LUKE 7

LUKE 7:1

1 ¶ Now when he had ended all his sayings in the audience of the people, he entered into Capernaum.

LUKE 7:2

2 And a certain centurion's servant, who was dear unto him, was sick, and ready to die.

LUKE 7:3

3 And when he heard of Jesus, he sent unto him the elders of the Jews, beseeching him that he would come and heal his servant.

LUKE 7:4

4 And when they came to Jesus, they besought him instantly, saying, That he was worthy for whom he should do this:

LUKE 7:5

5 For he loveth our nation, and he hath built us a synagogue.

LUKE 7:6

6 Then Jesus went with them. And when he was now not far from the house, the centurion sent friends to him, saying unto him, Lord, trouble not thyself: for I am not worthy that thou shouldest enter under my roof:

LUKE 7:7

7 Wherefore neither thought I myself worthy to come unto thee: but say in a word, and my servant shall be healed.

LUKE 7:8

8 For I also am a man set under authority, having under me soldiers, and I say unto one, Go, and he goeth; and to another, Come, and he cometh; and to my servant, Do this, and he doeth *it*.

LUKE 7:9

9 When Jesus heard these things, he marvelled at him, and turned him about, and said unto the people that followed him, I _say unto you, I have not _found _so _great _faith, _no, not in _Israel.

LUKE 7:10

10 And they that were sent, returning to the house, found the servant whole that had been sick.

LUKE 7:11

11 And it came to pass the day after, that he went into a city called Nain; and many of his disciples went with him, and much people.

LUKE 7:12

12 Now when he came nigh to the gate of the city, behold, there was a dead man carried out, the only son of his mother, and she was a widow: and much people of the city was with her.

LUKE 7:13

13 And when the Lord saw her, he had compassion on her, and said unto her, _Weep not.

LUKE 7:14

14 And he came and touched the bier: and they that bare *him* stood still. And he said, _Young _man, I _say unto thee, _Arise.

LUKE 7:15

15 And he that was dead sat up, and began to speak. And he delivered him to his mother.

LUKE 7:16

16 And there came a fear on all: and they glorified God, saying, That a great prophet is risen up among us; and, That God hath visited his people.

LUKE 7:17

17 And this rumour of him went forth throughout all Judaea, and throughout all the region round about.

LUKE 7:18

18 And the disciples of John shewed him of all these things.

LUKE 7:19

19 And John calling *unto him* two of his disciples sent *them* to Jesus, saying, Art thou he that should come? or look we for another?

LUKE 7:20

20 When the men were come unto him, they said, John Baptist hath sent us unto thee, saying, Art thou he that should come? or look we for another?

LUKE 7:21

21 And in that same hour he cured many of *their* infirmities and plagues, and of evil

spirits; and unto many that were blind he gave sight.

LUKE 7:22

22 Then Jesus answering said unto them, _Go your way, and _tell _John _what things ye have _seen and _heard; _how that the _blind _see, the _lame _walk, the _lepers are _cleansed, the _deaf _hear, the _dead are _raised, to the _poor the _gospel is _preached.

LUKE 7:23

23 And _blessed is *he*, _whosoever shall _not be _offended in me.

LUKE 7:24

And when the messengers of John were departed, he began to speak unto the people concerning John, _What _went ye out _into the _wilderness for to _see? A _reed _shaken with the _wind?

LUKE 7:25

25 But _what _went ye out for to _see? A _man _clothed in _soft _raiment? _Behold, they which are _gorgeously _apparelled, and _live _delicately, are in _kings' courts.

LUKE 7:26

26 But _what _went ye out for to _see? A _prophet? _Yea, I _say unto you, and _much _more _than a _prophet.

LUKE 7:27

27 _This is *he*, of _whom it is _written, _Behold, I _send my _messenger _before thy _face, _which shall _prepare thy _way _before thee.

LUKE 7:28

28 For I _say unto you, _Among those that are _born of _women there is not a _greater _prophet _than _John the _Baptist: but he that is _least in the _kingdom of _God is _greater _than he.

LUKE 7:29

29 And all the people that heard *him*, and the publicans, justified God, being baptized with the baptism of John.

LUKE 7:30

30 But the Pharisees and lawyers rejected the counsel of God against themselves, being not baptized of him.

LUKE 7:31

31 And the Lord said, _Whereunto _then shall I _liken the _men of _this

_generation? and to _what are they _like?

LUKE 7:32

32 They are _like unto _children _sitting in the _marketplace, and _calling _one to _another, and _saying, We have _piped unto you, and ye have not _danced; we have _mourned to you, and ye have not _wept.

LUKE 7:33

33 For _John the _Baptist _came _neither _eating _bread _nor _drinking _wine; and ye _say, He _hath a _devil.

LUKE 7:34

34 The _Son of _man is _come _eating and _drinking; and ye _say, _Behold a _gluttonous _man, and a _winebibber, a _friend of _publicans and _sinners!

LUKE 7:35

35 But _wisdom is _justified of _all her _children.

LUKE 7:36

36 ¶ And one of the Pharisees desired him that he would eat with him. And he went into the Pharisee's house, and sat down to meat.

LUKE 7:37

37 And, behold, a woman in the city, which was a sinner, when she knew that *Jesus* sat at meat in the Pharisee's house, brought an alabaster box of ointment,

LUKE 7:38

38 And stood at his feet behind *him* weeping, and began to wash his feet with tears, and did wipe *them* with the hairs of her head, and kissed his feet, and anointed *them* with the ointment.

LUKE 7:39

39 Now when the Pharisee which had bidden him saw *it*, he spake within himself, saying, This man, if he were a prophet, would have known who and what manner of woman *this is* that toucheth him: for she is a sinner.

LUKE 7:40

40 And Jesus answering said unto him, _Simon, I _have _somewhat to _say unto thee. And he saith, Master, say on.

LUKE 7:41

41 There was a _certain _creditor which _had _two _debtors: the _one _owed _five _hundred _pence, and the _other _fifty.

LUKE 7:42

42 And when they _had _nothing to _pay, he _frankly _forgave them _both. _Tell me _therefore, _which of them will _love him _most?

LUKE 7:43

43 Simon answered and said, I suppose that *he*, to whom he forgave most. And he said unto him, Thou hast _rightly _judged.

LUKE 7:44

44 And he turned to the woman, and said unto Simon, _Seest thou _this woman? I _entered _into _thine _house, thou _gavest me _no _water for my _feet: but she hath _washed my _feet with _tears, and _wiped *them* with the _hairs of her _head.

LUKE 7:45

45 Thou _gavest me _no _kiss: but _this woman _since the time I _came in hath not _ceased to _kiss my _feet.

LUKE 7:46

46 My _head with _oil thou didst not _anoint: but _this woman hath _anointed my _feet with _ointment.

LUKE 7:47

47 _Wherefore I _say unto thee, Her _sins, _which are _many, are _forgiven; for she _loved _much: but to _whom _little is _forgiven, *the same* _loveth _little.

LUKE 7:48

48 And he said unto her, Thy _sins are _forgiven.

LUKE 7:49

49 And they that sat at meat with him began to say within themselves, Who is this that forgiveth sins also?

LUKE 7:50

50 And he said to the woman, Thy _faith hath _saved thee; _go in _peace.
