MATTHEW 15

MATTHEW 15:1

1 Then came to Jesus scribes and Pharisees, which were of Jerusalem, saying,

MATTHEW 15:2

2 Why do thy disciples transgress the tradition of the elders? for they wash not their hands when they eat bread.

MATTHEW 15:3

3 But he answered and said unto them, _Why do ye _also _transgress the _commandment of _God by _your _tradition?

MATTHEW 15:4

4 For _God _commanded, _saying, _Honour thy _father and _mother: and, He that _curseth _father _or _mother, let him _die the _death.

MATTHEW 15:5

5 But ye _say, _Whosoever shall _say to *his* _father _or *his* _mother, *It is* a _gift, by _whatsoever thou mightest be _profited by me;

MATTHEW 15:6

6 And _honour not his _father _or his _mother, he shall be free. _Thus have ye _made the _commandment of _God of _none _effect by _your _tradition.

MATTHEW 15:7

7 Ye _hypocrites, _well did _Esaias _prophesy of you, _saying,

MATTHEW 15:8

8 _This _people draweth _nigh unto me with their _mouth, and _honoureth me with their _lips; but their _heart _is _far from _me.

MATTHEW 15:9

9 But in _vain they do _worship me, _teaching *for* _doctrines the _commandments of men.

MATTHEW 15:10

10 ¶ And he called the multitude, and said unto them, _Hear, and _understand:

MATTHEW 15:11

11 Not that which _goeth _into the _mouth _defileth a _man; but that which _cometh out of the _mouth, _this _defileth a _man.

MATTHEW 15:12

12 Then came his disciples, and said unto him, Knowest thou that the Pharisees were offended, after they heard this saying?

MATTHEW 15:13

13 But he answered and said, _Every _plant, _which my _heavenly _Father hath not _planted, shall be _rooted up.

MATTHEW 15:14

14 _Let them _alone: they be _blind _leaders of the _blind. And _if the _blind _lead the _blind, _both shall _fall _into the _ditch.

MATTHEW 15:15

15 Then answered Peter and said unto him, Declare unto us this parable.

MATTHEW 15:16

16 And Jesus said, Are ye _also _yet _without _understanding?

MATTHEW 15:17

17 Do not ye _yet _understand, that _whatsoever _entereth in _at the _mouth goeth into the belly, and is cast out into the draught?

MATTHEW 15:18

18 But _those things _which _proceed out of the _mouth _come _forth from the _heart; and they _defile the _man.

MATTHEW 15:19

19 For out of the _heart _proceed _evil _thoughts, _murders, _adulteries, _fornications, _thefts, _false _witness, _blasphemies:

MATTHEW 15:20

20 _These are *the things* _which _defile a _man: but to _eat with _unwashen _hands _defileth not a _man.

MATTHEW 15:21

21 Then Jesus went thence, and departed into the coasts of Tyre and Sidon.

MATTHEW 15:22

22 And, behold, a woman of Canaan came out of the same coasts, and cried unto him, saying, Have mercy on me, O Lord, *thou* Son of David; my daughter is grievously vexed with a devil.

MATTHEW 15:23

23 But he answered her not a word. And his disciples came and besought him, saying, Send her away; for she crieth after us.

MATTHEW 15:24

24 But he answered and said, I am not _sent but unto the _lost _sheep of the _house of _lsrael.

MATTHEW 15:25

25 Then came she and worshipped him, saying, Lord, help me.

MATTHEW 15:26

26 But he answered and said, It is not _meet to _take the _children's _bread, and to _cast it to _dogs.

MATTHEW 15:27

27 And she said, Truth, Lord: yet the dogs eat of the crumbs which fall from their masters' table.

MATTHEW 15:28

28 Then Jesus answered and said unto her, _O _woman, _great *is* thy _faith: be it unto thee even as thou _wilt. And her daughter was made whole from that very hour.

MATTHEW 15:29

29 ¶ And Jesus departed from thence, and came nigh unto the sea of Galilee; and went up into a mountain, and sat down there.

MATTHEW 15:30

30 And great multitudes came unto him, having with them *those that were* lame, blind, dumb, maimed, and many others, and cast them down at Jesus' feet; and he healed them:

MATTHEW 15:31

31 Insomuch that the multitude wondered, when they saw the dumb to speak, the maimed to be whole, the lame to walk, and the blind to see: and they glorified the God of Israel.

MATTHEW 15:32

32 Then Jesus called his disciples *unto him*, and said, I have _compassion _on the _multitude, _because they _continue with me _now _three _days, and _have _nothing to _eat: and I _will not _send them _away _fasting, _lest they _faint in the _way.

MATTHEW 15:33

33 And his disciples say unto him, Whence should we have so much bread in the wilderness, as to fill so great a multitude?

MATTHEW 15:34

34 And Jesus saith unto them, _How _many _loaves _have ye? And they said, Seven, and a few little fishes.

MATTHEW 15:35

35 And he commanded the multitude to sit down on the ground.

MATTHEW 15:36

36 And he took the seven loaves and the fishes, and gave thanks, and brake *them*, and gave to his disciples, and the disciples to the multitude.

MATTHEW 15:37

37 And they did all eat, and were filled: and they took up of the broken *meat* that was left seven baskets full.

MATTHEW 15:38

38 And they that did eat were four thousand men, beside women and children.

MATTHEW 15:39

39 And he sent away the multitude, and took ship, and came into the coasts of Magdala.
