MARK 11:1

1 ¶ And when they came nigh to Jerusalem, unto Bethphage and Bethany, at the mount of Olives, he sendeth forth two of his disciples,

MARK 11:2

2 And saith unto them, _Go your way _into the _village _over _against you: and as _soon as ye be _entered _into it, ye shall _find a _colt _tied, _whereon _never _man _sat; _loose him, and _bring him.

MARK 11:3

3 And _if _any man _say unto you, _Why _do ye _this? _say ye that the _Lord _hath _need of him; and _straightway he will _send him _hither.

MARK 11:4

4 And they went their way, and found the colt tied by the door without in a place where two ways met; and they loose him.

MARK 11:5

5 And certain of them that stood there said unto them, What do ye, loosing the colt?

MARK 11:6

6 And they said unto them even as Jesus had commanded: and they let them go.

MARK 11:7

7 And they brought the colt to Jesus, and cast their garments on him; and he sat upon him.

MARK 11:8

8 And many spread their garments in the way: and others cut down branches off the trees, and strawed *them* in the way.

MARK 11:9

9 And they that went before, and they that followed, cried, saying, Hosanna; Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord:

MARK 11:10

10 Blessed *be* the kingdom of our father David, that cometh in the name of the Lord: Hosanna in the highest.

MARK 11:11

11 And Jesus entered into Jerusalem, and into the temple: and when he had looked

round about upon all things, and now the eventide was come, he went out unto Bethany with the twelve.

MARK 11:12

12 \P And on the morrow, when they were come from Bethany, he was hungry:

MARK 11:13

13 And seeing a fig tree afar off having leaves, he came, if haply he might find any thing thereon: and when he came to it, he found nothing but leaves; for the time of figs was not *yet*.

MARK 11:14

14 And Jesus answered and said unto it, _No _man _eat _fruit of thee _hereafter for ever. And his disciples heard *it*.

MARK 11:15

15 And they come to Jerusalem: and Jesus went into the temple, and began to cast out them that sold and bought in the temple, and overthrew the tables of the moneychangers, and the seats of them that sold doves;

MARK 11:16

16 And would not suffer that any man should carry any vessel through the temple.

MARK 11:17

17 And he taught, saying unto them, Is it not _written, My _house shall be _called of _all _nations the _house of _prayer? but ye have _made it a _den of _thieves.

MARK 11:18

18 And the scribes and chief priests heard *it*, and sought how they might destroy him: for they feared him, because all the people was astonished at his doctrine.

MARK 11:19

19 And when even was come, he went out of the city.

MARK 11:20

20 And in the morning, as they passed by, they saw the fig tree dried up from the roots.

MARK 11:21

21 And Peter calling to remembrance saith unto him, Master, behold, the fig tree which thou cursedst is withered away.

MARK 11:22

22 And Jesus answering saith unto them, _Have _faith in _God.

MARK 11:23

23 For _verily I _say unto you, That _whosoever shall _say unto _this _mountain, Be thou _removed, and be thou _cast into the _sea; and shall not _doubt in his _heart, but shall _believe that those things _which he _saith shall _come to pass; he shall _have _whatsoever he _saith.

MARK 11:24

24 _Therefore I _say unto you, _What things _soever ye _desire, when ye _pray, _believe that ye _receive *them*, and ye shall _have *them*.

MARK 11:25

25 And _when ye _stand _praying, _forgive, _if ye _have _ought _against _any: that _your _Father _also _which is in _heaven may _forgive you _your _trespasses.

MARK 11:26

26 But _if ye do not _forgive, _neither will _your _Father _which is in _heaven _forgive _your _trespasses.

MARK 11:27

27 ¶ And they come again to Jerusalem: and as he was walking in the temple, there come to him the chief priests, and the scribes, and the elders,

MARK 11:28

28 And say unto him, By what authority doest thou these things? and who gave thee this authority to do these things?

MARK 11:29

29 And Jesus answered and said unto them, I will _also _ask of you _one _question, and _answer me, and I will _tell you by _what _authority I _do _these things.

MARK 11:30

30 The _baptism of _John, was it from _heaven, _or of _men? _answer me.

MARK 11:31

31 And they reasoned with themselves, saying, If we shall say, From heaven; he will say, Why then did ye not believe him?

MARK 11:32

32 But if we shall say, Of men; they feared the people: for all *men* counted John, that he was a prophet indeed.

MARK 11:33

33 And they answered and said unto Jesus, We cannot tell. And Jesus answering saith unto them, _Neither _do I _tell you by _what _authority I _do _these things.
