MATTHEW 6

MATTHEW 6:1

1 Take _heed that ye _do not _your _alms _before _men, to be _seen of them: _otherwise ye _have _no _reward of _your _Father _which is in _heaven.

MATTHEW 6:2

2 _Therefore _when thou _doest *thine* _alms, do not _sound a _trumpet _before thee, as the _hypocrites _do in the _synagogues and in the _streets, that they may have _glory of _men. _Verily I _say unto you, They _have their _reward.

MATTHEW 6:3

3 But when thou _doest _alms, let not thy _left hand _know _what thy _right hand doeth:

MATTHEW 6:4

4 That _thine _alms may be in _secret: and thy _Father _which _seeth in _secret _himself shall _reward thee _openly.

MATTHEW 6:5

5 And _when thou _prayest, thou shalt not be as the _hypocrites *are*: for they _love to _pray _standing in the _synagogues and in the _corners of the _streets, that they may be _seen of _men. _Verily I _say unto you, They _have their _reward.

MATTHEW 6:6

6 But _thou, _when thou _prayest, _enter _into thy _closet, and when thou hast _shut thy _door, _pray to thy _Father _which is in _secret; and thy _Father _which _seeth in _secret shall _reward thee _openly.

MATTHEW 6:7

7 But when ye _pray, use not vain _repetitions, as the _heathen *do*: for they _think that they shall be _heard for their _much _speaking.

MATTHEW 6:8

8 Be not ye _therefore _like unto them: for _your _Father _knoweth _what things ye _have _need of, _before ye _ask him.

MATTHEW 6:9

9 ¶ _After _this _manner _therefore _pray _ye: Our _Father _which art in _heaven, Hallowed be thy _name.

MATTHEW 6:10

10 Thy _kingdom _come. Thy _will be _done in _earth, as it is in _heaven.

MATTHEW 6:11

11 _Give _us _this _day our _daily _bread.

MATTHEW 6:12

12 And _forgive _us our _debts, as we _forgive our _debtors.

MATTHEW 6:13

13 And _lead _us not _into _temptation, but _deliver us from _evil: For _thine is the _kingdom, and the _power, and the _glory, for _ever. _Amen.

MATTHEW 6:14

14 For _if ye _forgive _men their _trespasses, _your _heavenly _Father will _also _forgive you:

MATTHEW 6:15

15 But _if ye _forgive _not _men their _trespasses, _neither will _your _Father _forgive _your _trespasses.

MATTHEW 6:16

16 Moreover _when ye _fast, be not, as the _hypocrites, of a _sad _countenance: for they _disfigure their _faces, that they may _appear unto _men to _fast. _Verily I _say unto you, They _have their _reward.

MATTHEW 6:17

17 But _thou, when thou _fastest, _anoint _thine _head, and _wash thy _face;

MATTHEW 6:18

18 That thou _appear not unto _men to _fast, but unto thy _Father _which is in _secret: and thy _Father, _which _seeth in _secret, shall _reward thee _openly.

MATTHEW 6:19

19 Lay not _up for _yourselves _treasures upon _earth, _where _moth and _rust doth _corrupt, and _where _thieves _break _through and _steal:

MATTHEW 6:20

20 But lay _up for _yourselves _treasures in _heaven, _where _neither _moth _nor _rust doth _corrupt, and _where _thieves do not _break _through _nor _steal:

MATTHEW 6:21

21 For _where _your _treasure is, _there will _your _heart be _also.

MATTHEW 6:22

22 The _light of the _body is the _eye: _if _therefore _thine _eye be _single, thy _whole _body shall be _full of _light.

MATTHEW 6:23

23 But _if _thine _eye be _evil, thy _whole _body shall be full of _darkness. _If _therefore the _light that is in thee be _darkness, _how _great *is* that _darkness!

MATTHEW 6:24

24 _No _man _can _serve _two _masters: for _either he will _hate the _one, and _love the _other; _or else he will _hold to the _one, and _despise the _other. Ye _cannot _serve _God and _mammon.

MATTHEW 6:25

25 Therefore I _say unto you, Take _no _thought for _your _life, _what ye shall _eat, or _what ye shall _drink; _nor yet for _your _body, _what ye shall _put _on. Is not the _life _more than _meat, and the _body than _raiment?

MATTHEW 6:26

26 _Behold the _fowls of the _air: for they _sow not, _neither do they _reap, _nor _gather _into _barns; yet _your _heavenly _Father _feedeth them. Are _ye not _much _better than they?

MATTHEW 6:27

27 _Which of you by taking _thought _can _add _one _cubit unto his _stature?

MATTHEW 6:28

28 And _why take ye _thought for _raiment? _Consider the _lilies of the _field, _how they _grow; they _toil not, _neither do they _spin:

MATTHEW 6:29

29 And yet I _say unto you, That _even _Solomon in _all his _glory was not arrayed like one of these.

MATTHEW 6:30

30 _Wherefore, _if _God _so _clothe the _grass of the _field, which to _day is, and to _morrow is _cast _into the _oven, shall he not _much _more clothe you, O ye of _little _faith?

MATTHEW 6:31

31 _Therefore take _no _thought, _saying, _What shall we _eat? _or, _What shall we _drink? _or, _Wherewithal shall we be _clothed?

MATTHEW 6:32

32 (For _after _all _these things do the _Gentiles _seek:) for _your _heavenly _Father _knoweth that ye have _need of _all _these things.

MATTHEW 6:33

33 But _seek ye _first the _kingdom of _God, and his _righteousness; and _all _these things shall be _added unto you.

MATTHEW 6:34

34 Take _therefore _no _thought for the _morrow: for the _morrow shall take _thought for the things of _itself. _Sufficient unto the _day *is* the _evil _thereof.
