MATTHEW 20:1

1 For the _kingdom of _heaven is _like unto a _man *that is* an _householder, _which _went out _early in the morning to _hire _labourers _into his _vineyard.

MATTHEW 20:2

2 And when he had _agreed with the _labourers for a _penny a _day, he _sent them _into his _vineyard.

MATTHEW 20:3

3 And he _went out _about the _third _hour, and _saw _others _standing _idle in the _marketplace,

MATTHEW 20:4

4 And _said unto them; _Go ye _also _into the _vineyard, and _whatsoever is _right I will give you. And they _went their way.

MATTHEW 20:5

5 _Again he _went out _about the _sixth and _ninth _hour, and _did _likewise.

MATTHEW 20:6

6 And _about the _eleventh _hour he _went out, and _found _others _standing _idle, and _saith unto them, _Why _stand ye here _all the _day _idle?

MATTHEW 20:7

7 They _say unto him, _Because _no _man hath _hired us. He _saith unto them, _Go ye _also _into the _vineyard; and _whatsoever is _right, *that* shall ye _receive.

MATTHEW 20:8

8 _So when _even was _come, the _lord of the _vineyard _saith unto his _steward, _Call the _labourers, and _give them *their* _hire, _beginning from the _last unto the first.

MATTHEW 20:9

9 And when they _came that were hired _about the _eleventh _hour, they _received _every man a _penny.

MATTHEW 20:10

10 But when the _first _came, they _supposed that they should have _received _more; and they _likewise _received _every man a _penny.

MATTHEW 20:11

11 And when they had _received *it*, they _murmured _against the _goodman of the house,

MATTHEW 20:12

12 _Saying, _These _last have _wrought *but* _one _hour, and thou hast _made them _equal unto us, _which have _borne the _burden and _heat of the _day.

MATTHEW 20:13

13 But he _answered _one of them, and _said, _Friend, I _do _thee _no _wrong: didst not thou _agree with me for a _penny?

MATTHEW 20:14

14 _Take *that* _thine *is*, and _go thy way: I _will _give unto _this _last, _even as unto thee.

MATTHEW 20:15

15 Is it not _lawful for me to _do _what I _will with _mine own? Is _thine _eye _evil, _because I _am _good?

MATTHEW 20:16

16 _So the _last shall be _first, and the _first _last: for _many be _called, but _few chosen.

MATTHEW 20:17

17 ¶ And Jesus going up to Jerusalem took the twelve disciples apart in the way, and said unto them,

MATTHEW 20:18

18 _Behold, we _go up to _Jerusalem; and the _Son of _man shall be _betrayed unto the _chief _priests and unto the _scribes, and they shall _condemn him to _death,

MATTHEW 20:19

19 And shall _deliver him to the _Gentiles to _mock, and to _scourge, and to _crucify *him*: and the _third _day he shall _rise _again.

MATTHEW 20:20

Then came to him the mother of Zebedee's children with her sons, worshipping *him*, and desiring a certain thing of him.

MATTHEW 20:21

21 And he said unto her, _What _wilt thou? She saith unto him, Grant that these my two sons may sit, the one on thy right hand, and the other on the left, in thy kingdom.

MATTHEW 20:22

22 But Jesus answered and said, Ye _know not _what ye _ask. Are ye _able to _drink of the _cup that I shall _drink of, and to be _baptized with the _baptism that I am _baptized with? They say unto him, We are able.

MATTHEW 20:23

23 And he saith unto them, Ye shall _drink _indeed of my _cup, and be _baptized with the _baptism that I am _baptized with: but to _sit _on my _right hand, and _on my _left, is not _mine to _give, but it shall be given to them for _whom it is _prepared of my _Father.

MATTHEW 20:24

24 And when the ten heard *it*, they were moved with indignation against the two brethren.

MATTHEW 20:25

25 But Jesus called them *unto him*, and said, Ye _know that the _princes of the _Gentiles _exercise _dominion over them, and they that are _great _exercise _authority upon them.

MATTHEW 20:26

26 But it shall not be _so _among you: but _whosoever _will be _great _among you, let him be _your _minister;

MATTHEW 20:27

27 And whosoever will be chief among you, let him be your servant:

MATTHEW 20:28

28 _Even as the _Son of _man _came not to be _ministered unto, but to _minister, and to _give his _life a _ransom for _many.

MATTHEW 20:29

29 ¶ And as they departed from Jericho, a great multitude followed him.

MATTHEW 20:30

30 And, behold, two blind men sitting by the way side, when they heard that Jesus passed by, cried out, saying, Have mercy on us, O Lord, *thou* Son of David.

MATTHEW 20:31

31 And the multitude rebuked them, because they should hold their peace: but they cried the more, saying, Have mercy on us, O Lord, *thou* Son of David.

MATTHEW 20:32

32 And Jesus stood still, and called them, and said, _What _will ye that I shall _do unto you?

MATTHEW 20:33

33 They say unto him, Lord, that our eyes may be opened.

MATTHEW 20:34

34 So Jesus had compassion *on them*, and touched their eyes: and immediately their eyes received sight, and they followed him.
