## **MARK 12:1**

1 And he began to speak unto them by parables. A certain \_man \_planted a \_vineyard, and \_set an \_hedge \_about it, and \_digged a place for the \_winefat, and \_built a \_tower, and \_let it out to \_husbandmen, and \_went into a far \_country.

#### MARK 12:2

2 And at the \_season he \_sent to the \_husbandmen a \_servant, that he might \_receive from the \_husbandmen of the \_fruit of the \_vineyard.

## **MARK 12:3**

3 And they \_caught him, and \_beat him, and \_sent him \_away \_empty.

## **MARK 12:4**

4 And \_again he \_sent unto them \_another \_servant; and at him they \_cast \_stones, and wounded *him* in the \_head, and \_sent *him* \_away \_shamefully \_handled.

## **MARK 12:5**

5 And \_again he \_sent \_another; and him they \_killed, and \_many \_others; \_beating \_some, and \_killing \_some.

## **MARK 12:6**

6 \_Having \_yet \_therefore \_one \_son, his \_wellbeloved, he \_sent him \_also \_last unto them, \_saying, They will \_reverence my \_son.

#### MARK 12:7

7 But \_those \_husbandmen \_said \_among \_themselves, \_This is the \_heir; \_come, let us \_kill him, and the \_inheritance shall be \_ours.

## **MARK 12:8**

8 And they \_took him, and \_killed him, and \_cast him out of the \_vineyard.

## **MARK 12:9**

9 \_What shall \_therefore the \_lord of the \_vineyard \_do? he will \_come and \_destroy the \_husbandmen, and will \_give the \_vineyard unto \_others.

## MARK 12:10

10 And have ye not \_read \_this \_scripture; The \_stone \_which the \_builders rejected is \_become the \_head of the \_corner:

## **MARK 12:11**

11 \_This was the \_Lord's \_doing, and it is \_marvellous in our \_eyes?

#### MARK 12:12

12 And they sought to lay hold on him, but feared the people: for they knew that he had spoken the parable against them: and they left him, and went their way.

#### MARK 12:13

13 ¶ And they send unto him certain of the Pharisees and of the Herodians, to catch him in *his* words.

## MARK 12:14

14 And when they were come, they say unto him, Master, we know that thou art true, and carest for no man: for thou regardest not the person of men, but teachest the way of God in truth: Is it lawful to give tribute to Caesar, or not?

#### MARK 12:15

15 Shall we give, or shall we not give? But he, knowing their hypocrisy, said unto them, \_Why \_tempt ye me? \_bring me a \_penny, that I may \_see *it*.

## MARK 12:16

16 And they brought *it*. And he saith unto them, \_Whose *is* \_this \_image and \_superscription? And they said unto him, Caesar's.

### **MARK 12:17**

17 And Jesus answering said unto them, \_Render to \_Caesar the things that are \_Caesar's, and to \_God the things that are \_God's. And they marvelled at him.

## **MARK 12:18**

18 ¶ Then come unto him the Sadducees, which say there is no resurrection; and they asked him, saying,

#### MARK 12:19

19 Master, Moses wrote unto us, If a man's brother die, and leave *his* wife *behind him*, and leave no children, that his brother should take his wife, and raise up seed unto his brother.

#### MARK 12:20

20 Now there were seven brethren: and the first took a wife, and dying left no seed.

#### **MARK 12:21**

21 And the second took her, and died, neither left he any seed: and the third likewise.

#### MARK 12:22

22 And the seven had her, and left no seed: last of all the woman died also.

## MARK 12:23

23 In the resurrection therefore, when they shall rise, whose wife shall she be of them? for the seven had her to wife.

#### MARK 12:24

24 And Jesus answering said unto them, Do ye not \_therefore \_err, because ye \_know not the \_scriptures, \_neither the \_power of \_God?

#### MARK 12:25

25 For \_when they shall \_rise from the \_dead, they \_neither \_marry, \_nor are given in \_marriage; but are as the \_angels \_which are in \_heaven.

## MARK 12:26

26 And as \_touching the \_dead, that they \_rise: have ye not \_read in the \_book of \_Moses, \_how in the \_bush \_God \_spake unto him, \_saying, I *am* the \_God of \_Abraham, and the \_God of \_Isaac, and the \_God of \_Jacob?

#### MARK 12:27

27 He is not the \_God of the \_dead, but the \_God of the \_living: ye \_therefore do \_greatly \_err.

## **MARK 12:28**

28 ¶ And one of the scribes came, and having heard them reasoning together, and perceiving that he had answered them well, asked him, Which is the first commandment of all?

#### MARK 12:29

29 And Jesus answered him, The \_first of \_all the \_commandments *i*s, \_Hear, O Israel; The Lord our God is one Lord:

## MARK 12:30

30 And thou shalt \_love the \_Lord thy \_God with \_all thy \_heart, and with \_all thy \_soul, and with \_all thy \_mind, and with \_all thy \_strength: \_this *is* the \_first \_commandment.

## MARK 12:31

31 And the \_second *is* \_like, *namely* \_this, Thou shalt \_love thy \_neighbour as \_thyself. There is \_none \_other \_commandment \_greater than \_these.

## MARK 12:32

32 And the scribe said unto him, Well, Master, thou hast said the truth: for there is

one God; and there is none other but he:

## MARK 12:33

33 And to love him with all the heart, and with all the understanding, and with all the soul, and with all the strength, and to love *his* neighbour as himself, is more than all whole burnt offerings and sacrifices.

## MARK 12:34

And when Jesus saw that he answered discreetly, he said unto him, Thou \_art not \_far from the \_kingdom of \_God. And no man after that durst ask him any question.

## MARK 12:35

35 ¶ And Jesus answered and said, while he taught in the temple, \_How \_say the \_scribes that \_Christ is the \_Son of \_David?

## MARK 12:36

36 For \_David \_himself \_said by the \_Holy \_Ghost, The \_LORD \_said to my \_Lord, \_Sit thou \_on my \_right hand, \_till I \_make \_thine \_enemies thy \_footstool.

#### MARK 12:37

37 \_David \_therefore \_himself \_calleth him \_Lord; and \_whence is he *then* his \_son? And the common people heard him gladly.

## MARK 12:38

38 And he said unto them in his doctrine, \_Beware of the \_scribes, \_which \_love to \_go in long \_clothing, and *love* \_salutations in the \_marketplaces,

## MARK 12:39

39 And the \_chief \_seats in the \_synagogues, and the \_uppermost \_rooms \_at feasts:

#### MARK 12:40

40 \_Which \_devour \_widows' \_houses, and for a \_pretence \_make \_long \_prayers: \_these shall \_receive \_greater \_damnation.

#### MARK 12:41

41 ¶ And Jesus sat over against the treasury, and beheld how the people cast money into the treasury: and many that were rich cast in much.

## MARK 12:42

42 And there came a certain poor widow, and she threw in two mites, which make a farthing.

## MARK 12:43

43 And he called *unto him* his disciples, and saith unto them, \_Verily I \_say unto you, That \_this \_poor \_widow hath \_cast \_more in, than \_all they which have \_cast \_into the \_treasury:

# MARK 12:44

44 For \_all they did \_cast in of their \_abundance; but she of her \_want did \_cast in \_all that she \_had, even \_all her \_living.
