MARK 8

MARK 8:1

1 In those days the multitude being very great, and having nothing to eat, Jesus called his disciples *unto him*, and saith unto them,

MARK 8:2

2 I have _compassion _on the _multitude, _because they have _now _been with me _three _days, and _have _nothing to _eat:

MARK 8:3

3 And _if I _send them _away _fasting to their own _houses, they will _faint by the _way: for _divers of them _came from _far.

MARK 8:4

4 And his disciples answered him, From whence can a man satisfy these *men* with bread here in the wilderness?

MARK 8:5

5 And he asked them, _How _many _loaves _have ye? And they said, Seven.

MARK 8:6

6 And he commanded the people to sit down on the ground: and he took the seven loaves, and gave thanks, and brake, and gave to his disciples to set before *them*; and they did set *them* before the people.

MARK 8:7

7 And they had a few small fishes: and he blessed, and commanded to set them also before *them*.

MARK 8:8

8 So they did eat, and were filled: and they took up of the broken *meat* that was left seven baskets.

MARK 8:9

9 And they that had eaten were about four thousand: and he sent them away.

MARK 8:10

10 ¶ And straightway he entered into a ship with his disciples, and came into the parts of Dalmanutha.

MARK 8:11

11 And the Pharisees came forth, and began to question with him, seeking of him a sign from heaven, tempting him.

MARK 8:12

12 And he sighed deeply in his spirit, and saith, _Why doth _this _generation _seek _after a _sign? _verily I _say unto you, There shall _no _sign be _given unto _this _generation.

MARK 8:13

13 And he left them, and entering into the ship again departed to the other side.

MARK 8:14

14 Now the disciples had forgotten to take bread, neither had they in the ship with them more than one loaf.

MARK 8:15

15 And he charged them, saying, Take _heed, _beware of the _leaven of the _Pharisees, and *ot* the _leaven of _Herod.

MARK 8:16

16 And they reasoned among themselves, saying, *It is* because we have no bread.

MARK 8:17

17 And when Jesus knew *it*, he saith unto them, _Why _reason ye, _because ye _have _no _bread? _perceive ye not _yet, _neither _understand? _have ye _your heart _yet hardened?

MARK 8:18

18 _Having _eyes, _see ye not? and _having _ears, _hear ye not? and do ye not _remember?

MARK 8:19

19 When I _brake the _five _loaves _among _five _thousand, _how _many _baskets _full of _fragments _took ye up? They say unto him, Twelve.

MARK 8:20

20 And when the _seven _among _four _thousand, _how _many _baskets _full of _fragments _took ye up? And they said, Seven.

MARK 8:21

21 And he said unto them, _How is it that ye do not _understand?

MARK 8:22

22 ¶ And he cometh to Bethsaida; and they bring a blind man unto him, and besought him to touch him.

MARK 8:23

And he took the blind man by the hand, and led him out of the town; and when he had spit on his eyes, and put his hands upon him, he asked him if he saw ought.

MARK 8:24

24 And he looked up, and said, I see men as trees, walking.

MARK 8:25

25 After that he put *hi*s hands again upon his eyes, and made him look up: and he was restored, and saw every man clearly.

MARK 8:26

26 And he sent him away to his house, saying, _Neither _go _into the _town, _nor _tell it to _any in the _town.

MARK 8:27

27 ¶ And Jesus went out, and his disciples, into the towns of Caesarea Philippi: and by the way he asked his disciples, saying unto them, _Whom do _men _say that I am?

MARK 8:28

28 And they answered, John the Baptist: but some *say*, Elias; and others, One of the prophets.

MARK 8:29

29 And he saith unto them, But _whom _say ye that I _am? And Peter answereth and saith unto him, Thou art the Christ.

MARK 8:30

30 And he charged them that they should tell no man of him.

MARK 8:31

31 And he began to teach them, that the Son of man must suffer many things, and be rejected of the elders, and of the chief priests, and scribes, and be killed, and after three days rise again.

MARK 8:32

32 And he spake that saying openly. And Peter took him, and began to rebuke him.

MARK 8:33

33 But when he had turned about and looked on his disciples, he rebuked Peter, saying, _Get thee _behind me, _Satan: for thou _savourest not the things that be of _God, but the things that be of _men.

MARK 8:34

34 And when he had called the people *unto him* with his disciples also, he said unto them, _Whosoever _will _come _after me, let him _deny _himself, and _take up his _cross, and _follow me.

MARK 8:35

35 For _whosoever _will _save his _life shall _lose it; but _whosoever shall _lose his _life for my _sake and the _gospel's, the _same shall _save it.

MARK 8:36

36 For _what shall it _profit a _man, _if he shall _gain the _whole _world, and _lose his own soul?

MARK 8:37

37 Or _what shall a _man _give in _exchange for his _soul?

MARK 8:38

38 _Whosoever _therefore shall be _ashamed of me and of my _words in _this _adulterous and _sinful _generation; of him _also shall the _Son of _man be _ashamed, _when he _cometh in the _glory of his _Father with the _holy _angels.
