LUKE 24

LUKE 24:1

1 Now upon the first *day* of the week, very early in the morning, they came unto the sepulchre, bringing the spices which they had prepared, and certain *others* with them.

LUKE 24:2

2 And they found the stone rolled away from the sepulchre.

LUKE 24:3

3 And they entered in, and found not the body of the Lord Jesus.

LUKE 24:4

4 And it came to pass, as they were much perplexed thereabout, behold, two men stood by them in shining garments:

LUKE 24:5

5 And as they were afraid, and bowed down *their* faces to the earth, they said unto them, Why seek ye the living among the dead?

LUKE 24:6

6 He is not here, but is risen: remember how he spake unto you when he was yet in Galilee.

LUKE 24:7

7 Saying, The Son of man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, and be crucified, and the third day rise again.

LUKE 24:8

8 And they remembered his words,

LUKE 24:9

9 And returned from the sepulchre, and told all these things unto the eleven, and to all the rest.

LUKE 24:10

10 It was Mary Magdalene, and Joanna, and Mary *the mother* of James, and other *women that were* with them, which told these things unto the apostles.

LUKE 24:11

11 And their words seemed to them as idle tales, and they believed them not.

LUKE 24:12

12 Then arose Peter, and ran unto the sepulchre; and stooping down, he beheld the linen clothes laid by themselves, and departed, wondering in himself at that which was come to pass.

LUKE 24:13

13 ¶ And, behold, two of them went that same day to a village called Emmaus, which was from Jerusalem *about* threescore furlongs.

LUKE 24:14

14 And they talked together of all these things which had happened.

LUKE 24:15

15 And it came to pass, that, while they communed *together* and reasoned, Jesus himself drew near, and went with them.

LUKE 24:16

16 But their eyes were holden that they should not know him.

LUKE 24:17

17 And he said unto them, _What manner of _communications are _these that ye _have _one to _another, as ye _walk, and are _sad?

LUKE 24:18

18 And the one of them, whose name was Cleopas, answering said unto him, Art thou only a stranger in Jerusalem, and hast not known the things which are come to pass there in these days?

LUKE 24:19

19 And he said unto them, _What things? And they said unto him, Concerning Jesus of Nazareth, which was a prophet mighty in deed and word before God and all the people:

LUKE 24:20

20 And how the chief priests and our rulers delivered him to be condemned to death, and have crucified him.

LUKE 24:21

21 But we trusted that it had been he which should have redeemed Israel: and beside all this, to day is the third day since these things were done.

LUKE 24:22

22 Yea, and certain women also of our company made us astonished, which were

early at the sepulchre;

LUKE 24:23

23 And when they found not his body, they came, saying, that they had also seen a vision of angels, which said that he was alive.

LUKE 24:24

24 And certain of them which were with us went to the sepulchre, and found *it* even so as the women had said: but him they saw not.

LUKE 24:25

25 Then he said unto them, O _fools, and _slow of _heart to _believe _all that the _prophets have _spoken:

LUKE 24:26

26 _Ought not _Christ to have _suffered _these things, and to _enter _into his _glory?

LUKE 24:27

27 And beginning at Moses and all the prophets, he expounded unto them in all the scriptures the things concerning himself.

LUKE 24:28

28 And they drew nigh unto the village, whither they went: and he made as though he would have gone further.

LUKE 24:29

29 But they constrained him, saying, Abide with us: for it is toward evening, and the day is far spent. And he went in to tarry with them.

LUKE 24:30

30 And it came to pass, as he sat at meat with them, he took bread, and blessed *it*, and brake, and gave to them.

LUKE 24:31

31 And their eyes were opened, and they knew him; and he vanished out of their sight.

LUKE 24:32

32 And they said one to another, Did not our heart burn within us, while he talked with us by the way, and while he opened to us the scriptures?

LUKE 24:33

33 And they rose up the same hour, and returned to Jerusalem, and found the

eleven gathered together, and them that were with them,

LUKE 24:34

34 Saying, The Lord is risen indeed, and hath appeared to Simon.

LUKE 24:35

35 And they told what things *were done* in the way, and how he was known of them in breaking of bread.

LUKE 24:36

36 ¶ And as they thus spake, Jesus himself stood in the midst of them, and saith unto them, _Peace *be* unto you.

LUKE 24:37

37 But they were terrified and affrighted, and supposed that they had seen a spirit.

LUKE 24:38

38 And he said unto them, _Why are ye _troubled? and _why do _thoughts _arise in your hearts?

LUKE 24:39

39 _Behold my _hands and my _feet, that it is I myself: _handle me, and _see; for a _spirit _hath not _flesh and _bones, as ye _see me _have.

LUKE 24:40

40 And when he had thus spoken, he shewed them *his* hands and *his* feet.

LUKE 24:41

41 And while they yet believed not for joy, and wondered, he said unto them, _Have ye _here _any _meat?

LUKE 24:42

42 And they gave him a piece of a broiled fish, and of an honeycomb.

LUKE 24:43

43 And he took *it*, and did eat before them.

LUKE 24:44

44 And he said unto them, _These are the _words _which I _spake unto you, while I was _yet with you, that _all things _must be _fulfilled, _which were _written in the _law of _Moses, and *in* the _prophets, and *in* the _psalms, _concerning me.

LUKE 24:45

45 Then opened he their understanding, that they might understand the scriptures,

LUKE 24:46

46 And said unto them, _Thus it is _written, and _thus it _behoved _Christ to _suffer, and to _rise from the _dead the _third _day:

LUKE 24:47

47 And that _repentance and _remission of _sins should be _preached in his _name _among _all _nations, _beginning _at _Jerusalem.

LUKE 24:48

48 And ye are _witnesses of _these things.

LUKE 24:49

49 And, _behold, I _send the _promise of my _Father upon you: but _tarry ye in the _city of _Jerusalem, _until ye be _endued with _power from on _high.

LUKE 24:50

50 ¶ And he led them out as far as to Bethany, and he lifted up his hands, and blessed them.

LUKE 24:51

51 And it came to pass, while he blessed them, he was parted from them, and carried up into heaven.

LUKE 24:52

52 And they worshipped him, and returned to Jerusalem with great joy:

LUKE 24:53

And were continually in the temple, praising and blessing God. Amen.
