### PSALMS 14:1

1 ¶ To the chief Musician, *A Psalm* of David. The fool hath said in his heart, *There is no God*. They are corrupt, they have done abominable works, *there is none* that doeth good.

### PSALMS 14:2

2 The LORD looked down from heaven upon the children of men, to see if there were any that did understand, *and seek God*.

### PSALMS 14:3

3 They are all gone aside, they are *all* together become filthy: *there is none* that doeth good, no, not one.

### PSALMS 14:4

4 ¶ Have all the workers of iniquity no knowledge? who eat up my people as they eat bread, and call not upon the LORD.

### PSALMS 14:5

5 There were they in great fear: for God *is* in the generation of the righteous.

### PSALMS 14:6

6 Ye have shamed the counsel of the poor, because the LORD *is* his refuge.

### PSALMS 14:7

7 Oh that the salvation of Israel *were come* out of Zion! when the LORD bringeth back the captivity of his people, Jacob shall rejoice, *and Israel shall be glad*.
