MATTHEW 17

MATTHEW 17:1

1 ¶ And after six days Jesus taketh Peter, James, and John his brother, and bringeth them up into an high mountain apart,

MATTHEW 17:2

2 And was transfigured before them: and his face did shine as the sun, and his raiment was white as the light.

MATTHEW 17:3

3 And, behold, there appeared unto them Moses and Elias talking with him.

MATTHEW 17:4

4 Then answered Peter, and said unto Jesus, Lord, it is good for us to be here: if thou wilt, let us make here three tabernacles; one for thee, and one for Moses, and one for Elias.

MATTHEW 17:5

5 While he yet spake, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them: and behold a voice out of the cloud, which said, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased; hear ye him.

MATTHEW 17:6

6 And when the disciples heard it, they fell on their face, and were sore afraid.

MATTHEW 17:7

7 And Jesus came and touched them, and said, _Arise, and be not _afraid.

MATTHEW 17:8

8 And when they had lifted up their eyes, they saw no man, save Jesus only.

MATTHEW 17:9

9 And as they came down from the mountain, Jesus charged them, saying, _Tell the _vision to _no _man, _until the _Son of _man be _risen _again from the _dead.

MATTHEW 17:10

10 And his disciples asked him, saying, Why then say the scribes that Elias must first come?

MATTHEW 17:11

11 And Jesus answered and said unto them, _Elias _truly shall _first _come, and _restore _all things.

MATTHEW 17:12

12 But I _say unto you, That _Elias is _come _already, and they _knew him not, but have _done unto him _whatsoever they _listed. _Likewise shall _also the _Son of _man _suffer of them.

MATTHEW 17:13

13 Then the disciples understood that he spake unto them of John the Baptist.

MATTHEW 17:14

14 ¶ And when they were come to the multitude, there came to him a *certain* man, kneeling down to him, and saying,

MATTHEW 17:15

15 Lord, have mercy on my son: for he is lunatick, and sore vexed: for ofttimes he falleth into the fire, and oft into the water.

MATTHEW 17:16

16 And I brought him to thy disciples, and they could not cure him.

MATTHEW 17:17

17 Then Jesus answered and said, _O _faithless and _perverse _generation, _how _long shall I be with you? _how _long shall I _suffer you? _bring him _hither to me.

MATTHEW 17:18

18 And Jesus rebuked the devil; and he departed out of him: and the child was cured from that very hour.

MATTHEW 17:19

19 Then came the disciples to Jesus apart, and said, Why could not we cast him out?

MATTHEW 17:20

20 And Jesus said unto them, _Because of _your _unbelief: for _verily I _say unto you, _If ye _have _faith as a _grain of _mustard seed, ye shall _say unto _this _mountain, _Remove _hence to _yonder place; and it shall _remove; and _nothing shall be _impossible unto you.

MATTHEW 17:21

21 Howbeit _this _kind _goeth not out but by _prayer and _fasting.

MATTHEW 17:22

22 ¶ And while they abode in Galilee, Jesus said unto them, The _Son of _man

shall be _betrayed _into the _hands of _men:

MATTHEW 17:23

23 And they shall _kill him, and the _third _day he shall be _raised _again. And they were _exceeding _sorry.

MATTHEW 17:24

24 ¶ And when they were come to Capernaum, they that received tribute *money* came to Peter, and said, Doth not your master pay tribute?

MATTHEW 17:25

25 He saith, Yes. And when he was come into the house, Jesus prevented him, saying, _What _thinkest thou, _Simon? of _whom do the _kings of the _earth _take _custom _or _tribute? of their own _children, _or of _strangers?

MATTHEW 17:26

26 Peter saith unto him, Of strangers. Jesus saith unto him, _Then are the _children _free.

MATTHEW 17:27

27 Notwithstanding, _lest we should _offend them, _go thou to the _sea, and _cast an _hook, and _take up the _fish that _first _cometh up; and when thou hast _opened his _mouth, thou shalt _find a piece of _money: that _take, and _give unto them for me and thee.
