MARK 9

MARK 9:1

1 And he said unto them, _Verily I _say unto you, That there be _some of them that _stand _here, _which shall not _taste of _death, _till they have _seen the _kingdom of _God _come with _power.

MARK 9:2

2 And after six days Jesus taketh *with him* Peter, and James, and John, and leadeth them up into an high mountain apart by themselves: and he was transfigured before them.

MARK 9:3

3 And his raiment became shining, exceeding white as snow; so as no fuller on earth can white them.

MARK 9:4

4 And there appeared unto them Elias with Moses: and they were talking with Jesus.

MARK 9:5

5 And Peter answered and said to Jesus, Master, it is good for us to be here: and let us make three tabernacles; one for thee, and one for Moses, and one for Elias.

MARK 9:6

6 For he wist not what to say; for they were sore afraid.

MARK 9:7

7 And there was a cloud that overshadowed them: and a voice came out of the cloud, saying, This is my beloved Son: hear him.

MARK 9:8

8 And suddenly, when they had looked round about, they saw no man any more, save Jesus only with themselves.

MARK 9:9

9 And as they came down from the mountain, he charged them that they should tell no man what things they had seen, till the Son of man were risen from the dead.

MARK 9:10

10 And they kept that saying with themselves, questioning one with another what the rising from the dead should mean.

MARK 9:11

11 And they asked him, saying, Why say the scribes that Elias must first come?

MARK 9:12

12 And he answered and told them, _Elias _verily _cometh _first, and _restoreth _all things; and _how it is _written of the _Son of _man, that he must _suffer _many things, and be _set _at _nought.

MARK 9:13

13 But I _say unto you, That _Elias is _indeed _come, and they have _done unto him _whatsoever they _listed, as it is _written of him.

MARK 9:14

14 ¶ And when he came to *his* disciples, he saw a great multitude about them, and the scribes questioning with them.

MARK 9:15

15 And straightway all the people, when they beheld him, were greatly amazed, and running to *him* saluted him.

MARK 9:16

16 And he asked the scribes, _What _question ye with them?

MARK 9:17

17 And one of the multitude answered and said, Master, I have brought unto thee my son, which hath a dumb spirit;

MARK 9:18

18 And wheresoever he taketh him, he teareth him: and he foameth, and gnasheth with his teeth, and pineth away: and I spake to thy disciples that they should cast him out; and they could not.

MARK 9:19

19 He answereth him, and saith, O _faithless _generation, _how _long shall I be with you? _how _long shall I _suffer you? _bring him unto me.

MARK 9:20

20 And they brought him unto him: and when he saw him, straightway the spirit tare him; and he fell on the ground, and wallowed foaming.

MARK 9:21

21 And he asked his father, _How _long is it ago _since _this _came unto him? And he said, Of a child.

MARK 9:22

22 And ofttimes it hath cast him into the fire, and into the waters, to destroy him: but if thou canst do any thing, have compassion on us, and help us.

MARK 9:23

23 Jesus said unto him, _If thou _canst _believe, _all things *are* _possible to him that _believeth.

MARK 9:24

24 And straightway the father of the child cried out, and said with tears, Lord, I believe; help thou mine unbelief.

MARK 9:25

25 When Jesus saw that the people came running together, he rebuked the foul spirit, saying unto him, *Thou* _dumb and _deaf _spirit, I _charge thee, _come out of him, and _enter _no _more _into him.

MARK 9:26

26 And *the spirit* cried, and rent him sore, and came out of him: and he was as one dead; insomuch that many said, He is dead.

MARK 9:27

27 But Jesus took him by the hand, and lifted him up; and he arose.

MARK 9:28

28 And when he was come into the house, his disciples asked him privately, Why could not we cast him out?

MARK 9:29

29 And he said unto them, _This _kind _can _come _forth by _nothing, but by _prayer and _fasting.

MARK 9:30

30 ¶ And they departed thence, and passed through Galilee; and he would not that any man should know it.

MARK 9:31

31 For he taught his disciples, and said unto them, The _Son of _man is _delivered _into the _hands of _men, and they shall _kill him; and after that he is _killed, he shall _rise the _third _day.

MARK 9:32

32 But they understood not that saying, and were afraid to ask him.

MARK 9:33

33 And he came to Capernaum: and being in the house he asked them, _What was it that ye _disputed _among _yourselves by the _way?

MARK 9:34

34 But they held their peace: for by the way they had disputed among themselves, who *should be* the greatest.

MARK 9:35

35 And he sat down, and called the twelve, and saith unto them, _lf _any man _desire to be _first, *the same* shall be _last of _all, and _servant of _all.

MARK 9:36

36 And he took a child, and set him in the midst of them: and when he had taken him in his arms, he said unto them,

MARK 9:37

37 _Whosoever shall _receive _one of _such _children in my _name, _receiveth me: and _whosoever shall _receive me, _receiveth not me, but him that _sent me.

MARK 9:38

38 And John answered him, saying, Master, we saw one casting out devils in thy name, and he followeth not us: and we forbad him, because he followeth not us.

MARK 9:39

39 But Jesus said, _Forbid him not: for there is _no _man _which shall _do a _miracle in my _name, that _can _lightly _speak _evil of me.

MARK 9:40

40 For he that is not _against us is _on our part.

MARK 9:41

41 ¶ For _whosoever shall _give you a _cup of _water to _drink in my _name, _because ye _belong to _Christ, _verily I _say unto you, he shall not _lose his _reward.

MARK 9:42

42 And _whosoever shall _offend _one of *these* _little ones that _believe in me, it is _better for him that a _millstone were _hanged _about his _neck, and he were _cast into the _sea.

MARK 9:43

43 And _if thy _hand _offend thee, _cut it _off: it is _better for thee to _enter _into

_life _maimed, _than _having _two _hands to _go _into _hell, _into the _fire that _never shall be _quenched:

MARK 9:44

44 _Where their _worm _dieth not, and the _fire is not _quenched.

MARK 9:45

45 And _if thy _foot _offend thee, _cut it _off: it is _better for thee to _enter _halt _into _life, _than _having _two _feet to be _cast _into _hell, _into the _fire that _never shall be _quenched:

MARK 9:46

46 _Where their _worm _dieth not, and the _fire is not _quenched.

MARK 9:47

47 And _if _thine _eye _offend thee, _pluck it out: it is _better for thee to _enter _into the _kingdom of _God with _one _eye, _than _having _two _eyes to be _cast _into _hell _fire:

MARK 9:48

48 _Where their _worm _dieth not, and the _fire is not _quenched.

MARK 9:49

49 For _every one shall be _salted with _fire, and _every _sacrifice shall be _salted with _salt.

MARK 9:50

50 _Salt *is* _good: but _if the _salt have _lost his _saltness, _wherewith will ye _season it? _Have _salt in _yourselves, and have _peace _one with _another.
