MATTHEW 18:1

1 ¶ At the same time came the disciples unto Jesus, saying, Who is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven?

MATTHEW 18:2

2 And Jesus called a little child unto him, and set him in the midst of them,

MATTHEW 18:3

3 And said, Verily I say unto you, Except ye be converted, and become as little children, ye shall not enter into the kingdom of heaven.

MATTHEW 18:4

4 Whosoever therefore shall humble himself as this little child, the same is greatest in the kingdom of heaven.

MATTHEW 18:5

5 And whoso shall receive one such little child in my name receiveth me.

MATTHEW 18:6

6 But whoso shall offend one of these little ones which believe in me, it were better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and that he were drowned in the depth of the sea.

MATTHEW 18:7

7 ¶ Woe unto the world because of offences! for it must needs be that offences come; but woe to that man by whom the offence cometh!

MATTHEW 18:8

8 Wherefore if thy hand or thy foot offend thee, cut them off, and cast them from thee: it is better for thee to enter into life halt or maimed, rather than having two hands or two feet to be cast into everlasting fire.

MATTHEW 18:9

9 And if thine eye offend thee, pluck it out, and cast it from thee: it is better for thee to enter into life with one eye, rather than having two eyes to be cast into hell fire.

MATTHEW 18:10

10 Take heed that ye despise not one of these little ones; for I say unto you, That in heaven their angels do always behold the face of my Father which is in

_heaven.

MATTHEW 18:11

11 For the _Son of _man is _come to _save that _which was _lost.

MATTHEW 18:12

12 _How _think ye? _if a _man _have an _hundred _sheep, and _one of them be _gone _astray, doth he not _leave the _ninety and _nine, and _goeth _into the _mountains, and _seeketh that _which is _gone _astray?

MATTHEW 18:13

13 And _if _so be that he _find it, _verily I _say unto you, he _rejoiceth _more of that *sheep*, _than of the _ninety and _nine _which _went not _astray.

MATTHEW 18:14

14 Even _so it is not the _will of _your _Father _which is in _heaven, that _one of _these _little ones should _perish.

MATTHEW 18:15

15 ¶ _Moreover _if thy _brother shall _trespass _against thee, _go and _tell him his _fault _between thee and him _alone: _if he shall _hear thee, thou hast _gained thy _brother.

MATTHEW 18:16

16 But _if he will _not _hear *thee*, *then* _take with thee _one _or _two _more, that in the _mouth of _two _or _three _witnesses _every _word may be _established.

MATTHEW 18:17

17 And _if he shall _neglect to _hear them, _tell *it* unto the _church: but _if he _neglect to _hear the _church, _let _him _be unto thee as an _heathen man and a _publican.

MATTHEW 18:18

18 _Verily I _say unto you, _Whatsoever ye shall _bind _on _earth shall be _bound in _heaven: and _whatsoever ye shall _loose _on _earth shall be _loosed in _heaven.

MATTHEW 18:19

19 _Again I _say unto you, That _if _two of you shall _agree _on _earth as _touching _any _thing that they shall _ask, it shall be _done for them of my _Father _which is in _heaven.

MATTHEW 18:20

20 For _where _two _or _three are _gathered _together in my _name, _there _am I

in the _midst of them.

MATTHEW 18:21

21 ¶ Then came Peter to him, and said, Lord, how oft shall my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? till seven times?

MATTHEW 18:22

22 Jesus saith unto him, I _say not unto thee, _Until _seven _times: but, _Until _seventy _times _seven.

MATTHEW 18:23

23 _Therefore is the _kingdom of _heaven _likened unto a _certain _king, _which _would _take _account of his _servants.

MATTHEW 18:24

24 And when he had _begun to _reckon, _one was _brought unto him, which _owed him _ten _thousand _talents.

MATTHEW 18:25

25 But forasmuch as he _had not to _pay, his _lord _commanded him to be _sold, and his _wife, and _children, and _all that he _had, and _payment to be _made.

MATTHEW 18:26

26 The _servant _therefore _fell down, and _worshipped him, _saying, _Lord, have _patience with me, and I will _pay thee _all.

MATTHEW 18:27

27 _Then the _lord of that _servant was _moved with _compassion, and _loosed him, and _forgave him the _debt.

MATTHEW 18:28

28 But the _same _servant _went out, and _found _one of his _fellowservants, _which _owed him an _hundred _pence: and he laid _hands on him, and _took *him* by the _throat, _saying, _Pay me that thou _owest.

MATTHEW 18:29

29 And his _fellowservant _fell down _at his _feet, and _besought him, _saying, Have _patience with me, and I will _pay thee all.

MATTHEW 18:30

30 And he _would not: but _went and _cast him _into _prison, _till he should _pay the _debt.

MATTHEW 18:31

31 _So when his _fellowservants _saw _what was _done, they were _very _sorry, and _came and _told unto their _lord _all that was _done.

MATTHEW 18:32

32 _Then his _lord, after that he had _called him, _said unto him, O thou _wicked _servant, I _forgave thee _all that _debt, _because thou _desiredst me:

MATTHEW 18:33

33 _Shouldst not _thou _also have had _compassion on thy _fellowservant, _even as I had _pity on _thee?

MATTHEW 18:34

34 _And his _lord was _wroth, and _delivered him to the _tormentors, _till he should _pay _all that was _due unto him.

MATTHEW 18:35

35 _So _likewise shall my _heavenly _Father _do _also unto you, _if ye from _your _hearts _forgive _not _every one his _brother their _trespasses.
