LUKE 19

LUKE 19:1

1 And *Jesus* entered and passed through Jericho.

LUKE 19:2

2 And, behold, *there was* a man named Zacchaeus, which was the chief among the publicans, and he was rich.

LUKE 19:3

3 And he sought to see Jesus who he was; and could not for the press, because he was little of stature.

LUKE 19:4

4 And he ran before, and climbed up into a sycomore tree to see him: for he was to pass that *way*.

LUKE 19:5

5 And when Jesus came to the place, he looked up, and saw him, and said unto him, _Zacchaeus, _make _haste, and _come _down; for to _day I _must _abide _at thy _house.

LUKE 19:6

6 And he made haste, and came down, and received him joyfully.

LUKE 19:7

7 And when they saw *it*, they all murmured, saying, That he was gone to be guest with a man that is a sinner.

LUKE 19:8

8 And Zacchaeus stood, and said unto the Lord; Behold, Lord, the half of my goods I give to the poor; and if I have taken any thing from any man by false accusation, I restore *him* fourfold.

LUKE 19:9

9 And Jesus said unto him, _This _day is _salvation _come to _this _house, _forsomuch as he _also is a _son of _Abraham.

LUKE 19:10

10 For the _Son of _man is _come to _seek and to _save that which was _lost.

LUKE 19:11

11 ¶ And as they heard these things, he added and spake a parable, because he was nigh to Jerusalem, and because they thought that the kingdom of God should immediately appear.

LUKE 19:12

12 He said therefore, A _certain _nobleman _went _into a _far _country to _receive for _himself a _kingdom, and to _return.

LUKE 19:13

13 And he _called his _ten _servants, and _delivered them _ten _pounds, and _said unto them, Occupy till I come.

LUKE 19:14

14 But his _citizens _hated him, and _sent a _message _after him, _saying, We _will not have _this *man* to _reign _over us.

LUKE 19:15

15 And it _came to pass, that _when he was _returned, having _received the _kingdom, then he _commanded _these _servants to be _called unto him, to _whom he had _given the _money, that he might _know _how much _every man had _gained by _trading.

LUKE 19:16

16 _Then _came the _first, _saying, _Lord, thy _pound hath _gained _ten _pounds.

LUKE 19:17

17 And he _said unto him, _Well, thou _good _servant: _because thou hast _been _faithful in a _very _little, _have thou _authority _over _ten _cities.

LUKE 19:18

18 And the _second _came, _saying, _Lord, thy _pound hath _gained _five _pounds.

LUKE 19:19

19 And he _said _likewise to him, Be thou _also _over _five _cities.

LUKE 19:20

20 And _another _came, _saying, _Lord, _behold, *here is* thy _pound, _which I have _kept _laid up in a _napkin:

LUKE 19:21

21 For I _feared thee, _because thou art an _austere _man: thou _takest up that thou _layedst not down, and _reapest that thou didst not _sow.

LUKE 19:22

22 And he _saith unto him, Out of _thine own _mouth will I _judge thee, thou _wicked _servant. Thou _knewest that I was an _austere _man, _taking up that I _laid not down, and _reaping that I did not _sow:

LUKE 19:23

23 _Wherefore _then _gavest not thou my _money _into the _bank, that at my _coming I might have _required _mine own with _usury?

LUKE 19:24

24 And he _said unto them that _stood by, _Take from him the _pound, and _give *it* to him that _hath _ten _pounds.

LUKE 19:25

25 (And they _said unto him, _Lord, he _hath _ten _pounds.)

LUKE 19:26

26 For I _say unto you, That unto _every one _which _hath shall be _given; and from him that _hath not, _even that he _hath shall be _taken away from him.

LUKE 19:27

27 _But _those _mine _enemies, _which _would not that I should _reign _over them, bring hither, and slay *them* before me.

LUKE 19:28

28 ¶ And when he had thus spoken, he went before, ascending up to Jerusalem.

LUKE 19:29

29 And it came to pass, when he was come nigh to Bethphage and Bethany, at the mount called *the mount* of Olives, he sent two of his disciples,

LUKE 19:30

30 _Saying, _Go ye _into the _village _over _against *you*; in the _which _at your _entering ye shall _find a _colt _tied, _whereon yet _never _man _sat: _loose him, and _bring *him hither*.

LUKE 19:31

31 And _if _any man _ask you, _Why do ye _loose *him*? _thus shall ye _say unto him, _Because the _Lord _hath _need of him.

LUKE 19:32

32 And they that were sent went their way, and found even as he had said unto

them.

LUKE 19:33

33 And as they were loosing the colt, the owners thereof said unto them, Why loose ye the colt?

LUKE 19:34

34 And they said, The Lord hath need of him.

LUKE 19:35

35 And they brought him to Jesus: and they cast their garments upon the colt, and they set Jesus thereon.

LUKE 19:36

36 And as he went, they spread their clothes in the way.

LUKE 19:37

37 And when he was come nigh, even now at the descent of the mount of Olives, the whole multitude of the disciples began to rejoice and praise God with a loud voice for all the mighty works that they had seen;

LUKE 19:38

38 Saying, Blessed *be* the King that cometh in the name of the Lord: peace in heaven, and glory in the highest.

LUKE 19:39

39 And some of the Pharisees from among the multitude said unto him, Master, rebuke thy disciples.

LUKE 19:40

40 And he answered and said unto them, I _tell you that, _if _these should _hold their _peace, the _stones would immediately _cry out.

LUKE 19:41

41 ¶ And when he was come near, he beheld the city, and wept over it,

LUKE 19:42

42 Saying, _If _thou hadst _known, _even _thou, _at _least in _this thy _day, the things *which belong* unto thy _peace! but _now they are _hid from _thine _eyes.

LUKE 19:43

43 For the _days shall _come upon thee, that _thine _enemies shall _cast a _trench _about thee, and _compass thee _round, and _keep thee in _on _every _side,

LUKE 19:44

44 And shall _lay thee even with the _ground, and thy _children _within thee; and they shall not _leave in thee one _stone upon another; _because thou _knewest not the _time of thy _visitation.

LUKE 19:45

45 And he went into the temple, and began to cast out them that sold therein, and them that bought;

LUKE 19:46

46 Saying unto them, It is _written, My _house is the _house of _prayer: but ye have _made it a _den of _thieves.

LUKE 19:47

47 And he taught daily in the temple. But the chief priests and the scribes and the chief of the people sought to destroy him,

LUKE 19:48

48 And could not find what they might do: for all the people were very attentive to hear him.
