over _one _sinner that _repenteth.

LUKE 15:11

11 ¶ And he said, A _certain _man _had _two _sons:

LUKE 15:12

12 And the _younger of them _said to *his* _father, _Father, _give me the _portion of _goods that _falleth *to me*. And he _divided unto them *his* _living.

LUKE 15:13

13 And not _many _days _after the _younger _son _gathered _all _together, and _took his _journey _into a _far _country, and _there _wasted his _substance with _riotous _living.

LUKE 15:14

14 And when he had _spent _all, there _arose a _mighty _famine in that _land; and he _began to be in _want.

LUKE 15:15

15 And he _went and _joined himself to a _citizen of that _country; and he _sent him _into his _fields to _feed _swine.

LUKE 15:16

16 And he would _fain have _filled his _belly with the _husks that the _swine did _eat: and _no _man _gave unto him.

LUKE 15:17

17 And when he _came to _himself, he _said, _How _many _hired _servants of my _father's have _bread _enough and to _spare, and I _perish with _hunger!

LUKE 15:18

18 I will _arise and _go to my _father, and will _say unto him, _Father, I have sinned against heaven, and before thee,

LUKE 15:19

19 And _am _no _more _worthy to be _called thy _son: _make me as _one of thy _hired _servants.

LUKE 15:20

20 And he _arose, and _came to his _father. But when he was _yet a _great _way _off, his _father _saw him, and had _compassion, and _ran, and _fell _on his _neck, and _kissed him.

LUKE 15:21

21 And the _son _said unto him, _Father, I have _sinned _against _heaven, and in thy _sight, and _am _no _more _worthy to be _called thy _son.

LUKE 15:22

22 But the _father _said to his _servants, _Bring _forth the _best _robe, and _put *it* _on him; and _put a _ring _on his _hand, and _shoes _on *his* _feet:

LUKE 15:23

23 And _bring hither the _fatted _calf, and _kill *it*; and let us _eat, and be _merry:

LUKE 15:24

24 For _this my _son was _dead, and is _alive _again; he was _lost, and is _found. And they _began to be _merry.

LUKE 15:25

25 _Now his _elder _son was in the _field: and as he _came and drew _nigh to the _house, he _heard _musick and _dancing.

LUKE 15:26

26 And he _called _one of the _servants, and _asked _what _these things _meant.

LUKE 15:27

27 And he _said unto him, Thy _brother is _come; and thy _father hath _killed the _fatted _calf, _because he hath _received him _safe and _sound.

LUKE 15:28

28 And he was _angry, and _would not _go in: _therefore _came his _father out, and intreated him.

LUKE 15:29

29 And he _answering _said to *his* _father, _Lo, _these _many _years do I _serve thee, _neither _transgressed I _at _any time thy _commandment: and yet thou _never _gavest me a _kid, that I might _make _merry with my _friends:

LUKE 15:30

30 But as _soon as _this thy _son was _come, _which hath _devoured thy _living with _harlots, thou hast _killed for him the _fatted _calf.

LUKE 15:31

31 And he _said unto him, _Son, _thou _art _ever with me, and _all that I _have is _thine.

LUKE 15:32

32 It was _meet that we should _make _merry, and be _glad: for _this thy _brother was _dead, and is _alive _again; and was _lost, and is _found.
