# LUKE 8

## LUKE 8:1

1 And it came to pass afterward, that he went throughout every city and village, preaching and shewing the glad tidings of the kingdom of God: and the twelve *were* with him,

# LUKE 8:2

2 And certain women, which had been healed of evil spirits and infirmities, Mary called Magdalene, out of whom went seven devils,

# LUKE 8:3

3 And Joanna the wife of Chuza Herod's steward, and Susanna, and many others, which ministered unto him of their substance.

## LUKE 8:4

4  $\P$  And when much people were gathered together, and were come to him out of every city, he spake by a parable:

# LUKE 8:5

**5** A \_sower \_went out to \_sow his \_seed: and as he \_sowed, \_some \_fell by the \_way \_side; and it was \_trodden \_down, and the \_fowls of the \_air \_devoured it.

## LUKE 8:6

6 And \_some \_fell upon a \_rock; and as soon as it was \_sprung up, it \_withered away, \_because it \_lacked \_moisture.

## LUKE 8:7

7 And \_some \_fell \_among \_thorns; and the \_thorns \_sprang up with it, and \_choked it.

## LUKE 8:8

8 And \_other \_fell \_on \_good \_ground, and \_sprang up, and \_bare \_fruit an \_hundredfold. And when he had \_said \_these things, he \_cried, He that \_hath \_ears to \_hear, let him \_hear.

## LUKE 8:9

9 And his disciples asked him, saying, What might this parable be?

## LUKE 8:10

10 And he said, Unto you it is \_given to \_know the \_mysteries of the \_kingdom of \_God: but to \_others in \_parables; that \_seeing they might not \_see, and \_hearing they

might not \_understand.

### LUKE 8:11

11 \_Now the \_parable is \_this: The \_seed is the \_word of \_God.

### LUKE 8:12

12 \_Those by the \_way \_side are they that \_hear; \_then \_cometh the \_devil, and \_taketh \_away the \_word out of their \_hearts, \_lest they should \_believe and be \_saved.

### LUKE 8:13

**13** They \_on the \_rock *are they*, \_which, \_when they \_hear, \_receive the \_word with \_joy; and \_these \_have \_no \_root, \_which for a \_while \_believe, and in \_time of \_temptation \_fall \_away.

### LUKE 8:14

14 And that which \_fell \_among \_thorns are they, which, when they have \_heard, \_go \_forth, and are \_choked with \_cares and \_riches and \_pleasures of *this* \_life, and \_bring \_no \_fruit to \_perfection.

### LUKE 8:15

**15** But that \_on the \_good \_ground are they, \_which in an \_honest and \_good \_heart, having \_heard the \_word, \_keep *it*, and \_bring forth \_fruit with \_patience.

### LUKE 8:16

**16** \_No \_man, when he hath \_lighted a \_candle, \_covereth it with a \_vessel, \_or \_putteth *it* \_under a \_bed; but \_setteth *it* \_on a \_candlestick, that they which \_enter in may \_see the \_light.

### LUKE 8:17

**17** For \_nothing is \_secret, that shall not be \_made \_manifest; \_neither any thing \_hid, that shall not be \_known and \_come \_abroad.

### LUKE 8:18

**18** Take \_heed \_therefore \_how ye \_hear: for \_whosoever \_hath, to him shall be \_given; and \_whosoever \_hath not, from him shall be \_taken \_even that \_which he \_seemeth to \_have.

### LUKE 8:19

19 Then came to him *his* mother and his brethren, and could not come at him for the press.

## LUKE 8:20

20 And it was told him by certain which said, Thy mother and thy brethren stand

without, desiring to see thee.

## LUKE 8:21

21 And he answered and said unto them, My \_mother and my \_brethren are \_these \_which \_hear the \_word of \_God, and \_do it.

# LUKE 8:22

22 Now it came to pass on a certain day, that he went into a ship with his disciples: and he said unto them, Let us \_go \_over unto the \_other \_side of the \_lake. And they launched forth.

## LUKE 8:23

23 But as they sailed he fell asleep: and there came down a storm of wind on the lake; and they were filled *with water*, and were in jeopardy.

## LUKE 8:24

24 And they came to him, and awoke him, saying, Master, master, we perish. Then he arose, and rebuked the wind and the raging of the water: and they ceased, and there was a calm.

## LUKE 8:25

25 And he said unto them, <u>Where is your \_faith?</u> And they being afraid wondered, saying one to another, What manner of man is this! for he commandeth even the winds and water, and they obey him.

## LUKE 8:26

26 And they arrived at the country of the Gadarenes, which is over against Galilee.

## LUKE 8:27

27 And when he went forth to land, there met him out of the city a certain man, which had devils long time, and ware no clothes, neither abode in *any* house, but in the tombs.

## LUKE 8:28

28 When he saw Jesus, he cried out, and fell down before him, and with a loud voice said, What have I to do with thee, Jesus, *thou* Son of God most high? I beseech thee, torment me not.

## LUKE 8:29

29 (For he had commanded the unclean spirit to come out of the man. For oftentimes it had caught him: and he was kept bound with chains and in fetters; and he brake the bands, and was driven of the devil into the wilderness.)

## LUKE 8:30

30 And Jesus asked him, saying, <u>What is thy \_name?</u> And he said, Legion: because many devils were entered into him.

# LUKE 8:31

31 And they besought him that he would not command them to go out into the deep.

# LUKE 8:32

32 And there was there an herd of many swine feeding on the mountain: and they besought him that he would suffer them to enter into them. And he suffered them.

# LUKE 8:33

33 Then went the devils out of the man, and entered into the swine: and the herd ran violently down a steep place into the lake, and were choked.

## LUKE 8:34

34 When they that fed *them* saw what was done, they fled, and went and told *it* in the city and in the country.

## LUKE 8:35

35 Then they went out to see what was done; and came to Jesus, and found the man, out of whom the devils were departed, sitting at the feet of Jesus, clothed, and in his right mind: and they were afraid.

## LUKE 8:36

36 They also which saw *it* told them by what means he that was possessed of the devils was healed.

## LUKE 8:37

37 Then the whole multitude of the country of the Gadarenes round about besought him to depart from them; for they were taken with great fear: and he went up into the ship, and returned back again.

## LUKE 8:38

38 Now the man out of whom the devils were departed besought him that he might be with him: but Jesus sent him away, saying,

## LUKE 8:39

39 \_Return to \_thine own \_house, and \_shew \_how \_great things \_God hath \_done unto thee. And he went his way, and published throughout the whole city how great things Jesus had done unto him.

## LUKE 8:40

### The Holy Bible KJV

40 And it came to pass, that, when Jesus was returned, the people *gladly* received him: for they were all waiting for him.

### LUKE 8:41

41 And, behold, there came a man named Jairus, and he was a ruler of the synagogue: and he fell down at Jesus' feet, and besought him that he would come into his house:

### LUKE 8:42

42 For he had one only daughter, about twelve years of age, and she lay a dying. But as he went the people thronged him.

### LUKE 8:43

43 And a woman having an issue of blood twelve years, which had spent all her living upon physicians, neither could be healed of any,

### LUKE 8:44

44 Came behind *him*, and touched the border of his garment: and immediately her issue of blood stanched.

### LUKE 8:45

45 And Jesus said, <u>Who touched me?</u> When all denied, Peter and they that were with him said, Master, the multitude throng thee and press *thee*, and sayest thou, Who touched me?

### LUKE 8:46

46 And Jesus said, \_Somebody hath \_touched me: for I \_perceive that \_virtue is \_gone out of me.

### LUKE 8:47

47 And when the woman saw that she was not hid, she came trembling, and falling down before him, she declared unto him before all the people for what cause she had touched him, and how she was healed immediately.

### LUKE 8:48

48 And he said unto her, \_Daughter, be of good \_comfort: thy \_faith hath \_made thee \_whole; \_go in \_peace.

### LUKE 8:49

49 While he yet spake, there cometh one from the ruler of the synagogue's *house*, saying to him, Thy daughter is dead; trouble not the Master.

### LUKE 8:50

50 But when Jesus heard *it*, he answered him, saying, \_Fear not: \_believe \_only, and she shall be \_made \_whole.

# LUKE 8:51

51 And when he came into the house, he suffered no man to go in, save Peter, and James, and John, and the father and the mother of the maiden.

# LUKE 8:52

52 And all wept, and bewailed her: but he said, \_Weep not; she is not \_dead, but \_sleepeth.

# LUKE 8:53

53 And they laughed him to scorn, knowing that she was dead.

# LUKE 8:54

54 And he put them all out, and took her by the hand, and called, saying, <u>Maid</u>, <u>arise</u>.

# LUKE 8:55

55 And her spirit came again, and she arose straightway: and he commanded to give her meat.

# LUKE 8:56

56 And her parents were astonished: but he charged them that they should tell no man what was done.
