## MARK 4:1

1 ¶ And he began again to teach by the sea side: and there was gathered unto him a great multitude, so that he entered into a ship, and sat in the sea; and the whole multitude was by the sea on the land.

## MARK 4:2

2 And he taught them many things by parables, and said unto them in his doctrine,

## MARK 4:3

3 **\_Hearken; \_Behold, there \_went out a \_sower to \_sow:**

## MARK 4:4

4 **And it \_came to pass, as he \_sowed, \_some \_fell by the \_way \_side, and the \_fowls of the \_air \_came and \_devoured it up.**

## MARK 4:5

5 **And \_some \_fell \_on \_stony ground, \_where it \_had not \_much \_earth; and \_immediately it \_sprang up, \_because it \_had \_no \_depth of \_earth:**

## MARK 4:6

6 **But when the \_sun was up, it was \_scorched; and \_because it \_had \_no \_root, it \_withered away.**

## MARK 4:7

7 **And \_some \_fell \_among \_thorns, and the \_thorns \_grew up, and \_choked it, and it \_yielded \_no \_fruit.**

## MARK 4:8

8 **And \_other \_fell \_on \_good \_ground, and did \_yield \_fruit that \_sprang up and \_increased; and \_brought \_forth, \_some \_thirty, and \_some \_sixty, and \_some an \_hundred.**

## MARK 4:9

9 And he said unto them, **He that \_hath \_ears to \_hear, let him \_hear.**

## MARK 4:10

10 And when he was alone, they that were about him with the twelve asked of him the parable.

## MARK 4:11

11 And he said unto them, **Unto you it is \_given to \_know the \_mystery of the**

\_kingdom of \_God: but unto them that are \_without, \_all *these* things are \_done in \_parables:

**MARK 4:12**

12 That \_seeing they may \_see, and not \_perceive; and \_hearing they may \_hear, and not \_understand; \_lest \_at \_any \_time they should be \_converted, and *their* \_sins should be \_forgiven them.

**MARK 4:13**

13 And he said unto them, \_Know ye not \_this \_parable? and \_how then will ye \_know \_all \_parables?

**MARK 4:14**

14 The \_sower \_soweth the \_word.

**MARK 4:15**

15 And \_these are they by the \_way \_side, \_where the \_word is \_sown; but \_when they have \_heard, \_Satan \_cometh \_immediately, and \_taketh \_away the \_word that was \_sown in their \_hearts.

**MARK 4:16**

16 And \_these are they \_likewise which are \_sown \_on \_stony ground; \_who, \_when they have \_heard the \_word, \_immediately \_receive it with \_gladness;

**MARK 4:17**

17 And \_have \_no \_root in \_themselves, and so \_endure but for a \_time: \_afterward, when \_affliction \_or \_persecution \_ariseth for the \_word's sake, \_immediately they are \_offended.

**MARK 4:18**

18 And \_these are they which are \_sown \_among \_thorns; \_such as \_hear the \_word,

**MARK 4:19**

19 And the \_cares of \_this \_world, and the \_deceitfulness of \_riches, and the \_lusts of \_other things \_entering in, \_choke the \_word, and it \_becometh \_unfruitful.

**MARK 4:20**

20 And \_these are they which are \_sown \_on \_good \_ground; \_such as \_hear the \_word, and \_receive *it*, and \_bring \_forth \_fruit, \_some \_thirtyfold, \_some \_sixty, and \_some an \_hundred.

**MARK 4:21**

21 ¶ And he said unto them, Is a candle brought to be put under a bushel, or under a bed? and not to be set on a candlestick?

MARK 4:22

22 For there is nothing hid, which shall not be manifested; neither was any thing kept secret, but that it should come abroad.

MARK 4:23

23 If any man have ears to hear, let him hear.

MARK 4:24

24 And he said unto them, Take heed what ye hear: with what measure ye mete, it shall be measured to you: and unto you that hear shall more be given.

MARK 4:25

25 For he that hath, to him shall be given: and he that hath not, from him shall be taken even that which he hath.

MARK 4:26

26 And he said, So is the kingdom of God, as if a man should cast seed into the ground;

MARK 4:27

27 And should sleep, and rise night and day, and the seed should spring and grow up, he knoweth not how.

MARK 4:28

28 For the earth bringeth forth fruit of herself; first the blade, then the ear, after that the full corn in the ear.

MARK 4:29

29 But when the fruit is brought forth, immediately he putteth in the sickle, because the harvest is come.

MARK 4:30

30 And he said, Whereunto shall we liken the kingdom of God? or with what comparison shall we compare it?

MARK 4:31

31 It is like a grain of mustard seed, which, when it is sown in the earth, is less than all the seeds that be in the earth:

MARK 4:32

32 But when it is sown, it groweth up, and becometh greater than all herbs, and shooteth out great branches; so that the fowls of the air may lodge under the shadow of it.

MARK 4:33

33 And with many such parables spake he the word unto them, as they were able to hear it.

MARK 4:34

34 But without a parable spake he not unto them: and when they were alone, he expounded all things to his disciples.

MARK 4:35

35 ¶ And the same day, when the even was come, he saith unto them, Let us pass over unto the other side.

MARK 4:36

36 And when they had sent away the multitude, they took him even as he was in the ship. And there were also with him other little ships.

MARK 4:37

37 And there arose a great storm of wind, and the waves beat into the ship, so that it was now full.

MARK 4:38

38 And he was in the hinder part of the ship, asleep on a pillow: and they awake him, and say unto him, Master, carest thou not that we perish?

MARK 4:39

39 And he arose, and rebuked the wind, and said unto the sea, Peace, be still. And the wind ceased, and there was a great calm.

MARK 4:40

40 And he said unto them, Why are ye so fearful? how is it that ye have no faith?

MARK 4:41

41 And they feared exceedingly, and said one to another, What manner of man is this, that even the wind and the sea obey him?
