PROVERBS 13:1

1 ¶ A wise son *heareth* his father's instruction: but a scorner *heareth* not rebuke.

PROVERBS 13:2

2 ¶ A man shall eat good by the fruit of *his* mouth: but the soul of the transgressors *shall eat* violence.

PROVERBS 13:3

3 ¶ He that keepeth his mouth keepeth his life: *but* he that openeth wide his lips shall have destruction.

PROVERBS 13:4

4 ¶ The soul of the sluggard desireth, and *hath* nothing: but the soul of the diligent shall be made fat.

PROVERBS 13:5

5 ¶ A righteous *man* hateth lying: but a wicked *man* is loathsome, and cometh to shame.

PROVERBS 13:6

6 ¶ Righteousness keepeth *him that is* upright in the way: but wickedness overthroweth the sinner.

PROVERBS 13:7

7 ¶ There is that maketh himself rich, yet *hath* nothing: *there is* that maketh himself poor, yet *hath* great riches.

PROVERBS 13:8

8 ¶ The ransom of a man's life *are* his riches: but the poor *heareth* not rebuke.

PROVERBS 13:9

9 ¶ The light of the righteous rejoiceth: but the lamp of the wicked shall be put out.

PROVERBS 13:10

10 ¶ Only by pride cometh contention: but with the well advised *is* wisdom.

PROVERBS 13:11

11 ¶ Wealth *gotten* by vanity shall be diminished: but he that gathereth by labour shall increase.

PROVERBS 13:12

12 ¶ Hope deferred maketh the heart sick: but *when* the desire cometh, *it is* a tree of life.

PROVERBS 13:13

13 ¶ Whoso despiseth the word shall be destroyed: but he that feareth the commandment shall be rewarded.

PROVERBS 13:14

14 ¶ The law of the wise *is* a fountain of life, to depart from the snares of death.

PROVERBS 13:15

15 ¶ Good understanding giveth favour: but the way of transgressors *is* hard.

PROVERBS 13:16

16 ¶ Every prudent *man* dealeth with knowledge: but a fool layeth open *his* folly.

PROVERBS 13:17

17 ¶ A wicked messenger falleth into mischief: but a faithful ambassador *is* health.

PROVERBS 13:18

18 ¶ Poverty and shame *shall be to* him that refuseth instruction: but he that regardeth reproof shall be honoured.

PROVERBS 13:19

19 ¶ The desire accomplished is sweet to the soul: but *it is* abomination to fools to depart from evil.

PROVERBS 13:20

20 ¶ He that walketh with wise *men* shall be wise: but a companion of fools shall be destroyed.

PROVERBS 13:21

21 ¶ Evil pursueth sinners: but to the righteous good shall be repayed.

PROVERBS 13:22

22 ¶ A good *man* leaveth an inheritance to his children's children: and the wealth of the sinner *is* laid up for the just.

23 ¶ Much food *is in* the tillage of the poor: but there is *that is* destroyed for want of judgment.

24 ¶ He that spareth his rod hateth his son: but he that loveth him chasteneth him betimes.

25 ¶ The righteous eateth to the satisfying of his soul: but the belly of the wicked shall want.
