PROVERBS 9:1

1 ¶ Wisdom hath builded her house, she hath hewn out her seven pillars:

PROVERBS 9:2

2 She hath killed her beasts; she hath mingled her wine; she hath also furnished her table.

PROVERBS 9:3

3 She hath sent forth her maidens: she crieth upon the highest places of the city,

PROVERBS 9:4

4 Whoso *is* simple, let him turn in hither: *as for* him that wanteth understanding, she saith to him,

PROVERBS 9:5

5 Come, eat of my bread, and drink of the wine *which* I have mingled.

PROVERBS 9:6

6 Forsake the foolish, and live; and go in the way of understanding.

PROVERBS 9:7

7 He that reproveth a scorner getteth to himself shame: and he that rebuketh a wicked *man* getteth himself a blot.

PROVERBS 9:8

8 Reprove not a scorner, lest he hate thee: rebuke a wise man, and he will love thee.

PROVERBS 9:9

9 Give *instruction* to a wise *man*, and he will be yet wiser: teach a just *man*, and he will increase in learning.

PROVERBS 9:10

10 The fear of the LORD *is* the beginning of wisdom: and the knowledge of the holy *is* understanding.

PROVERBS 9:11

11 For by me thy days shall be multiplied, and the years of thy life shall be increased.

PROVERBS 9:12

12 If thou be wise, thou shalt be wise for thyself: but *if* thou scornest, thou alone shalt bear *it*.

PROVERBS 9:13

13 ¶ A foolish woman *is* clamorous: *she is* simple, and knoweth nothing.

PROVERBS 9:14

14 For she sitteth at the door of her house, on a seat in the high places of the city,

PROVERBS 9:15

15 To call passengers who go right on their ways:

PROVERBS 9:16

16 Whoso *is* simple, let him turn in hither: and *as for* him that wanteth understanding, she saith to him,

PROVERBS 9:17

17 Stolen waters are sweet, and bread *eaten* in secret is pleasant.

PROVERBS 9:18

18 But he knoweth not that the dead *are* there; *and that* her guests *are* in the depths of hell.
