#### **MATTHEW 13:1**

1 The same day went Jesus out of the house, and sat by the sea side.

# **MATTHEW 13:2**

2 And great multitudes were gathered together unto him, so that he went into a ship, and sat; and the whole multitude stood on the shore.

#### **MATTHEW 13:3**

3 And he spake many things unto them in parables, saying, \_Behold, a \_sower \_went \_forth to \_sow;

## MATTHEW 13:4

4 And \_when he \_sowed, \_some *seeds* \_fell by the \_way \_side, and the \_fowls \_came and \_devoured them up:

## MATTHEW 13:5

5 \_Some \_fell upon \_stony places, \_where they \_had not \_much \_earth: and \_forthwith they \_sprung up, \_because they \_had \_no \_deepness of \_earth:

#### MATTHEW 13:6

6 And when the \_sun was \_up, they were \_scorched; and \_because they \_had \_no \_root, they \_withered away.

#### MATTHEW 13:7

7 And \_some \_fell \_among \_thorns; and the \_thorns \_sprung up, and \_choked them:

#### **MATTHEW 13:8**

8 But \_other \_fell \_into \_good \_ground, and \_brought forth \_fruit, \_some an \_hundredfold, \_some \_sixtyfold, \_some \_thirtyfold.

#### **MATTHEW 13:9**

9 Who hath ears to hear, let him hear.

## **MATTHEW 13:10**

10 And the disciples came, and said unto him, Why speakest thou unto them in parables?

#### **MATTHEW 13:11**

11 He answered and said unto them, \_Because it is \_given unto you to \_know the \_mysteries of the \_kingdom of \_heaven, but to them it is not \_given.

12 For \_whosoever \_hath, to him shall be \_given, and he shall have more \_abundance: but \_whosoever \_hath not, from him shall be \_taken \_away \_even that he \_hath.

#### **MATTHEW 13:13**

13 \_Therefore \_speak I to them in \_parables: \_because they \_seeing \_see not; and \_hearing they \_hear not, \_neither do they \_understand.

## **MATTHEW 13:14**

14 And in them is \_fulfilled the \_prophecy of \_Esaias, \_which \_saith, By \_hearing ye shall \_hear, and shall not \_understand; and \_seeing ye shall \_see, and shall not perceive:

# **MATTHEW 13:15**

15 For \_this \_people's \_heart is \_waxed \_gross, and *their* \_ears are \_dull of \_hearing, and their \_eyes they have \_closed; \_lest \_at \_any \_time they should \_see with *their* \_eyes, and \_hear with *their* \_ears, and should \_understand with *their* \_heart, and should be \_converted, and I should \_heal them.

## **MATTHEW 13:16**

16 But \_blessed are \_your \_eyes, for they \_see: and \_your \_ears, for they \_hear.

# **MATTHEW 13:17**

17 For \_verily I \_say unto you, That \_many \_prophets and \_righteous *men* have \_desired to \_see *those things* \_which ye \_see, and have not \_seen *them*; and to \_hear *those things* \_which ye \_hear, and have not \_heard *them*.

# **MATTHEW 13:18**

18 \_Hear ye \_therefore the \_parable of the \_sower.

#### **MATTHEW 13:19**

19 When \_any one \_heareth the \_word of the \_kingdom, and \_understandeth *it* not, then \_cometh the \_wicked *one*, and \_catcheth \_away that \_which was \_sown in his \_heart. \_This is he \_which \_received \_seed by the \_way \_side.

## **MATTHEW 13:20**

20 But he that \_received the \_seed \_into \_stony places, the \_same is he that \_heareth the \_word, and \_anon with \_joy \_receiveth it;

#### **MATTHEW 13:21**

21 \_Yet \_hath he not \_root in \_himself, but \_dureth for a \_while: for when \_tribulation \_or \_persecution \_ariseth \_because of the \_word, by and \_by he is \_offended.

22 He \_also that \_received \_seed \_among the \_thorns is he that \_heareth the \_word; and the \_care of \_this \_world, and the \_deceitfulness of \_riches, \_choke the word, and he \_becometh unfruitful.

# **MATTHEW 13:23**

23 But he that \_received \_seed \_into the \_good \_ground is he that \_heareth the \_word, and \_understandeth *it*; \_which \_also \_beareth \_fruit, and \_bringeth \_forth, \_some an \_hundredfold, \_some \_sixty, \_some \_thirty.

# **MATTHEW 13:24**

24 ¶ Another parable put he forth unto them, saying, The \_kingdom of \_heaven is \_likened unto a \_man which \_sowed \_good \_seed in his \_field:

## **MATTHEW 13:25**

25 But \_while \_men \_slept, his \_enemy \_came and \_sowed \_tares \_among the \_wheat, and \_went his way.

## **MATTHEW 13:26**

26 But \_when the \_blade was \_sprung up, and \_brought \_forth \_fruit, \_then \_appeared the \_tares \_also.

## **MATTHEW 13:27**

27 \_So the \_servants of the \_householder \_came and \_said unto him, \_Sir, didst not thou \_sow \_good \_seed in thy \_field? from \_whence \_then \_hath it \_tares?

## **MATTHEW 13:28**

28 He \_said unto them, An \_enemy hath \_done \_this. The \_servants \_said unto him, \_Wilt thou \_then that we \_go and \_gather them up?

#### **MATTHEW 13:29**

29 But he \_said, \_Nay; \_lest while ye \_gather up the \_tares, ye \_root up \_also the \_wheat with them.

#### **MATTHEW 13:30**

30 \_Let \_both \_grow \_together \_until the \_harvest: and in the \_time of \_harvest I will \_say to the \_reapers, \_Gather ye \_together \_first the \_tares, and \_bind them in \_bundles to \_burn them: but \_gather the \_wheat \_into my \_barn.

## **MATTHEW 13:31**

31 Another parable put he forth unto them, saying, The \_kingdom of \_heaven is \_like to a \_grain of \_mustard seed, \_which a \_man \_took, and \_sowed in his \_field:

32 \_Which \_indeed is the \_least of \_all \_seeds: but \_when it is \_grown, it is the \_greatest among \_herbs, and \_becometh a \_tree, \_so that the \_birds of the \_air \_come and \_lodge in the \_branches \_thereof.

## **MATTHEW 13:33**

33 Another parable spake he unto them; The \_kingdom of \_heaven is \_like unto \_leaven, \_which a \_woman \_took, and \_hid in \_three \_measures of \_meal, \_till the \_whole was \_leavened.

## **MATTHEW 13:34**

34 All these things spake Jesus unto the multitude in parables; and without a parable spake he not unto them:

## **MATTHEW 13:35**

35 That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet, saying, I will open my mouth in parables; I will utter things which have been kept secret from the foundation of the world.

## **MATTHEW 13:36**

36 Then Jesus sent the multitude away, and went into the house: and his disciples came unto him, saying, Declare unto us the parable of the tares of the field.

#### **MATTHEW 13:37**

37 He answered and said unto them, He that \_soweth the \_good \_seed is the \_Son of man;

#### **MATTHEW 13:38**

**38** The \_field is the \_world; the \_good \_seed are the \_children of the \_kingdom; but the \_tares are the \_children of the \_wicked *one*;

## **MATTHEW 13:39**

39 The \_enemy that \_sowed them is the \_devil; the \_harvest is the \_end of the \_world; and the \_reapers are the \_angels.

#### **MATTHEW 13:40**

40 As \_therefore the \_tares are \_gathered and \_burned in the \_fire; \_so shall it be in the \_end of \_this \_world.

## **MATTHEW 13:41**

41 The \_Son of \_man shall \_send \_forth his \_angels, and they shall \_gather out of his \_kingdom \_all things that \_offend, and them which \_do \_iniquity;

42 And shall \_cast them \_into a \_furnace of \_fire: \_there shall be \_wailing and \_gnashing of \_teeth.

# **MATTHEW 13:43**

43 \_Then shall the \_righteous \_shine \_forth as the \_sun in the \_kingdom of their \_Father. \_Who \_hath \_ears to \_hear, let him \_hear.

## **MATTHEW 13:44**

44 ¶ \_Again, the \_kingdom of \_heaven is \_like unto \_treasure \_hid in a \_field; the \_which when a \_man hath \_found, he \_hideth, and for \_joy \_thereof \_goeth and \_selleth \_all that he \_hath, and \_buyeth that \_field.

#### **MATTHEW 13:45**

45 \_Again, the \_kingdom of \_heaven is \_like unto a \_merchant \_man, \_seeking \_goodly \_pearls:

## **MATTHEW 13:46**

46 \_Who, when he had \_found \_one \_pearl of \_great \_price, \_went and \_sold \_all that he \_had, and \_bought it.

#### **MATTHEW 13:47**

47 \_Again, the \_kingdom of \_heaven is \_like unto a \_net, that was \_cast \_into the \_sea, and \_gathered of \_every \_kind:

## **MATTHEW 13:48**

48 \_Which, \_when it was \_full, they \_drew to \_shore, and \_sat \_down, and gathered the good into vessels, but cast the bad away.

#### **MATTHEW 13:49**

49 \_So shall it be \_at the \_end of the \_world: the \_angels shall \_come \_forth, and \_sever the \_wicked from \_among the \_just,

#### **MATTHEW 13:50**

50 And shall \_cast them \_into the \_furnace of \_fire: \_there shall be \_wailing and \_gnashing of \_teeth.

## **MATTHEW 13:51**

51 Jesus saith unto them, Have ye \_understood \_all \_these things? They say unto him, Yea, Lord.

## **MATTHEW 13:52**

52 Then said he unto them, \_Therefore \_every \_scribe which is \_instructed unto the

\_kingdom of \_heaven is \_like unto a \_man *that is* an \_householder, \_which \_bringeth \_forth out of his \_treasure *things* \_new and \_old.

## **MATTHEW 13:53**

53 ¶ And it came to pass, *that* when Jesus had finished these parables, he departed thence.

## **MATTHEW 13:54**

54 And when he was come into his own country, he taught them in their synagogue, insomuch that they were astonished, and said, Whence hath this *man* this wisdom, and *these* mighty works?

## **MATTHEW 13:55**

55 Is not this the carpenter's son? is not his mother called Mary? and his brethren, James, and Joses, and Simon, and Judas?

#### **MATTHEW 13:56**

56 And his sisters, are they not all with us? Whence then hath this *man* all these things?

## **MATTHEW 13:57**

57 And they were offended in him. But Jesus said unto them, A \_prophet is not \_without \_honour, \_save in his own \_country, and in his own \_house.

# **MATTHEW 13:58**

58 And he did not many mighty works there because of their unbelief.
