LUKE 16

LUKE 16:1

1 And he said also unto his disciples, There was a _certain _rich _man, _which _had a _steward; and the _same was _accused unto him that he had _wasted his _goods.

LUKE 16:2

2 And he _called him, and _said unto him, _How is it that I _hear _this of thee? _give an _account of thy _stewardship; for thou _mayest be _no _longer _steward.

LUKE 16:3

3 _Then the _steward _said _within _himself, _What shall I _do? for my _lord _taketh _away from me the _stewardship: I _cannot _dig; to _beg I am _ashamed.

LUKE 16:4

4 I am _resolved _what to _do, that, _when I am _put out of the _stewardship, they may _receive me _into their _houses.

LUKE 16:5

5 _So he _called _every _one of his _lord's _debtors *unto him*, and _said unto the _first, _How _much _owest thou unto my _lord?

LUKE 16:6

6 And he _said, An _hundred _measures of _oil. And he _said unto him, _Take thy _bill, and _sit _down _quickly, and _write _fifty.

LUKE 16:7

7 _Then _said he to _another, And _how _much _owest thou? And he _said, An _hundred _measures of _wheat. And he _said unto him, _Take thy _bill, and _write _fourscore.

LUKE 16:8

8 And the _lord _commended the _unjust _steward, _because he had _done _wisely: for the _children of _this _world are in their _generation _wiser _than the _children of _light.

LUKE 16:9

9 And I _say unto you, _Make to _yourselves _friends of the _mammon of _unrighteousness; that, _when ye _fail, they may _receive you _into _everlasting _habitations.

LUKE 16:10

10 He that is _faithful in that which is _least is _faithful _also in _much: and he that is _unjust in the _least is _unjust _also in _much.

LUKE 16:11

11 _If _therefore ye have not _been _faithful in the _unrighteous _mammon, _who will _commit to _your _trust the _true *riches*?

LUKE 16:12

12 And _if ye have not _been _faithful in that which is _another _man's, _who shall _give you that which is _your own?

LUKE 16:13

13 _No _servant _can _serve _two _masters: for _either he will _hate the _one, and _love the _other; _or else he will _hold to the _one, and _despise the _other. Ye _cannot _serve _God and _mammon.

LUKE 16:14

14 And the Pharisees also, who were covetous, heard all these things: and they derided him.

LUKE 16:15

15 And he said unto them, Ye are they _which _justify _yourselves _before _men; but _God _knoweth _your _hearts: for that which is _highly esteemed _among _men is _abomination in the _sight of _God.

LUKE 16:16

16 The _law and the _prophets *were* _until _John: _since that _time the _kingdom of _God is _preached, and _every man _presseth _into it.

LUKE 16:17

17 And it is _easier for _heaven and _earth to _pass, _than _one _tittle of the _law to fail.

LUKE 16:18

18 _Whosoever _putteth _away his _wife, and _marrieth _another, _committeth _adultery: and _whosoever _marrieth her that is _put _away from *her* _husband _committeth _adultery.

LUKE 16:19

19 There was a _certain _rich _man, _which was _clothed in _purple and fine _linen, and _fared _sumptuously _every _day:

LUKE 16:20

20 And there was a _certain _beggar _named _Lazarus, _which was _laid _at his _gate, full of _sores,

LUKE 16:21

21 And _desiring to be _fed with the _crumbs _which _fell from the _rich man's _table: _moreover the _dogs _came and _licked his _sores.

LUKE 16:22

22 And it _came to pass, that the _beggar _died, and was _carried by the _angels _into _Abraham's _bosom: the _rich man _also _died, and was _buried;

LUKE 16:23

23 And in _hell he _lift up his _eyes, _being in _torments, and _seeth _Abraham _afar _off, and _Lazarus in his _bosom.

LUKE 16:24

24 And he _cried and _said, _Father _Abraham, have _mercy on me, and _send _Lazarus, that he may _dip the _tip of his _finger in _water, and _cool my _tongue; for I am _tormented in _this _flame.

LUKE 16:25

25 But _Abraham _said, _Son, _remember that _thou in thy _lifetime _receivedst thy _good things, and _likewise _Lazarus _evil things: but _now _he is _comforted, and _thou art _tormented.

LUKE 16:26

26 And _beside _all _this, _between us and you there is a _great _gulf _fixed: _so that they which _would _pass from _hence to you _cannot; _neither _can they _pass to us, that would come from _thence.

LUKE 16:27

27 _Then he _said, I _pray thee _therefore, _father, that thou wouldest _send him to my _father's _house:

LUKE 16:28

28 For I _have _five _brethren; that he may _testify unto them, _lest they _also _come _into _this _place of _torment.

LUKE 16:29

29 _Abraham _saith unto him, They _have _Moses and the _prophets; let them hear them.

LUKE 16:30

30 And he _said, _Nay, _father _Abraham: but _if _one _went unto them from the

_dead, they will _repent.

LUKE 16:31

31 And he _said unto him, _If they _hear not _Moses and the _prophets, _neither will they be _persuaded, _though _one _rose from the _dead.
