MATTHEW 9

MATTHEW 9:1

1 ¶ And he entered into a ship, and passed over, and came into his own city.

MATTHEW 9:2

2 And, behold, they brought to him a man sick of the palsy, lying on a bed: and Jesus seeing their faith said unto the sick of the palsy; _Son, be of good _cheer; thy _sins be _forgiven thee.

MATTHEW 9:3

3 And, behold, certain of the scribes said within themselves, This *man* blasphemeth.

MATTHEW 9:4

4 And Jesus knowing their thoughts said, _Wherefore _think ye _evil in _your _hearts?

MATTHEW 9:5

5 For _whether is _easier, to _say, *Thy* _sins be _forgiven thee; _or to _say, _Arise, and _walk?

MATTHEW 9:6

6 But that ye may _know that the _Son of _man _hath _power _on _earth to _forgive _sins, (then saith he to the sick of the palsy,) _Arise, _take up thy _bed, and _go unto _thine _house.

MATTHEW 9:7

7 And he arose, and departed to his house.

MATTHEW 9:8

8 But when the multitudes saw *it*, they marvelled, and glorified God, which had given such power unto men.

MATTHEW 9:9

9 And as Jesus passed forth from thence, he saw a man, named Matthew, sitting at the receipt of custom: and he saith unto him, _Follow me. And he arose, and followed him.

MATTHEW 9:10

10 And it came to pass, as Jesus sat at meat in the house, behold, many publicans and sinners came and sat down with him and his disciples.

MATTHEW 9:11

11 And when the Pharisees saw *it*, they said unto his disciples, Why eateth your Master with publicans and sinners?

MATTHEW 9:12

12 But when Jesus heard *that*, he said unto them, They that be _whole _need not a _physician, but they that are _sick.

MATTHEW 9:13

13 But _go ye and _learn _what *that* _meaneth, I _will have _mercy, and not _sacrifice: for I am not _come to _call the _righteous, but _sinners to _repentance.

MATTHEW 9:14

14 Then came to him the disciples of John, saying, Why do we and the Pharisees fast oft, but thy disciples fast not?

MATTHEW 9:15

15 And Jesus said unto them, _Can the _children of the _bridechamber _mourn, as _long as the _bridegroom is with them? but the _days will _come, _when the _bridegroom shall be _taken from them, and _then shall they _fast.

MATTHEW 9:16

16 _No _man _putteth a _piece of _new _cloth unto an _old _garment, for that which is put in to _fill it up _taketh from the _garment, and the _rent is _made _worse.

MATTHEW 9:17

17 _Neither do men _put _new _wine _into _old _bottles: _else the _bottles _break, and the _wine _runneth out, and the _bottles _perish: but they _put _new _wine _into _new _bottles, and _both are _preserved.

MATTHEW 9:18

18 While he spake these things unto them, behold, there came a certain ruler, and worshipped him, saying, My daughter is even now dead: but come and lay thy hand upon her, and she shall live.

MATTHEW 9:19

19 And Jesus arose, and followed him, and *so did* his disciples.

MATTHEW 9:20

20 And, behold, a woman, which was diseased with an issue of blood twelve years, came behind *him*, and touched the hem of his garment:

MATTHEW 9:21

21 For she said within herself, If I may but touch his garment, I shall be whole.

MATTHEW 9:22

22 But Jesus turned him about, and when he saw her, he said, <u>Daughter</u>, be of good <u>comfort</u>; thy <u>faith hath made thee</u> whole. And the woman was made whole from that hour.

MATTHEW 9:23

23 And when Jesus came into the ruler's house, and saw the minstrels and the people making a noise,

MATTHEW 9:24

24 He said unto them, _Give _place: for the _maid is not _dead, but _sleepeth. And they laughed him to scorn.

MATTHEW 9:25

25 But when the people were put forth, he went in, and took her by the hand, and the maid arose.

MATTHEW 9:26

26 And the fame hereof went abroad into all that land.

MATTHEW 9:27

27 And when Jesus departed thence, two blind men followed him, crying, and saying, *Thou* Son of David, have mercy on us.

MATTHEW 9:28

28 And when he was come into the house, the blind men came to him: and Jesus saith unto them, _Believe ye that I am _able to _do _this? They said unto him, Yea, Lord.

MATTHEW 9:29

29 Then touched he their eyes, saying, _According to _your _faith be it unto you.

MATTHEW 9:30

30 And their eyes were opened; and Jesus straitly charged them, saying, <u>See that</u> <u>no man know it</u>.

MATTHEW 9:31

31 But they, when they were departed, spread abroad his fame in all that country.

MATTHEW 9:32

32 As they went out, behold, they brought to him a dumb man possessed with a

devil.

MATTHEW 9:33

33 And when the devil was cast out, the dumb spake: and the multitudes marvelled, saying, It was never so seen in Israel.

MATTHEW 9:34

34 But the Pharisees said, He casteth out devils through the prince of the devils.

MATTHEW 9:35

35 ¶ And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people.

MATTHEW 9:36

36 But when he saw the multitudes, he was moved with compassion on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd.

MATTHEW 9:37

37 Then saith he unto his disciples, The _harvest _truly *is* _plenteous, but the _labourers *are* _few;

MATTHEW 9:38

38 _Pray ye _therefore the _Lord of the _harvest, that he will _send _forth _labourers _into his _harvest.
