MATTHEW 12:1

1 ¶ At that time Jesus went on the sabbath day through the corn; and his disciples were an hungred, and began to pluck the ears of corn, and to eat.

MATTHEW 12:2

2 But when the Pharisees saw *it*, they said unto him, Behold, thy disciples do that which is not lawful to do upon the sabbath day.

MATTHEW 12:3

3 But he said unto them, Have ye not *read what David did, when he was an hungred, and they that were with him;*

MATTHEW 12:4

4 *How he entered into the house of God, and did eat the shewbread, which was not lawful for him to eat, neither for them which were with him, but only for the priests?*

MATTHEW 12:5

5 *Or have ye not read in the law, how that on the sabbath days the priests in the temple profane the sabbath, and are blameless?*

MATTHEW 12:6

6 But I say unto you, That in *this place is one greater than the temple.*

MATTHEW 12:7

7 But *if ye had known what this meaneth, I will have mercy, and not sacrifice, ye would not have condemned the guiltless.*

MATTHEW 12:8

8 For the *Son of man is Lord even of the sabbath day.*

MATTHEW 12:9

9 And when he was departed thence, he went into their synagogue:

MATTHEW 12:10

10 And, behold, there was a man which had *his* hand withered. And they asked him, saying, Is it lawful to heal on the sabbath days? that they might accuse him.

MATTHEW 12:11

11 And he said unto them, *What man shall there be among you, that shall have one sheep, and if it fall into a pit on the sabbath day, will he not lay hold on it,*

and *lift it* out?

MATTHEW 12:12

12 *How much then is a man better than a sheep? Wherefore it is lawful to do well on the sabbath days.*

MATTHEW 12:13

13 Then saith he to the man, *Stretch forth thine hand.* And he stretched *it* forth; and it was restored whole, like as the other.

MATTHEW 12:14

14 ¶ Then the Pharisees went out, and held a council against him, how they might destroy him.

MATTHEW 12:15

15 But when Jesus knew *it*, he withdrew himself from thence: and great multitudes followed him, and he healed them all;

MATTHEW 12:16

16 And charged them that they should not make him known:

MATTHEW 12:17

17 That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying,

MATTHEW 12:18

18 Behold my servant, whom I have chosen; my beloved, in whom my soul is well pleased: I will put my spirit upon him, and he shall shew judgment to the Gentiles.

MATTHEW 12:19

19 He shall not strive, nor cry; neither shall any man hear his voice in the streets.

MATTHEW 12:20

20 A bruised reed shall he not break, and smoking flax shall he not quench, till he send forth judgment unto victory.

MATTHEW 12:21

21 And in his name shall the Gentiles trust.

MATTHEW 12:22

22 ¶ Then was brought unto him one possessed with a devil, blind, and dumb: and he healed him, insomuch that the blind and dumb both spake and saw.

MATTHEW 12:23

23 And all the people were amazed, and said, Is not this the son of David?

MATTHEW 12:24

24 But when the Pharisees heard *it*, they said, This *fellow* doth not cast out devils, but by Beelzebub the prince of the devils.

MATTHEW 12:25

25 And Jesus knew their thoughts, and said unto them, *Every kingdom divided against itself is brought to desolation; and every city or house divided against itself shall not stand:*

MATTHEW 12:26

26 *And if Satan cast out Satan, he is divided against himself; how shall then his kingdom stand?*

MATTHEW 12:27

27 *And if I by Beelzebub cast out devils, by whom do your children cast them out? therefore they shall be your judges.*

MATTHEW 12:28

28 *But if I cast out devils by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God is come unto you.*

MATTHEW 12:29

29 *Or else how can one enter into a strong man's house, and spoil his goods, except he first bind the strong man? and then he will spoil his house.*

MATTHEW 12:30

30 He that is not with me is against me; and he that gathereth not with me scattereth abroad.

MATTHEW 12:31

31 *Wherefore I say unto you, All manner of sin and blasphemy shall be forgiven unto men: but the blasphemy against the Holy Ghost shall not be forgiven unto men.*

MATTHEW 12:32

32 *And whosoever speaketh a word against the Son of man, it shall be forgiven him: but whosoever speaketh against the Holy Ghost, it shall not be forgiven him, neither in this world, neither in the world to come.*

MATTHEW 12:33

33 *Either make the tree good, and his fruit good; or else make the tree corrupt, and his fruit corrupt: for the tree is known by his fruit.*

MATTHEW 12:34

34 O _generation of _vipers, _how _can ye, _being _evil, _speak _good things? for out of the _abundance of the _heart the _mouth _speaketh.

MATTHEW 12:35

35 A _good _man out of the _good _treasure of the _heart _bringeth _forth _good things: and an _evil _man out of the _evil _treasure _bringeth forth _evil things.

MATTHEW 12:36

36 But I _say unto you, That _every _idle _word that _men shall _speak, they shall _give _account _thereof in the _day of _judgment.

MATTHEW 12:37

37 For by thy _words thou shalt be _justified, and by thy _words thou shalt be _condemned.

MATTHEW 12:38

38 ¶ Then certain of the scribes and of the Pharisees answered, saying, Master, we would see a sign from thee.

MATTHEW 12:39

39 But he answered and said unto them, An _evil and _adulterous _generation _seeketh _after a _sign; and there shall _no _sign be _given to it, but the _sign of the _prophet _Jonas:

MATTHEW 12:40

40 For as _Jonas was _three _days and _three _nights in the _whale's _belly; _so shall the _Son of _man be _three _days and _three _nights in the _heart of the _earth.

MATTHEW 12:41

41 The _men of _Nineveh shall _rise in _judgment with _this _generation, and shall _condemn it: _because they _repented _at the _preaching of _Jonas; and, _behold, a _greater than _Jonas *is* _here.

MATTHEW 12:42

42 The _queen of the _south shall _rise up in the _judgment with _this _generation, and shall _condemn it: for she _came from the _uttermost parts of the _earth to _hear the _wisdom of _Solomon; and, _behold, a _greater than _Solomon *is* _here.

MATTHEW 12:43

43 _When the _unclean _spirit is _gone out of a _man, he _walketh _through _dry _places, _seeking _rest, and _findeth _none.

MATTHEW 12:44

44 Then he saith, I will return into my house from whence I came out; and when he is come, he findeth it empty, swept, and garnished.

MATTHEW 12:45

45 Then goeth he, and taketh with himself seven other spirits more wicked than himself, and they enter in and dwell there: and the last state of that man is worse than the first. Even so shall it be also unto this wicked generation.

MATTHEW 12:46

46 ¶ While he yet talked to the people, behold, his mother and his brethren stood without, desiring to speak with him.

MATTHEW 12:47

47 Then one said unto him, Behold, thy mother and thy brethren stand without, desiring to speak with thee.

MATTHEW 12:48

48 But he answered and said unto him that told him, Who is my mother? and who are my brethren?

MATTHEW 12:49

49 And he stretched forth his hand toward his disciples, and said, Behold my mother and my brethren!

MATTHEW 12:50

50 For whosoever shall do the will of my Father which is in heaven, the same is my brother, and sister, and mother.
