

LUKE 22

LUKE 22:1

1 ¶ Now the feast of unleavened bread drew nigh, which is called the Passover.

LUKE 22:2

2 And the chief priests and scribes sought how they might kill him; for they feared the people.

LUKE 22:3

3 Then entered Satan into Judas surnamed Iscariot, being of the number of the twelve.

LUKE 22:4

4 And he went his way, and communed with the chief priests and captains, how he might betray him unto them.

LUKE 22:5

5 And they were glad, and covenanted to give him money.

LUKE 22:6

6 And he promised, and sought opportunity to betray him unto them in the absence of the multitude.

LUKE 22:7

7 ¶ Then came the day of unleavened bread, when the passover must be killed.

LUKE 22:8

8 And he sent Peter and John, saying, **_Go and _prepare us the _passover, that we may _eat.**

LUKE 22:9

9 And they said unto him, Where wilt thou that we prepare?

LUKE 22:10

10 And he said unto them, **_Behold, when ye are _entered _into the _city, there shall a _man _meet you, _bearing a _pitcher of _water; _follow him _into the _house _where he _entereth in.**

LUKE 22:11

11 And ye shall **_say unto the _goodman of the _house, The _Master _saith unto thee, _Where is the _guestchamber, _where I shall _eat the _passover with my**

_disciples?

LUKE 22:12

12 And he shall *_shew you a _large _upper room _furnished: _there _make _ready.*

LUKE 22:13

13 And they went, and found as he had said unto them: and they made ready the passover.

LUKE 22:14

14 And when the hour was come, he sat down, and the twelve apostles with him.

LUKE 22:15

15 And he said unto them, *With _desire I have _desired to _eat _this _passover with you _before I _suffer:*

LUKE 22:16

16 For I *_say unto you, I will not _any _more _eat _thereof, _until it be _fulfilled in the _kingdom of _God.*

LUKE 22:17

17 And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and said, *_Take _this, and _divide it among _yourselves:*

LUKE 22:18

18 For I *_say unto you, I will not _drink of the _fruit of the _vine, _until the _kingdom of _God shall _come.*

LUKE 22:19

19 And he took bread, and gave thanks, and brake *it*, and gave unto them, saying, *_This is my _body _which is _given for you: _this _do in _remembrance of me.*

LUKE 22:20

20 Likewise also the cup after supper, saying, *_This _cup is the _new _testament in my _blood, _which is _shed for you.*

LUKE 22:21

21 ¶ *_But, _behold, the _hand of him that _betrayeth me is with me _on the _table.*

LUKE 22:22

22 And *_truly the _Son of _man _goeth, as it was _determined: _but _woe unto that _man by _whom he is _betrayed!*

LUKE 22:23

23 And they began to enquire among themselves, which of them it was that should do this thing.

LUKE 22:24

24 And there was also a strife among them, which of them should be accounted the greatest.

LUKE 22:25

25 And he said unto them, The *kings of the Gentiles exercise lordship over them; and they that exercise authority upon them are called benefactors.*

LUKE 22:26

26 But ye *shall not be so: but he that is greatest among you, let him be as the younger; and he that is chief, as he that doth serve.*

LUKE 22:27

27 For *whether is greater, he that sitteth at meat, or he that serveth? is not he that sitteth at meat? but I am among you as he that serveth.*

LUKE 22:28

28 Ye are they which have *continued with me in my temptations.*

LUKE 22:29

29 And I *appoint unto you a kingdom, as my Father hath appointed unto me;*

LUKE 22:30

30 That ye may *eat and drink at my table in my kingdom, and sit on thrones judging the twelve tribes of Israel.*

LUKE 22:31

31 And the Lord said, *Simon, Simon, behold, Satan hath desired to have you, that he may sift you as wheat:*

LUKE 22:32

32 But I have *prayed for thee, that thy faith fail not: and when thou art converted, strengthen thy brethren.*

LUKE 22:33

33 And he said unto him, Lord, I am ready to go with thee, both into prison, and to death.

LUKE 22:34

34 And he said, I *tell thee, Peter, the cock shall not crow this day, before*

that thou shalt *_thrice _deny* that thou *_knowest* me.

LUKE 22:35

35 And he said unto them, *_When I _sent you _without _purse, and _scrip, and _shoes, _lacked ye _any thing?* And they said, *Nothing.*

LUKE 22:36

36 Then said he unto them, *But _now, he that _hath a _purse, let him _take it, and _likewise his _scrip: and he that _hath _no _sword, let him _sell his _garment, and _buy one.*

LUKE 22:37

37 For I *_say* unto you, that *_this* that is *_written* *_must* *_yet* be *_accomplished* in me, And he was *_reckoned* *_among* the *_transgressors*: for the things *_concerning* me *_have* an *_end*.

LUKE 22:38

38 And they said, Lord, behold, here *are* two swords. And he said unto them, *It is _enough.*

LUKE 22:39

39 ¶ And he came out, and went, as he was wont, to the mount of Olives; and his disciples also followed him.

LUKE 22:40

40 And when he was at the place, he said unto them, *_Pray that ye _enter not _into _temptation.*

LUKE 22:41

41 And he was withdrawn from them about a stone's cast, and kneeled down, and prayed,

LUKE 22:42

42 Saying, *_Father, _if thou be _willing, _remove _this _cup from me: _nevertheless not my _will, but _thine, be _done.*

LUKE 22:43

43 And there appeared an angel unto him from heaven, strengthening him.

LUKE 22:44

44 And being in an agony he prayed more earnestly: and his sweat was as it were great drops of blood falling down to the ground.

LUKE 22:45

45 And when he rose up from prayer, and was come to his disciples, he found them sleeping for sorrow,

LUKE 22:46

46 And said unto them, *_Why _sleep ye? _rise and _pray, _lest ye _enter _into _temptation.*

LUKE 22:47

47 ¶ And while he yet spake, behold a multitude, and he that was called Judas, one of the twelve, went before them, and drew near unto Jesus to kiss him.

LUKE 22:48

48 But Jesus said unto him, *_Judas, _betrayest thou the _Son of _man with a _kiss?*

LUKE 22:49

49 When they which were about him saw what would follow, they said unto him, Lord, shall we smite with the sword?

LUKE 22:50

50 And one of them smote the servant of the high priest, and cut off his right ear.

LUKE 22:51

51 And Jesus answered and said, *_Suffer ye _thus _far.* And he touched his ear, and healed him.

LUKE 22:52

52 Then Jesus said unto the chief priests, and captains of the temple, and the elders, which were come to him, *Be ye _come out, as _against a _thief, with _swords and _staves?*

LUKE 22:53

53 *When I was _daily with you in the _temple, ye _stretched _forth _no _hands _against me: but _this is _your _hour, and the _power of _darkness.*

LUKE 22:54

54 ¶ Then took they him, and led *him*, and brought him into the high priest's house. And Peter followed afar off.

LUKE 22:55

55 And when they had kindled a fire in the midst of the hall, and were set down together, Peter sat down among them.

LUKE 22:56

56 But a certain maid beheld him as he sat by the fire, and earnestly looked upon him, and said, This man was also with him.

LUKE 22:57

57 And he denied him, saying, Woman, I know him not.

LUKE 22:58

58 And after a little while another saw him, and said, Thou art also of them. And Peter said, Man, I am not.

LUKE 22:59

59 And about the space of one hour after another confidently affirmed, saying, Of a truth this *fellow* also was with him: for he is a Galilaeen.

LUKE 22:60

60 And Peter said, Man, I know not what thou sayest. And immediately, while he yet spake, the cock crew.

LUKE 22:61

61 And the Lord turned, and looked upon Peter. And Peter remembered the word of the Lord, how he had said unto him, Before the cock crow, thou shalt deny me thrice.

LUKE 22:62

62 And Peter went out, and wept bitterly.

LUKE 22:63

63 ¶ And the men that held Jesus mocked him, and smote *him*.

LUKE 22:64

64 And when they had blindfolded him, they struck him on the face, and asked him, saying, Prophesy, who is it that smote thee?

LUKE 22:65

65 And many other things blasphemously spake they against him.

LUKE 22:66

66 And as soon as it was day, the elders of the people and the chief priests and the scribes came together, and led him into their council, saying,

LUKE 22:67

67 Art thou the Christ? tell us. And he said unto them, ***_If I _tell you, ye will not _believe:***

LUKE 22:68

68 And if I also ask you, ye will not answer me, nor let me go.

LUKE 22:69

69 Hereafter shall the Son of man sit on the right hand of the power of God.

LUKE 22:70

70 Then said they all, Art thou then the Son of God? And he said unto them, Ye say that I am.

LUKE 22:71

71 And they said, What need we any further witness? for we ourselves have heard of his own mouth.
