MARK 10

MARK 10:1

1 ¶ And he arose from thence, and cometh into the coasts of Judaea by the farther side of Jordan: and the people resort unto him again; and, as he was wont, he taught them again.

MARK 10:2

2 And the Pharisees came to him, and asked him, Is it lawful for a man to put away his wife? tempting him.

MARK 10:3

3 And he answered and said unto them, _What did _Moses _command you?

MARK 10:4

4 And they said, Moses suffered to write a bill of divorcement, and to put *her* away.

MARK 10:5

5 And Jesus answered and said unto them, For the _hardness of _your _heart he _wrote you _this _precept.

MARK 10:6

6 But from the _beginning of the _creation _God _made them _male and _female.

MARK 10:7

7 For _this _cause shall a _man _leave his _father and _mother, and _cleave to his _wife;

MARK 10:8

8 And they _twain shall be _one _flesh: _so then they are _no _more _twain, but one flesh.

MARK 10:9

9 What therefore God hath joined together, let not man put asunder.

MARK 10:10

10 And in the house his disciples asked him again of the same *matter*.

MARK 10:11

11 And he saith unto them, _Whosoever shall _put _away his _wife, and _marry _another, _committeth _adultery _against her.

MARK 10:12

12 And _if a _woman shall _put _away her _husband, and be _married to _another, she _committeth _adultery.

MARK 10:13

13 ¶ And they brought young children to him, that he should touch them: and *his* disciples rebuked those that brought *them*.

MARK 10:14

14 But when Jesus saw *it*, he was much displeased, and said unto them, _Suffer the _little _children to _come unto me, and _forbid them not: for of _such is the _kingdom of God.

MARK 10:15

15 _Verily I _say unto you, _Whosoever shall _not _receive the _kingdom of _God as a _little _child, he shall not _enter _therein.

MARK 10:16

16 And he took them up in his arms, put *his* hands upon them, and blessed them.

MARK 10:17

17 ¶ And when he was gone forth into the way, there came one running, and kneeled to him, and asked him, Good Master, what shall I do that I may inherit eternal life?

MARK 10:18

18 And Jesus said unto him, _Why _callest thou me _good? *there is* _none _good but _one, *that is*, _God.

MARK 10:19

19 Thou _knowest the _commandments, Do not _commit _adultery, Do not _kill, Do not _steal, Do not _bear _false _witness, _Defraud not, _Honour thy _father and _mother.

MARK 10:20

20 And he answered and said unto him, Master, all these have I observed from my youth.

MARK 10:21

21 Then Jesus beholding him loved him, and said unto him, _One thing thou _lackest: _go thy way, _sell _whatsoever thou _hast, and _give to the _poor, and thou shalt _have _treasure in _heaven: and _come, _take up the _cross, and _follow me.

MARK 10:22

22 And he was sad at that saying, and went away grieved: for he had great possessions.

MARK 10:23

23 And Jesus looked round about, and saith unto his disciples, _How _hardly shall they that _have _riches _enter _into the _kingdom of _God!

MARK 10:24

24 And the disciples were astonished at his words. But Jesus answereth again, and saith unto them, _Children, _how _hard is it for them that _trust in _riches to _enter _into the _kingdom of _God!

MARK 10:25

25 It is _easier for a _camel to _go _through the _eye of a _needle, _than for a _rich man to _enter _into the _kingdom of _God.

MARK 10:26

26 And they were astonished out of measure, saying among themselves, Who then can be saved?

MARK 10:27

27 And Jesus looking upon them saith, With _men it is _impossible, but not with _God: for with _God _all things are _possible.

MARK 10:28

28 Then Peter began to say unto him, Lo, we have left all, and have followed thee.

MARK 10:29

29 And Jesus answered and said, _Verily I _say unto you, There is _no _man that hath _left _house, _or _brethren, _or _sisters, _or _father, _or _mother, _or _wife, _or _children, _or _lands, for my _sake, and the _gospel's,

MARK 10:30

30 _But he shall _receive an _hundredfold _now in _this _time, _houses, and _brethren, and _sisters, and _mothers, and _children, and _lands, with _persecutions; and in the _world to _come _eternal _life.

MARK 10:31

31 But _many that are _first shall be _last; and the _last _first.

MARK 10:32

32 ¶ And they were in the way going up to Jerusalem; and Jesus went before them: and they were amazed; and as they followed, they were afraid. And he took again

the twelve, and began to tell them what things should happen unto him,

MARK 10:33

33 Saying, _Behold, we _go up to _Jerusalem; and the _Son of _man shall be _delivered unto the _chief _priests, and unto the _scribes; and they shall _condemn him to _death, and shall _deliver him to the _Gentiles:

MARK 10:34

34 And they shall _mock him, and shall _scourge him, and shall _spit upon him, and shall _kill him: and the _third _day he shall _rise _again.

MARK 10:35

35 And James and John, the sons of Zebedee, come unto him, saying, Master, we would that thou shouldest do for us whatsoever we shall desire.

MARK 10:36

36 And he said unto them, _What _would ye that I should _do for you?

MARK 10:37

37 They said unto him, Grant unto us that we may sit, one on thy right hand, and the other on thy left hand, in thy glory.

MARK 10:38

38 But Jesus said unto them, Ye _know not _what ye _ask: _can ye _drink of the _cup that I _drink of? and be _baptized with the _baptism that I am _baptized with?

MARK 10:39

39 And they said unto him, We can. And Jesus said unto them, Ye shall _indeed _drink of the _cup that I _drink of; and with the _baptism that I am _baptized withal shall ye be _baptized:

MARK 10:40

40 But to _sit _on my _right hand and _on my _left hand is not mine to _give; but *it shall be given to them* for _whom it is _prepared.

MARK 10:41

41 And when the ten heard *it*, they began to be much displeased with James and John.

MARK 10:42

42 But Jesus called them *to him*, and saith unto them, Ye _know that they which are _accounted to _rule over the _Gentiles _exercise _lordship over them; and their _great ones exercise authority upon them.

MARK 10:43

43 But _so shall it not be _among you: but _whosoever _will be _great _among you, shall be _your _minister:

MARK 10:44

44 And _whosoever of you _will be the _chiefest, shall be _servant of _all.

MARK 10:45

45 For _even the _Son of _man _came not to be _ministered unto, but to _minister, and to _give his _life a _ransom for _many.

MARK 10:46

46 ¶ And they came to Jericho: and as he went out of Jericho with his disciples and a great number of people, blind Bartimaeus, the son of Timaeus, sat by the highway side begging.

MARK 10:47

47 And when he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to cry out, and say, Jesus, *thou* Son of David, have mercy on me.

MARK 10:48

48 And many charged him that he should hold his peace: but he cried the more a great deal, *Thou* Son of David, have mercy on me.

MARK 10:49

49 And Jesus stood still, and commanded him to be called. And they call the blind man, saying unto him, Be of good comfort, rise; he calleth thee.

MARK 10:50

50 And he, casting away his garment, rose, and came to Jesus.

MARK 10:51

51 And Jesus answered and said unto him, _What _wilt thou that I should _do unto thee? The blind man said unto him, Lord, that I might receive my sight.

MARK 10:52

52 And Jesus said unto him, _Go thy way; thy _faith hath _made thee _whole. And immediately he received his sight, and followed Jesus in the way.
