#### **PSALMS 21:1**

1 To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. The king shall joy in thy strength, O LORD; and in thy salvation how greatly shall he rejoice!

## **PSALMS 21:2**

2 Thou hast given him his heart's desire, and hast not withholden the request of his lips. Selah.

## **PSALMS 21:3**

3 For thou preventest him with the blessings of goodness: thou settest a crown of pure gold on his head.

## **PSALMS 21:4**

4 He asked life of thee, *and* thou gavest *it* him, *even* length of days for ever and ever.

#### **PSALMS 21:5**

5 His glory is great in thy salvation: honour and majesty hast thou laid upon him.

#### **PSALMS 21:6**

6 For thou hast made him most blessed for ever: thou hast made him exceeding glad with thy countenance.

## **PSALMS 21:7**

7 ¶ For the king trusteth in the LORD, and through the mercy of the most High he shall not be moved.

## **PSALMS 21:8**

8 Thine hand shall find out all thine enemies: thy right hand shall find out those that hate thee.

## **PSALMS 21:9**

9 Thou shalt make them as a fiery oven in the time of thine anger: the LORD shall swallow them up in his wrath, and the fire shall devour them.

#### **PSALMS 21:10**

10 Their fruit shalt thou destroy from the earth, and their seed from among the children of men.

## **PSALMS 21:11**

11 For they intended evil against thee: they imagined a mischievous device, *which* they are not able *to perform*.

# **PSALMS 21:12**

12 Therefore shalt thou make them turn their back, *when* thou shalt make ready *thine arrows* upon thy strings against the face of them.

13 Be thou exalted, LORD, in thine own strength: so will we sing and praise thy power.
