# MATTHEW 26:1

1  $\P$  And it came to pass, when Jesus had finished all these sayings, he said unto his disciples,

# MATTHEW 26:2

2 Ye \_know that \_after \_two \_days is *the feast of* the \_passover, and the \_Son of \_man is \_betrayed to be \_crucified.

# MATTHEW 26:3

3 Then assembled together the chief priests, and the scribes, and the elders of the people, unto the palace of the high priest, who was called Caiaphas,

# MATTHEW 26:4

4 And consulted that they might take Jesus by subtilty, and kill him.

# MATTHEW 26:5

5 But they said, Not on the feast *day*, lest there be an uproar among the people.

## MATTHEW 26:6

6 ¶ Now when Jesus was in Bethany, in the house of Simon the leper,

# MATTHEW 26:7

7 There came unto him a woman having an alabaster box of very precious ointment, and poured it on his head, as he sat *at meat*.

### MATTHEW 26:8

8 But when his disciples saw *it*, they had indignation, saying, To what purpose *is* this waste?

### MATTHEW 26:9

9 For this ointment might have been sold for much, and given to the poor.

## **MATTHEW 26:10**

10 When Jesus understood *it*, he said unto them, \_Why \_trouble ye the \_woman? for she hath \_wrought a \_good \_work upon me.

# **MATTHEW 26:11**

11 For ye \_have the \_poor \_always with you; but me ye \_have not \_always.

## **MATTHEW 26:12**

**12** For in that she hath \_poured \_this \_ointment \_on my \_body, she \_did *it* for my \_burial.

# **MATTHEW 26:13**

**13** \_Verily I \_say unto you, \_Wheresoever \_this \_gospel shall be \_preached in the \_whole \_world, *there* shall \_also \_this, that \_this woman hath \_done, be \_told for a \_memorial of her.

# **MATTHEW 26:14**

14 Then one of the twelve, called Judas Iscariot, went unto the chief priests,

# **MATTHEW 26:15**

15 And said *unto them*, What will ye give me, and I will deliver him unto you? And they covenanted with him for thirty pieces of silver.

# **MATTHEW 26:16**

16 And from that time he sought opportunity to betray him.

# **MATTHEW 26:17**

17 Now the first *day* of the *feast of* unleavened bread the disciples came to Jesus, saying unto him, Where wilt thou that we prepare for thee to eat the passover?

# **MATTHEW 26:18**

18 And he said, \_Go \_into the \_city to \_such a man, and \_say unto him, The \_Master \_saith, My \_time is \_at \_hand; I will \_keep the \_passover \_at \_thy house with my \_disciples.

# **MATTHEW 26:19**

19 And the disciples did as Jesus had appointed them; and they made ready the passover.

# **MATTHEW 26:20**

20 Now when the even was come, he sat down with the twelve.

# **MATTHEW 26:21**

21 And as they did eat, he said, \_Verily I \_say unto you, that \_one of you shall \_betray me.

# MATTHEW 26:22

22 And they were exceeding sorrowful, and began every one of them to say unto him, Lord, is it I?

# **MATTHEW 26:23**

# MATTHEW 26:24

24 The \_Son of \_man \_goeth as it is \_written of him: but \_woe unto that \_man by \_whom the \_Son of \_man is \_betrayed! it had \_been \_good for that \_man \_if he had not been \_born.

# **MATTHEW 26:25**

25 Then Judas, which betrayed him, answered and said, Master, is it I? He said unto him, \_Thou hast \_said.

# MATTHEW 26:26

26 And as they were eating, Jesus took bread, and blessed *it*, and brake *it*, and gave *it* to the disciples, and said, <u>Take</u>, <u>eat</u>; <u>this is my body</u>.

# **MATTHEW 26:27**

27 And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and gave *it* to them, saying, \_Drink ye \_all of it;

# **MATTHEW 26:28**

**28** For \_this is my \_blood of the \_new \_testament, \_which is \_shed for \_many for the \_remission of \_sins.

### **MATTHEW 26:29**

**29** But I \_say unto you, I will not \_drink \_henceforth of \_this \_fruit of the \_vine, \_until that \_day \_when I \_drink it \_new with you in my \_Father's \_kingdom.

### **MATTHEW 26:30**

30 And when they had sung an hymn, they went out into the mount of Olives.

# MATTHEW 26:31

31 **Then saith Jesus unto them**, \_All ye shall be \_offended \_because of me \_this \_night: for it is \_written, I will \_smite the \_shepherd, and the \_sheep of the \_flock shall be \_scattered \_abroad.

# MATTHEW 26:32

32 But \_after I am \_risen \_again, I will \_go \_before you \_into \_Galilee.

### **MATTHEW 26:33**

33 Peter answered and said unto him, Though all *men* shall be offended because of thee, *yet* will I never be offended.

#### **MATTHEW 26:34**

**34 Jesus said unto him**, \_Verily I \_say unto thee, That \_this \_night, \_before the \_cock \_crow, thou shalt \_deny me \_thrice.

### **MATTHEW 26:35**

35 Peter said unto him, Though I should die with thee, yet will I not deny thee. Likewise also said all the disciples.

# **MATTHEW 26:36**

36 Then cometh Jesus with them unto a place called Gethsemane, and saith unto the disciples, \_Sit ye \_here, \_while I \_go and \_pray \_yonder.

### **MATTHEW 26:37**

37 And he took with him Peter and the two sons of Zebedee, and began to be sorrowful and very heavy.

### **MATTHEW 26:38**

38 Then saith he unto them, My \_soul is \_exceeding \_sorrowful, even unto \_death: \_tarry ye \_here, and \_watch with me.

### **MATTHEW 26:39**

39 And he went a little further, and fell on his face, and prayed, saying, O my \_Father, \_if it be \_possible, let \_this \_cup \_pass from me: \_nevertheless not as I \_will, but as thou *wilt*.

#### **MATTHEW 26:40**

40 And he cometh unto the disciples, and findeth them asleep, and saith unto Peter, \_What, \_could ye not \_watch with me \_one \_hour?

### **MATTHEW 26:41**

**41** \_Watch and \_pray, that ye \_enter not \_into \_temptation: the \_spirit \_indeed *is* \_willing, but the \_flesh *is* \_weak.

#### MATTHEW 26:42

42 He went away again the second time, and prayed, saying, O my \_Father, \_if \_this \_cup \_may not \_pass \_away from me, \_except I \_drink it, thy \_will be \_done.

### **MATTHEW 26:43**

43 And he came and found them asleep again: for their eyes were heavy.

#### **MATTHEW 26:44**

44 And he left them, and went away again, and prayed the third time, saying the same words.

### **MATTHEW 26:45**

45 Then cometh he to his disciples, and saith unto them, \_Sleep on \_now, and take *your* \_rest: \_behold, the \_hour is \_at \_hand, and the \_Son of \_man is \_betrayed \_into the \_hands of \_sinners.

### **MATTHEW 26:46**

46 \_Rise, let us be \_going: \_behold, he is \_at \_hand that doth \_betray me.

# **MATTHEW 26:47**

47 And while he yet spake, lo, Judas, one of the twelve, came, and with him a great multitude with swords and staves, from the chief priests and elders of the people.

### **MATTHEW 26:48**

48 Now he that betrayed him gave them a sign, saying, Whomsoever I shall kiss, that same is he: hold him fast.

### **MATTHEW 26:49**

49 And forthwith he came to Jesus, and said, Hail, master; and kissed him.

### **MATTHEW 26:50**

50 And Jesus said unto him, \_Friend, \_wherefore art thou \_come? Then came they, and laid hands on Jesus, and took him.

### **MATTHEW 26:51**

51 And, behold, one of them which were with Jesus stretched out *his* hand, and drew his sword, and struck a servant of the high priest's, and smote off his ear.

#### **MATTHEW 26:52**

52 Then said Jesus unto him, \_Put up \_again thy \_sword \_into his \_place: for \_all they that \_take the \_sword shall \_perish with the \_sword.

#### **MATTHEW 26:53**

53 \_Thinkest thou that I \_cannot \_now \_pray to my \_Father, and he shall \_presently \_give me \_more \_than \_twelve \_legions of \_angels?

## **MATTHEW 26:54**

54 But \_how \_then shall the \_scriptures be \_fulfilled, that \_thus it \_must be?

### **MATTHEW 26:55**

55 In that same hour said Jesus to the multitudes, Are ye \_come out as \_against a \_thief with \_swords and \_staves for to \_take me? I \_sat \_daily with you \_teaching in the \_temple, and ye laid \_no \_hold on me.

### **MATTHEW 26:56**

56 But \_all \_this was \_done, that the \_scriptures of the \_prophets might be \_fulfilled. Then all the disciples forsook him, and fled.

### **MATTHEW 26:57**

57 And they that had laid hold on Jesus led *him* away to Caiaphas the high priest, where the scribes and the elders were assembled.

### **MATTHEW 26:58**

58 But Peter followed him afar off unto the high priest's palace, and went in, and sat with the servants, to see the end.

## **MATTHEW 26:59**

59 Now the chief priests, and elders, and all the council, sought false witness against Jesus, to put him to death;

### **MATTHEW 26:60**

60 But found none: yea, though many false witnesses came, *yet* found they none. At the last came two false witnesses,

#### **MATTHEW 26:61**

61 And said, This *fellow* said, I am able to destroy the temple of God, and to build it in three days.

### **MATTHEW 26:62**

62 And the high priest arose, and said unto him, Answerest thou nothing? what *is it which* these witness against thee?

# **MATTHEW 26:63**

63 But Jesus held his peace. And the high priest answered and said unto him, I adjure thee by the living God, that thou tell us whether thou be the Christ, the Son of God.

### **MATTHEW 26:64**

64 Jesus saith unto him, \_Thou hast \_said: \_nevertheless I \_say unto you, \_Hereafter shall ye \_see the \_Son of \_man \_sitting \_on the \_right hand of \_power, and \_coming in the \_clouds of \_heaven.

### **MATTHEW 26:65**

65 Then the high priest rent his clothes, saying, He hath spoken blasphemy; what further need have we of witnesses? behold, now ye have heard his blasphemy.

### **MATTHEW 26:66**

66 What think ye? They answered and said, He is guilty of death.

# MATTHEW 26:67

67 Then did they spit in his face, and buffeted him; and others smote *him* with the palms of their hands,

# **MATTHEW 26:68**

68 Saying, Prophesy unto us, thou Christ, Who is he that smote thee?

# **MATTHEW 26:69**

69 ¶ Now Peter sat without in the palace: and a damsel came unto him, saying, Thou also wast with Jesus of Galilee.

# **MATTHEW 26:70**

70 But he denied before *them* all, saying, I know not what thou sayest.

# **MATTHEW 26:71**

71 And when he was gone out into the porch, another *maid* saw him, and said unto them that were there, This *fellow* was also with Jesus of Nazareth.

# MATTHEW 26:72

72 And again he denied with an oath, I do not know the man.

# **MATTHEW 26:73**

73 And after a while came unto *him* they that stood by, and said to Peter, Surely thou also art *one* of them; for thy speech bewrayeth thee.

### MATTHEW 26:74

74 Then began he to curse and to swear, *saying*, I know not the man. And immediately the cock crew.

# **MATTHEW 26:75**

75 And Peter remembered the word of Jesus, which said unto him, Before the cock crow, thou shalt deny me thrice. And he went out, and wept bitterly.
