LUKE 18

LUKE 18:1

1 ¶ And he spake a parable unto them *to this end*, that men ought always to pray, and not to faint;

LUKE 18:2

2 Saying, There was in a _city a _judge, which _feared not _God, _neither _regarded _man:

LUKE 18:3

3 And there was a _widow in that _city; and she _came unto him, _saying, _Avenge me of _mine _adversary.

LUKE 18:4

4 And he _would not for a _while: but _afterward he _said _within _himself, _Though I _fear not _God, _nor _regard _man;

LUKE 18:5

5 _Yet _because _this _widow _troubleth me, I will _avenge her, _lest by her _continual _coming she _weary me.

LUKE 18:6

6 And the Lord said, _Hear _what the _unjust _judge _saith.

LUKE 18:7

7 And shall not _God _avenge his own _elect, _which _cry _day and _night unto him, _though he _bear _long with them?

LUKE 18:8

8 I _tell you that he will _avenge them _speedily. _Nevertheless when the _Son of _man _cometh, _shall _he _find _faith _on the _earth?

LUKE 18:9

9 ¶ And he spake this parable unto certain which trusted in themselves that they were righteous, and despised others:

LUKE 18:10

10 _Two _men _went up _into the _temple to _pray; the _one a _Pharisee, and the _other a _publican.

LUKE 18:11

11 The _Pharisee _stood and _prayed _thus with _himself, _God, I _thank thee, that I _am not as _other _men are, _extortioners, _unjust, _adulterers, _or _even as _this _publican.

LUKE 18:12

12 I _fast _twice in the _week, I give _tithes of _all that I _possess.

LUKE 18:13

13 And the _publican, _standing _afar off, _would not _lift up _so _much as *his* _eyes unto _heaven, but _smote upon his _breast, _saying, _God be _merciful to me a _sinner.

LUKE 18:14

14 I _tell you, _this man _went _down to his _house _justified *rather* _than the _other: for _every one that _exalteth _himself shall be _abased; and he that _humbleth _himself shall be _exalted.

LUKE 18:15

15 ¶ And they brought unto him also infants, that he would touch them: but when his disciples saw it, they rebuked them.

LUKE 18:16

16 But Jesus called them *unto him*, and said, _Suffer _little _children to _come unto me, and _forbid them not: for of _such is the _kingdom of _God.

LUKE 18:17

17 _Verily I _say unto you, _Whosoever shall _not _receive the _kingdom of _God as a _little _child shall in _no wise _enter _therein.

LUKE 18:18

18 And a certain ruler asked him, saying, Good Master, what shall I do to inherit eternal life?

LUKE 18:19

19 And Jesus said unto him, _Why _callest thou me _good? _none *is* _good, _save _one, *that is*, _God.

LUKE 18:20

20 Thou _knowest the _commandments, Do not _commit _adultery, Do not _kill, Do not _steal, Do not _bear _false _witness, _Honour thy _father and thy _mother.

LUKE 18:21

21 And he said, All these have I kept from my youth up.

LUKE 18:22

22 Now when Jesus heard these things, he said unto him, _Yet _lackest thou _one thing: _sell _all that thou _hast, and _distribute unto the _poor, and thou shalt _have treasure in heaven: and come, follow me.

LUKE 18:23

23 And when he heard this, he was very sorrowful: for he was very rich.

LUKE 18:24

24 And when Jesus saw that he was very sorrowful, he said, _How _hardly shall they that _have _riches _enter _into the _kingdom of _God!

LUKE 18:25

25 For it is _easier for a _camel to _go _through a _needle's _eye, _than for a _rich man to _enter _into the _kingdom of _God.

LUKE 18:26

26 And they that heard it said, Who then can be saved?

LUKE 18:27

27 And he said, The things which are _impossible with _men are _possible with _God.

LUKE 18:28

28 Then Peter said, Lo, we have left all, and followed thee.

LUKE 18:29

29 And he said unto them, _Verily I _say unto you, There is _no _man that hath _left _house, _or _parents, _or _brethren, _or _wife, _or _children, for the _kingdom of God's sake,

LUKE 18:30

30 _Who shall not _receive _manifold _more in _this present _time, and in the _world to _come _life _everlasting.

LUKE 18:31

31 Then he took *unto him* the twelve, and said unto them, _Behold, we _go up to _Jerusalem, and _all things that are _written by the _prophets concerning the _Son of _man shall be _accomplished.

LUKE 18:32

32 For he shall be _delivered unto the _Gentiles, and shall be _mocked, and

_spitefully _entreated, and _spitted _on:

LUKE 18:33

33 And they shall _scourge *him*, and _put him to _death: and the _third _day he shall _rise _again.

LUKE 18:34

34 And they understood none of these things: and this saying was hid from them, neither knew they the things which were spoken.

LUKE 18:35

35 ¶ And it came to pass, that as he was come nigh unto Jericho, a certain blind man sat by the way side begging:

LUKE 18:36

36 And hearing the multitude pass by, he asked what it meant.

LUKE 18:37

37 And they told him, that Jesus of Nazareth passeth by.

LUKE 18:38

38 And he cried, saying, Jesus, thou Son of David, have mercy on me.

LUKE 18:39

39 And they which went before rebuked him, that he should hold his peace: but he cried so much the more, *Thou* Son of David, have mercy on me.

LUKE 18:40

40 And Jesus stood, and commanded him to be brought unto him: and when he was come near, he asked him,

LUKE 18:41

41 Saying, _What _wilt thou that I shall _do unto thee? And he said, Lord, that I may receive my sight.

LUKE 18:42

42 And Jesus said unto him, _Receive thy _sight: thy _faith hath _saved thee.

LUKE 18:43

43 And immediately he received his sight, and followed him, glorifying God: and all the people, when they saw *it*, gave praise unto God.
