LUKE 5:1

1 ¶ And it came to pass, that, as the people pressed upon him to hear the word of God, he stood by the lake of Gennesaret,

LUKE 5:2

2 And saw two ships standing by the lake: but the fishermen were gone out of them, and were washing *their* nets.

LUKE 5:3

3 And he entered into one of the ships, which was Simon's, and prayed him that he would thrust out a little from the land. And he sat down, and taught the people out of the ship.

LUKE 5:4

4 Now when he had left speaking, he said unto Simon, **_Launch out _into the _deep, and _let _down _your _nets for a _draught.**

LUKE 5:5

5 And Simon answering said unto him, Master, we have toiled all the night, and have taken nothing: nevertheless at thy word I will let down the net.

LUKE 5:6

6 And when they had this done, they inclosed a great multitude of fishes: and their net brake.

LUKE 5:7

7 And they beckoned unto *their* partners, which were in the other ship, that they should come and help them. And they came, and filled both the ships, so that they began to sink.

LUKE 5:8

8 When Simon Peter saw *it*, he fell down at Jesus' knees, saying, Depart from me; for I am a sinful man, O Lord.

LUKE 5:9

9 For he was astonished, and all that were with him, at the draught of the fishes which they had taken:

LUKE 5:10

10 And so was also James, and John, the sons of Zebedee, which were partners with Simon. And Jesus said unto Simon, **_Fear not; from _henceforth thou shalt _catch**

_men.

LUKE 5:11

11 And when they had brought their ships to land, they forsook all, and followed him.

LUKE 5:12

12 ¶ And it came to pass, when he was in a certain city, behold a man full of leprosy: who seeing Jesus fell on *his* face, and besought him, saying, Lord, if thou wilt, thou canst make me clean.

LUKE 5:13

13 And he put forth *his* hand, and touched him, saying, I *_will: be thou _clean.* And immediately the leprosy departed from him.

LUKE 5:14

14 And he charged him to *_tell _no _man: but _go, and _shew _thyself to the _priest, and _offer for thy _cleansing, according as _Moses _commanded, for a _testimony unto them.*

LUKE 5:15

15 But so much the more went there a fame abroad of him: and great multitudes came together to hear, and to be healed by him of their infirmities.

LUKE 5:16

16 And he withdrew himself into the wilderness, and prayed.

LUKE 5:17

17 ¶ And it came to pass on a certain day, as he was teaching, that there were Pharisees and doctors of the law sitting by, which were come out of every town of Galilee, and Judaea, and Jerusalem: and the power of the Lord was *present* to heal them.

LUKE 5:18

18 And, behold, men brought in a bed a man which was taken with a palsy: and they sought *means* to bring him in, and to lay *him* before him.

LUKE 5:19

19 And when they could not find by what *way* they might bring him in because of the multitude, they went upon the housetop, and let him down through the tiling with *his* couch into the midst before Jesus.

LUKE 5:20

20 And when he saw their faith, he said unto him, *_Man, thy _sins are _forgiven*

thee.

LUKE 5:21

21 And the scribes and the Pharisees began to reason, saying, Who is this which speaketh blasphemies? Who can forgive sins, but God alone?

LUKE 5:22

22 But when Jesus perceived their thoughts, he answering said unto them, **_What _reason ye in _your _hearts?**

LUKE 5:23

23 **_Whether is _easier, to _say, Thy _sins be _forgiven thee; _or to _say, _Rise up and _walk?**

LUKE 5:24

24 **But that ye may _know that the _Son of _man _hath _power upon _earth to _forgive _sins, (he said unto the sick of the palsy,) I _say unto thee, _Arise, and _take up thy _couch, and _go _into _thine _house.**

LUKE 5:25

25 And immediately he rose up before them, and took up that whereon he lay, and departed to his own house, glorifying God.

LUKE 5:26

26 And they were all amazed, and they glorified God, and were filled with fear, saying, We have seen strange things to day.

LUKE 5:27

27 ¶ And after these things he went forth, and saw a publican, named Levi, sitting at the receipt of custom: and he said unto him, **_Follow me.**

LUKE 5:28

28 And he left all, rose up, and followed him.

LUKE 5:29

29 And Levi made him a great feast in his own house: and there was a great company of publicans and of others that sat down with them.

LUKE 5:30

30 But their scribes and Pharisees murmured against his disciples, saying, Why do ye eat and drink with publicans and sinners?

LUKE 5:31

31 And Jesus answering said unto them, They that are whole need not a physician; but they that are sick.

LUKE 5:32

32 I came not to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance.

LUKE 5:33

33 And they said unto him, Why do the disciples of John fast often, and make prayers, and likewise *the disciples* of the Pharisees; but thine eat and drink?

LUKE 5:34

34 And he said unto them, Can ye make the children of the bridechamber fast, while the bridegroom is with them?

LUKE 5:35

35 But the days will come, when the bridegroom shall be taken away from them, and then shall they fast in those days.

LUKE 5:36

36 And he spake also a parable unto them; No man putteth a piece of a new garment upon an old; if otherwise, then both the new maketh a rent, and the piece that was *taken* out of the new agreeth not with the old.

LUKE 5:37

37 And no man putteth new wine into old bottles; else the new wine will burst the bottles, and be spilled, and the bottles shall perish.

LUKE 5:38

38 But new wine must be put into new bottles; and both are preserved.

LUKE 5:39

39 No man also having drunk old *wine* straightway desireth new: for he saith, The old is better.
