LUKE 20

LUKE 20:1

1 And it came to pass, *that* on one of those days, as he taught the people in the temple, and preached the gospel, the chief priests and the scribes came upon *him* with the elders,

LUKE 20:2

2 And spake unto him, saying, Tell us, by what authority doest thou these things? or who is he that gave thee this authority?

LUKE 20:3

3 And he answered and said unto them, I will _also _ask you _one _thing; and _answer me:

LUKE 20:4

4 The _baptism of _John, was it from _heaven, _or of _men?

LUKE 20:5

5 And they reasoned with themselves, saying, If we shall say, From heaven; he will say, Why then believed ye him not?

LUKE 20:6

6 But and if we say, Of men; all the people will stone us: for they be persuaded that John was a prophet.

LUKE 20:7

7 And they answered, that they could not tell whence *it was*.

LUKE 20:8

8 And Jesus said unto them, _Neither _tell I you by _what _authority I _do _these things.

LUKE 20:9

9 Then began he to speak to the people this parable; A _certain _man _planted a _vineyard, and _let it _forth to _husbandmen, and _went into a far _country for a _long _time.

LUKE 20:10

10 And _at the _season he _sent a _servant to the _husbandmen, that they should _give him of the _fruit of the _vineyard: but the _husbandmen _beat him, and _sent him _away _empty.

LUKE 20:11

11 And _again he _sent _another _servant: and they _beat him also, and _entreated *him* _shamefully, and _sent *him* _away _empty.

LUKE 20:12

12 And _again he _sent a _third: and they _wounded him _also, and _cast *him* out.

LUKE 20:13

13 _Then _said the _lord of the _vineyard, _What shall I _do? I will _send my _beloved _son: it _may be they will _reverence *him* when they _see him.

LUKE 20:14

14 But when the _husbandmen _saw him, they _reasoned _among _themselves, _saying, _This is the _heir: _come, let us _kill him, that the _inheritance may be _ours.

LUKE 20:15

15 _So they _cast him out of the _vineyard, and _killed *him*. _What _therefore shall the _lord of the _vineyard _do unto them?

LUKE 20:16

16 He shall _come and _destroy _these _husbandmen, and shall _give the _vineyard to _others. And when they heard *it*, they said, God forbid.

LUKE 20:17

17 And he beheld them, and said, _What is _this _then that is _written, The _stone _which the _builders _rejected, the _same is _become the _head of the _corner?

LUKE 20:18

18 _Whosoever shall _fall upon that _stone shall be _broken; but _on _whomsoever it shall _fall, it will _grind him to _powder.

LUKE 20:19

19 And the chief priests and the scribes the same hour sought to lay hands on him; and they feared the people: for they perceived that he had spoken this parable against them.

LUKE 20:20

20 And they watched *him*, and sent forth spies, which should feign themselves just men, that they might take hold of his words, that so they might deliver him unto the power and authority of the governor.

LUKE 20:21

21 And they asked him, saying, Master, we know that thou sayest and teachest rightly, neither acceptest thou the person *of any*, but teachest the way of God truly:

LUKE 20:22

22 Is it lawful for us to give tribute unto Caesar, or no?

LUKE 20:23

23 But he perceived their craftiness, and said unto them, _Why _tempt ye me?

LUKE 20:24

24 _Shew me a _penny. _Whose _image and _superscription _hath it? They answered and said, Caesar's.

LUKE 20:25

25 And he said unto them, _Render _therefore unto _Caesar the things which be _Caesar's, and unto _God the things which be _God's.

LUKE 20:26

26 And they could not take hold of his words before the people: and they marvelled at his answer, and held their peace.

LUKE 20:27

27 Then came to *him* certain of the Sadducees, which deny that there is any resurrection; and they asked him,

LUKE 20:28

28 Saying, Master, Moses wrote unto us, If any man's brother die, having a wife, and he die without children, that his brother should take his wife, and raise up seed unto his brother.

LUKE 20:29

29 There were therefore seven brethren: and the first took a wife, and died without children.

LUKE 20:30

30 And the second took her to wife, and he died childless.

LUKE 20:31

31 And the third took her; and in like manner the seven also: and they left no children, and died.

LUKE 20:32

32 Last of all the woman died also.

LUKE 20:33

33 Therefore in the resurrection whose wife of them is she? for seven had her to wife.

LUKE 20:34

34 And Jesus answering said unto them, The _children of _this _world _marry, and are given in _marriage:

LUKE 20:35

35 But they which shall be _accounted _worthy to _obtain that _world, and the _resurrection from the _dead, _neither _marry, _nor are given in _marriage:

LUKE 20:36

36 _Neither _can they _die _any _more: for they are _equal unto the _angels; and are the _children of _God, _being the _children of the _resurrection.

LUKE 20:37

37 _Now that the _dead are _raised, _even _Moses _shewed _at the _bush, _when he _calleth the _Lord the _God of _Abraham, and the _God of _Isaac, and the _God of _Jacob.

LUKE 20:38

38 For he is not a _God of the _dead, but of the _living: for _all _live unto him.

LUKE 20:39

39 Then certain of the scribes answering said, Master, thou hast well said.

LUKE 20:40

40 And after that they durst not ask him any *question at all*.

LUKE 20:41

41 And he said unto them, _How _say they that _Christ is _David's _son?

LUKE 20:42

42 And _David _himself _saith in the _book of _Psalms, The _LORD _said unto my _Lord, _Sit thou _on my _right hand,

LUKE 20:43

43 _Till I _make _thine _enemies thy _footstool.

LUKE 20:44

44 _David therefore _calleth him _Lord, _how is he _then his _son?

LUKE 20:45

45 Then in the audience of all the people he said unto his disciples,

LUKE 20:46

46 _Beware of the _scribes, _which _desire to _walk in long _robes, and _love _greetings in the _markets, and the _highest _seats in the _synagogues, and the _chief _rooms _at _feasts;

LUKE 20:47

47 _Which _devour _widows' _houses, and for a _shew _make _long _prayers: the _same shall _receive _greater _damnation.
